

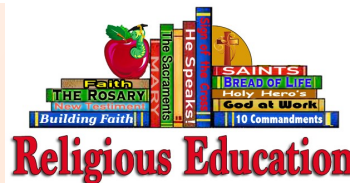

Listek może być ofiarowany z okazji urodzin, rocznicy ślubu a także aby upamiętnić imię osoby, której już z nami nie ma. Ofiara za mniejszy listek wynosi \$300.00 natomiast większy \$1,000.00.
