## Moi Kochani Bracia i Siostry!

### JAKIE JEST NIEBO?

Chrystus Pan wypełnił wolę Ojca do końca i wśród radości i chwały wstępuje dziś do nieba. Wskazuje nam kierunek. A czy my tęsknimy za niebem? Czy ono nas pociąga tak, że budząc się rano, chcemy, aby dziś przyszedł ostatecznie Chrystus? Możemy zapytać, jakie jest niebo, skoro nawet „oko nie widziało, ani ucho nie słyszało, ani serce człowieka nie zdołało pojąć, jak wielkie rzeczy przygotował Bóg”? (1Kor 2,9). Jeżeli potrafimy zachwycić się pięknem natury tu na ziemi, która przecież jest skażona grzechem pierworodnym, to jak piękna musi być natura doskonała, czysta. Jak piękny musi być cały wszechświat, który stworzył Pan Bóg z miłości do człowieka. Pan Jezus powiedział uczniom: „Idźcie na cały świat i głoscie Ewangelię!”.
