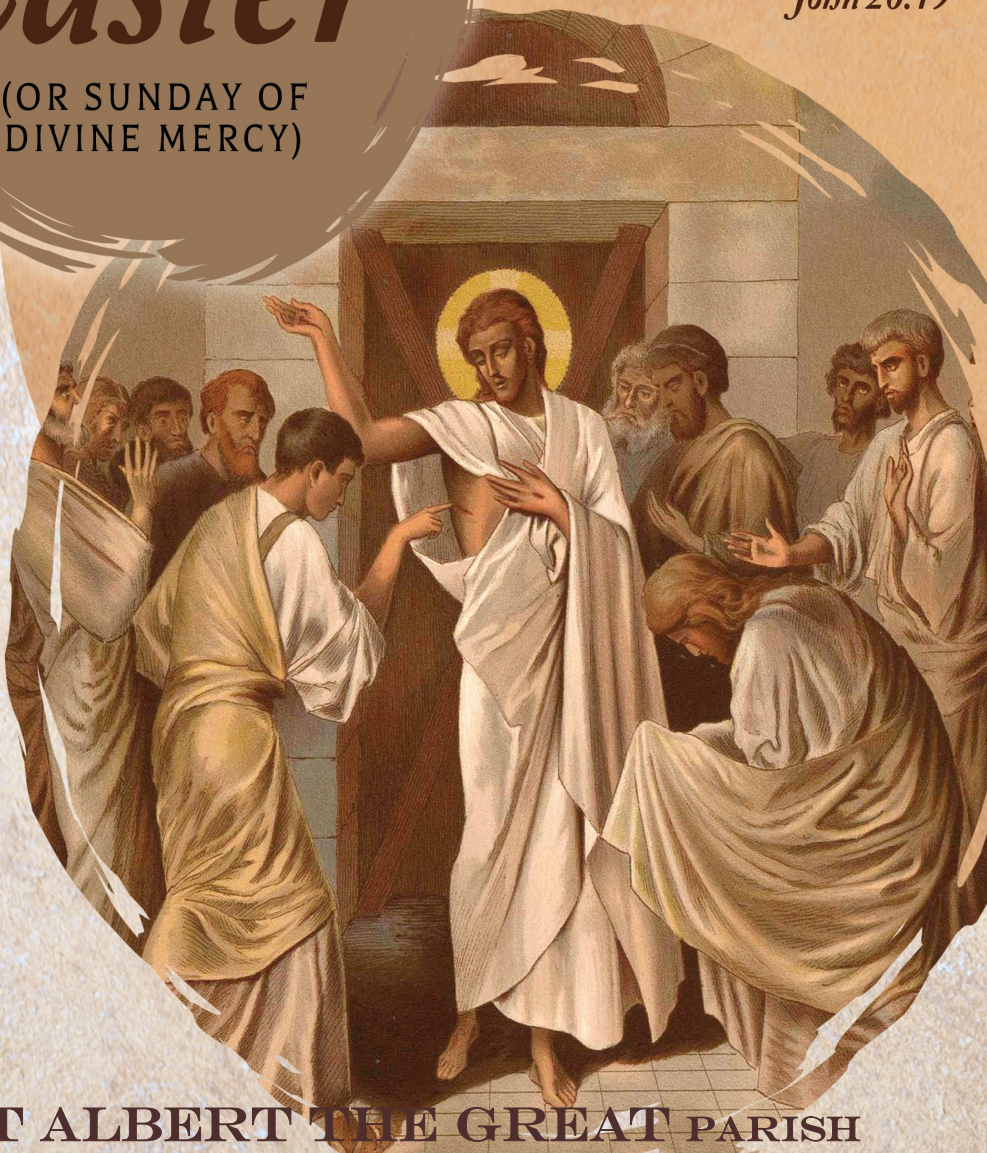

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

An ancient title for this Sunday is *Dominica in Albis*, or "Sunday in White." During the Easter Vigil, the newly baptized are invested with a white garment, a sign that they have put on Christ. At one time, the garments were worn for a full week of celebration and reflection, and on this Sunday the newly baptized would appear in their robes again in their new place among the faithful for Eucharist.

