## TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

In recent years, there has been remarkable progress in drawing persons with disabilities into full celebration. Now it is generally accepted that worship places need accommodations such as ramps or elevators, large-print materials for those who are sight-impaired, and perhaps even an assisted hearing system or signing in American Sign Language. American Sign Language is not merely English translated into movement, but a distinct language with its own grammar, syntax (word order), and vocabulary. For this reason, the American Catholic bishops have approved American Sign Language (ASL) as an official language of the liturgy. Celebrating liturgy in our own language (the vernacular) means that liturgy must be accessible to all languages and cultures. The fact that Mass is celebrated this weekend in some places in total silence, but with the full participation of deaf people praising God in the movements of their hands, and sometimes even with a priest who is deaf, is nothing less than the Church being faithful to the image of Jesus, who made the deaf hear and the mute speak. Remember too that deafness is an invisible disability, and that there may well be people in your parish who are quietly yearning for Mass to be signed for them in ASL.

## From the Pastor's Desk

*My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!*

Nex week, the Archdiocese of Chicago as well as in our beloved parish, will begin the "Annual Catholic Appeal 2019". This year's motto is: "Come, Follow me ... and share the Word." The Annual Catholic Appeal supports not only the Chicago Diocese, but above all supports parishes, schools and communities throughout Cook and Lake Counties. This year, the money collected will support ministries such as: Kolbe House Jail Ministry, Lifelong Formation, which aims to lift, form and empower ministries and parishioners, Respect Life Ministry, which seeks to transform society into Culture of Life where every human being is valued and protected, Immigration Ministry Youth and Young Adults Ministry that helps to develop parish based teams of local leaders and empower them with training and formation.

Each year, in the past, our parish not only achieved the goals set by the Diocese, but it exceeded them. For example, last year (2018) our parish goal was \$53,588.65, our parishioners and people praying in our church pledged \$70,742.00 and contributed \$68,682.00. Our parish received from the Archdiocese refund in the amount of \$15,093.35.

This year's financial goal of the Catholic Appeal for our parish is \$54,382.68. I am convinced that we will achieve this goal the same way we did in previous years. I am asking you for prayers in this intention. I would like to thank the people of good will who already submitted their pledges and donations for 2019 Appeal. Please, sit down together with your families and consider the amount of your material support for this campaign. All financial commitments made in the church will be sent to the Diocese's ACA department, which is responsible for all financial registrations, settlements, reminders, correspondence and, unfortunately, sometimes mistakes. If it should happen that a mistake occurs on your statement, we will clear it up. I am asking you for cooperation, patience and understanding.

**Drodzy Bracia i Siostry!**

Już za tydzień w całej naszej Archidiecezji Chicago oraz w naszej ukochanej parafii zostanie przeprowadzona „Coroczna Kwesta Katolicka 2019”. W tym roku głównym mottem tej kwesty są słowa: „**Pójdź za Mną... i głoś Słowo**”. Coroczna Kwesta Katolicka wspiera nie tylko Diecezję Chicago, ale przede wszystkim wspiera parafie oraz dzieła duszpasterskie. W tym roku pieniądze w ten sposób zebrane będą też przeznaczone na duszpasterstwo do spraw Formacji na całe Życie, duszpasterstwo do spraw Szacunku dla Życia, duszpasterstwo do spraw Imigracji oraz duszpasterstwo do spraw Młodzieży i Młodych Dorosłych.

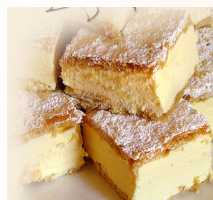
