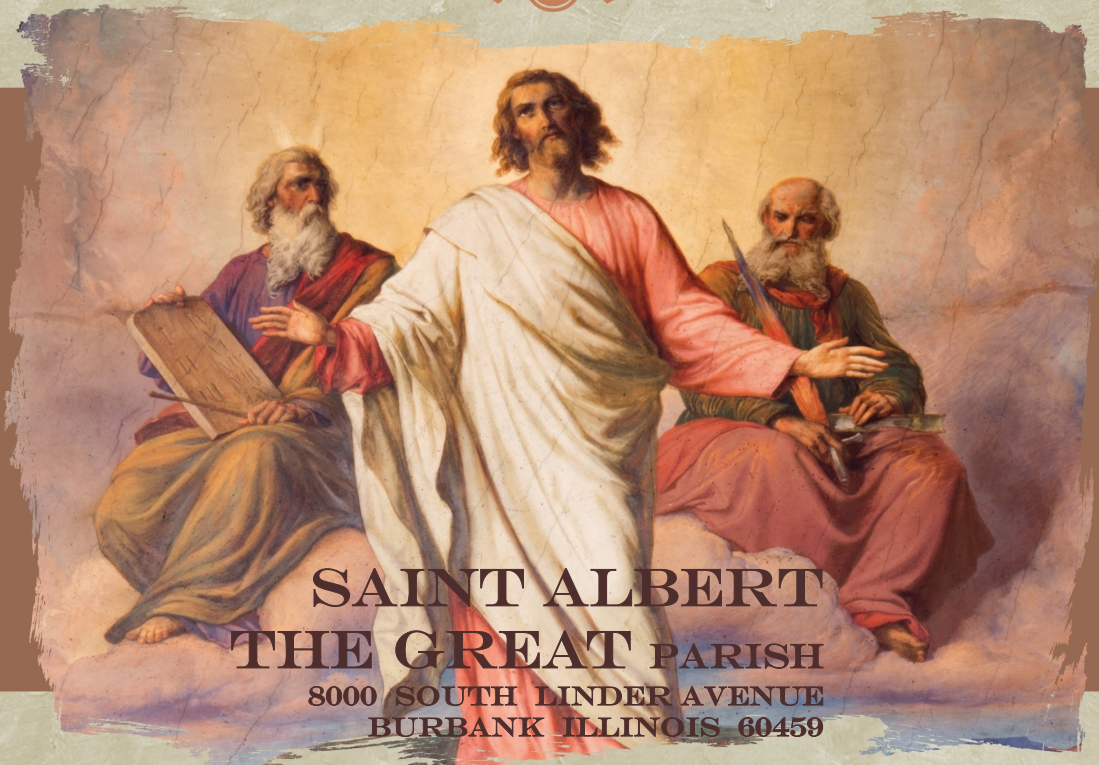

STAND FIRM IN THE LORD

It is not hard to imagine, in this age of wars, evil groups bent on the destruction of humanity, and political follies, that the words of Saint Paul were so accurate, even for his time. It seems that the world never changes. Paul says, "Many . . . conduct themselves as enemies of the cross of Christ. Their end is their destruction . . . Their minds are occupied with earthly things" (Philippians 3:18, 19). The result is the destruction of innocent people and of the Earth itself. But Paul says to the Philippians, "our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we also await a savior, the Lord Jesus Christ" (3:20). He will "change our lowly body to conform with his glorified body" (3:21). Note that he says "body" rather than "bodies." He is talking about the whole community of believers, who, following the example of Jesus and of Paul, will come into the glory of God. So "stand firm in the Lord" (4:1).

PRZEMIENIENIE A EUCHARYSTIA

„Nasza bowiem ojczyzna jest w niebie. Stamtąd też oczekujemy Zbawiciela, Pana, Jezusa Chrystusa, który przemieni nasze marne ciało i upodobni je do swego chwalebego ciała” (II czytanie). Doświadczenie życiowe potwierdza tezę Viktora Frankla, że człowiek musi mieć przed oczyma wielkie idee, konkretne cele, do których zmierza, gdyż inaczej zmarnuje swoje siły i przegra życie. Przekraczanie grzesznej niedoskonałości, niezagubienie się w szczegółach oraz osiągnięcie pełnego i trwałego szczęścia jest możliwe tylko dzięki łasce Bożej. W dzisiejszej Ewangelii Chrystus przedstawia wizję życiowych perspektyw. Zanim zażąda od uczniów wierności w momencie Jego odrzucenia, męki i śmierci, ukazuje im, kim naprawdę jest. Jest Bogiem, który przyjął ludzką naturę dla naszego zbawienia. Na progu Wielkiego Postu warto uczyć się doświadczenia tajemnicy Eucharystii jak góry Przemienienia przeżytej przez uczniów. Nie tylko uczestniczyć w przemianie chleba i wina w Ciało i Krew Chrystusa, ale pozwolić Bogu na konsekrację zranionej grzechem ludzkiej natury. Przemienienie Pana Jezusa nie zakończyło się wniebowstąpieniem czy wniebowzięciem uczniów. Zakończyło się umocnieniem ich wiary i nadziei na drogę do Jerozolimy i przeżycie Paschy. Podobnie każdy z nas powinien wyjść z Eucharystii umocniony słowem Bożym i Ciałem Chrystusa, by odważnie głosić wielkie dzieła Pana. Warto łączyć codzienny trud życia z tajemnicą światła niedzielnej Mszy św., z codzienną modlitwą i uczynkami miłosierdzia, by życie odmieniło się jak twarz Jezusa i Jego szata.
