Last weekend in the Archdiocese of Chicago as well as in our beloved parish we began the "Annual Catholic Appeal 2019". Drodzy Bracia i Siostry!

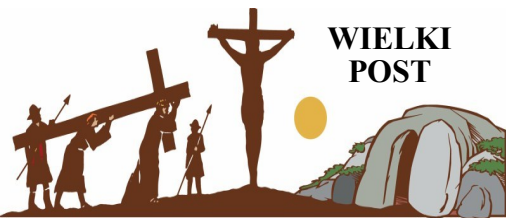
Tydzień temu w całej naszej Archidiecezji Chicago oraz w naszej ukochanej parafii prowadzona była „**Coroczna Kwesta Katolicka 2019**”, która wspiera nie tylko Diecezję Chicago, ale przede wszystkim wspiera parafie oraz dzieła duszpasterskie. Każdego roku nasza parafia nie tylko osiąga wyznaczony przez Diecezję Chicago cel (54,382.68 \$), ale również go przekracza. Proszę was bardzo o modlitwę w tej intencji.