In later centuries, the energy of new life at Easter was largely forgotten, and this Sunday was renamed "Quasimodo Sunday," or "Low Sunday." In recent years, with the recovery of the insight that Easter is the privileged time for celebrating and renewing baptism, there is nothing "Low" about this Sunday. At a week's distance, the beauty and grace of our Easter celebration is sustained by joyful alleluias, the blessing and sprinkling of holy water, and the comfort of the Lord's presence to us. He is risen, and he summons us together, opening up the scriptures for us, breaking the bread, filling us with new life.

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

Still immersed in the joy of Easter, I would like to express a big thank you to the **“Fish Fry Friday's Team”, the “Holy Name Society”, the “Spanish Ministry” and all volunteers** who took part in this year's Lenten *"Fish Dinners"*. The *"Fish Fry Fridays"* tradition refers to Capernaum on the Lake of Galilee, where Jesus has multiplied bread and fish. I am very pleased that this Christian tradition (after a few years break) continues and is nurtured in our parish. As you know our *"Fish Dinners"* enjoy a great popularity. Thousands of our brothers and sisters from Burbank, surrounding towns and parishes came out to be with us. I thank from the bottom of my heart all that supported us; thank you, thank you very much.

I direct words of sincere gratitude to the **"Fish Fry Friday's Team and the Holy Name Society"** for their tireless work in the kitchen and a beautiful service for the good of our parish. This year's profit from the *"Fish Dinners"* was **\$21,000.00** and it will be used for the installation of a new fire alarm system in our Church and Rogers Hall. At the same time I invite all of you to save the dates for the next parish *"Fish Fry" 2020*.

Today I also would like to thank another group of donors who financially supported the central cooling system project for the Sacred Heart of Jesus Adoration Chapel. Drodzy Bracia i Siostry!

Trwając wciąż w Radości Wielkanocnej dziś pragnę z głębi serca podziękować: „**Fish Fry Friday’s Team**”, „**Holy Name Society**”, „**Spanish Ministry**” i wielu wolontariuszom za tegoroczne wielkopostne „*obiady rybne*”. Tradycja „*obiadów rybnych*” nawiązuje do Kafarnaum nad Jeziorem Galilejskim, gdzie Pan Jezus rozmnożył chleb i ryby. Bardzo się cieszę, że ta chrześcijańska tradycja jest (po kilkuletniej przerwie) kontynuowana i pielęgnowana w naszej parafii. Jak wiecie nasze „*obiady rybne*” cieszą się wielką popularnością. Tysiące naszych braci i sióstr z naszego miasta Burbank oraz z okolicznych parafii i miejscowości było z nami. Wszystkim tym, którzy wsparli nasze postne „*obiady rybne*” z serca dziękuję.

Słowa szczególnej wdzięczności kieruję do „**Fish Fry Friday’s Team i Holy Name Society**” za mozolną pracę w kuchni oraz za piękną służbę dla dobra naszej parafii. Tegoroczny zysk z „*obiadów rybnych*” **\$21,000.00** zostanie przeznaczony na instalację systemu przeciwpożarowego w kościele oraz w sali pod kościołem. Już dziś myślami wybiegamy do przyszłego roku i serdecznie wszystkich zapraszamy na ryby za rok.

Również w miesiącu maju zostanie zainstalowane w korytarzu na ścianie specjalne krzeselko dla osób niepełnosprawnych, które umożliwi im poruszanie się po naszych schodach. Na czas tych zbliżających się oraz koniecznych prac w kościele oraz w sali pod kościołem proszę was o cierpliwość, wyrozumiałość i życzliwość.

Niech wszystkich naszych parafian i modlących się w naszym kościele błogosławi Pan Jezus Zmartwychwstały i Miłosierny!
