From the Pastor's Desk

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

Always when we finish a calendar year we make a summary. We ask: what was the last year like? With great pride we look at our great spiritual and material goods that we were able to accomplish in our parish community. Today I would like to share with you these fruits with you. This is a small summary of our "**being**" together in this great parish family of St. Albert the Great!

Spiritual Fruits:

- loving faith community that respects traditions, customs, culture and languages (English, Polish, Spanish and Filipino);
- our parish is the largest in the Archdiocese of Chicago, on average 4,700 faithful attends Sunday Masses;
- loving presence of Jesus in the Adoration Chapel;
- community of prayer □ many services, daily Masses, Sunday Masses, monthly, periodical and annual Mass celebrations;
- Masses celebrated in the Church as well as Adoration Chapel and outdoors: Stations of the Cross and Rosary through the streets of Burbank. We have very good relations with the Mayor of Burbank Mr. Dan Foy as well as Burbank Police and Fire Departments;
- during the year we distributed 70 thousand of Holy Communion;
- thousands of people take advantage of the Sacrament of Reconciliation;
- in 2018 we celebrated 134 baptisms;
- 164 children received the First Holy Communion;
- 133 young men and women received the Sacrament of Confirmation;
- we celebrated 37 Marriage Ceremonies
- we celebrated 110 funerals;
- parish has 5 different schools (total over 1200 students);
- only God knows the multitude of the spiritual gifts. Glory be to God in His Angels and His Saints!

- washing of the church ceiling;
- cleaning of all church pew cushions;

- ceramic tiles in the cry rooms;
- sacristy renovation (floor, painting, new restroom, granite, new decorations);
- renovations in Rogers Hall: new signs, new lamps in the hallways, two new TV sets, bar, lamps above the bar, lightbulbs, new walls and „Welcome” signs in several different languages, new decorations, wooden posts, coffers, new coat racks, decorations;
- each room and facility was cleaned and well organized;

Area surrounding the church building:

- expanded St. Albert the Great garden;
- new outdoor electronic sign;
- outdoor sign for school;
- information signs for all parish schools;
- tree removal;
- playground for children;
- new wooden fences;
- new garages (6), storage for property maintenance equipment;

Zawsze kiedy kończymy rok kalendarzowy dokonujemy pewnych podsumowań. Pytamy: jaki był ten ostatni rok? Z wielką dumą patrzymy na to wielkie dobro duchowe i materialne jakie udało się nam wspólnie wypracować w naszej wspólnocie parafialnej. Dziś pragnę się tymi owocami duchowymi i materialnymi z wami podzielić. Jest to takie małe podsumowanie naszego „**bycia**” razem w tej wspaniałej i wielkiej wspólnocie rodzinnej św. - wiele owoców duchowych zna tylko Pan Bóg. I za to niech będzie Bóg uwielbiony w Swoich Aniołach i w Swoich Świętych!
