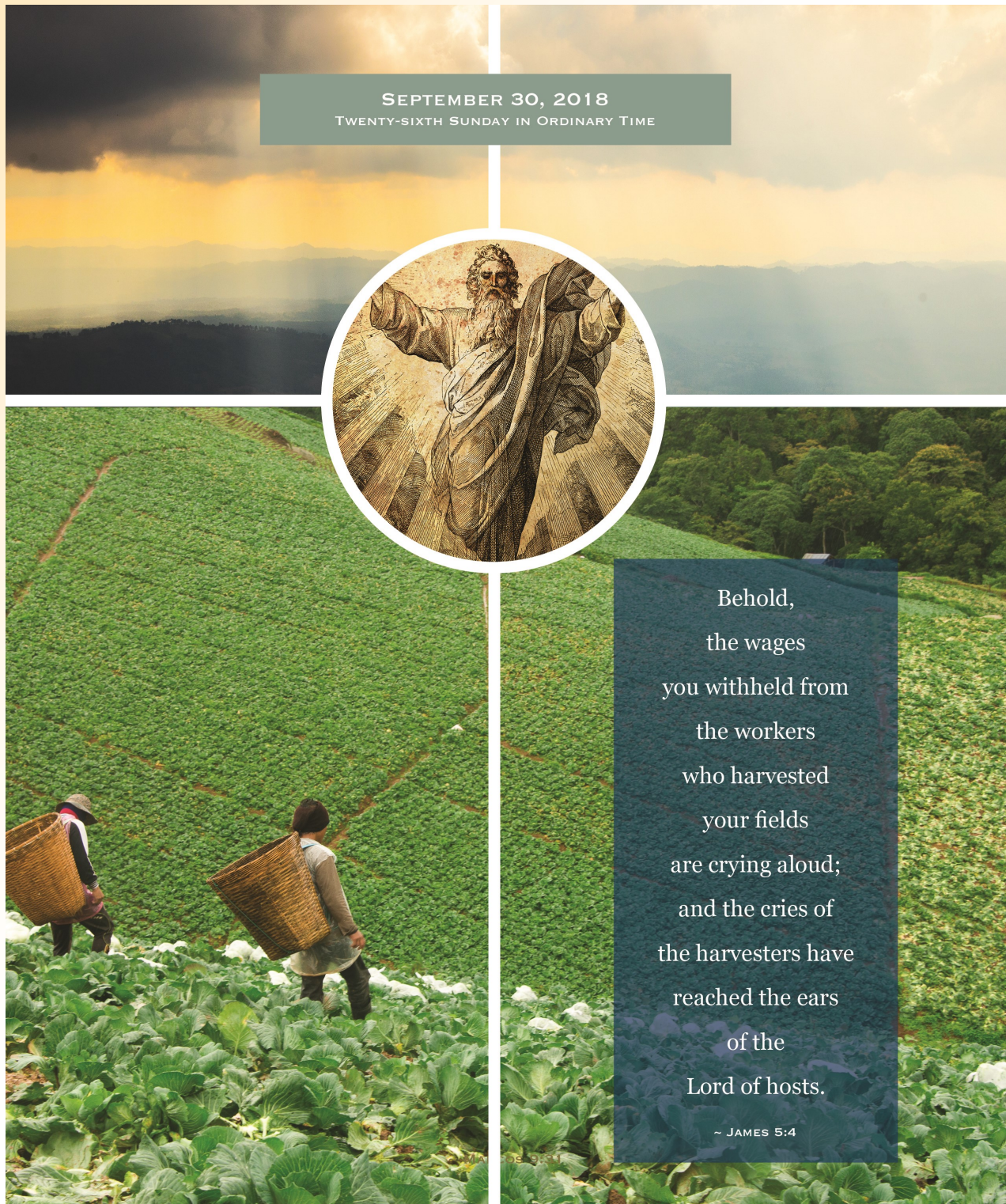

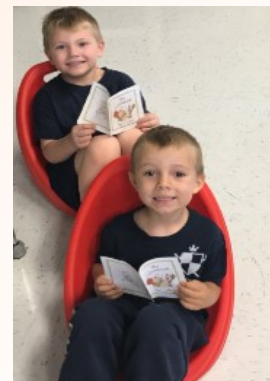
Great things happen @ St. Albert the Great!

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry!

Kilka lat temu prowadziliśmy w Archidiecezji Chicago specjalny program pod tytułem: „**Uczyć kim jest Jezus Chrystus**”! Pieniążki zebrane w ramach tej kampanii finansowej służyły i wciąż służą między innymi w prowadzeniu prac remontowych w naszych kościołach, także i w naszej ukochanej świątyni św. Alberta Wielkiego w Burbank.

Dzięki tym pieniążkom udało się nam tylko w tym roku wymienić główne i boczne zewnętrzne drzwi do naszego kościoła. Także w najbliższych dniach i tygodniach z tego funduszu zostaną wygospodarowane kolejne specjalne fundusze na poprawę posadzki w przedsionku kościoła oraz na naprawę popękanych głównych wewnętrznych schodów do kościoła i do sali pod kościołem. Dziękuję dyrekcji polskiej szkoły im. **Adama Mickiewicza** za specjalną donację na rzecz naszej parafii.
