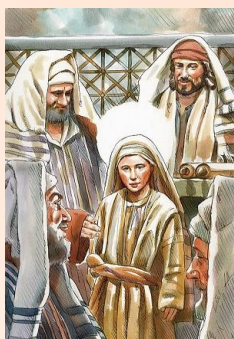

### SEKRET SZCZĘŚLIWEJ RODZINY

Kiedy słyszę słowo „rodzina”, od razu przypomina mi się pewna zabawna piosenka. Jej refren brzmi jeszcze w mojej głowie: „Rodzina, rodzina, rodzina, ach rodzina. Rodzina nie cieszy, nie cieszy, gdy jest, lecz kiedy jej nima samotny jak pies”. Ktoś mógłby w tym miejscu zaprotestować: jak to nie cieszy, kiedy cieszyć powinna i to jeszcze w święto Świętej Rodziny. Też chciałbym, aby cieszyła, ale pomyślmy, czy nasze katolickie rodziny są miejscem radości i szczęścia? Oczywiście, nie wszystkie, ale są. I to nawet pomimo nieporozumień i trudności, których żadnej rodzinie nie brakuje. Nie brakowało ich również Świętej Rodziny. O takim nieporozumieniu związanym z zagubieniem się Jezusa wspomina dzisiejsza Ewangelia. Wiemy też, że rodzinie Jezusa nie oszczędzono różnych trudności. A jednak nie mamy wątpliwości co do tego, że Chrystus wychował się w szczęśliwym domu. Nieprzypadkowo na Jego widok jedna z kobiet z podziwem stwierdziła: „Błogosławione łono, które Cię nosiło, i piersi, które ssałeś” (Łk 11,27). Jaki jest sekret szczęśliwych rodzin? Czy nie właśnie ten, o którym mówi św. Paweł w dzisiejszym drugim czytaniu: „Umilowani, obleczcie się w serdeczne miłosierdzie, dobroć, pokorę, cichość, cierpliwość, znosząc jedni drugich i wybacząc sobie nawzajem, jeśliby miał ktoś zarzut przeciw drugiemu: jak Pan wybaczył wam, tak i wy. Na to zaś wszystko przyobleczcie miłość, która jest więzią doskonałości. A sercami waszymi niech rządzi pokój Chrystusowy, do którego też zostaliście wezwani, w jednym Ciele. I bądźcie wdzięczni”. *O. Cul – dominikanin*
