From the Pastor's Desk

My beloved Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

Just a week ago I informed you about some new plans for our parish. What is done every week in our "HOME" is bordering on a miracle! Last week I informed you that we are planning to renovate the "Stations of the Cross" sculptures in the church. In just two days fourteen families offered to cover the entire cost of this project. I also informed you that we are planning to purchase new tables and chairs for the St. Albert Room. This plan was also realized; we bought 150 new plastic chairs, 25 tables and 8 special chairs for children. Our parish gardeners: **sister Weronika, Wiola, Anna, Helena, Bernadetta, Bogusia, Anna, Andrzej, Janina, Jacenty, Hugo, Miguel and Luis** are taking care of the flowers around our Church, chapel, statues of St. Albert the Great, garages and the administration building.

Many of you ask how you can still support our future works and projects. The next new idea is to renovate the church bell tower, to name it "**Sursum Corda – Lift up your Hearts**", and improve the area around it. I ask all parish groups to consider making a donation toward this project. I also encourage parishioners and their families to financially support this improvement. All those who will make a donation will have their names engraved on a special plate that will be mounted on this tower. Individuals and families interested in supporting this projects, please contact me or the parish office.

We are still waiting for the last license from the Archdiocese of Chicago, which will allow us to begin the installation of the Fire Alarm System in the church and in Rogers Hall. We are also waiting for the state permit for the installation of a special chair lift (in the church) for individuals with disabilities. I will keep you informed about the progress of all future projects in our wonderful parish community of St. Albert the Great. Please know that I pray daily to Our Lord Jesus in your intention.

Zaledwie tydzień temu informowałem was o naszych nowych parafialnych planach. To co się dokonuje każdego tygodnia w naszym „**DOMU**” graniczy chyba z cudem! Przed tygodniem poinformowałem was, że planujemy odnowić w kościele Droge Krzyżową. W dwa dni zgłosiło się 14 rodzin, które pokryły w całości koszt renowacji stacji Drogi Krzyżowej. Informowałem was także, że planujemy zakupić do sali św. Alberta Wielkiego nowe lekkie stoły i krzeselka. I tak też się stało. Zakupiliśmy więc 150 nowych plastikowych krzesełek, 25 stołów i 8 specjalnych krzesełek dla dzieci. Nasze ogrodniczki i ogrodnicy min. **siostra Weronika, Wiola, Anna, Helena, Bernadetta, Bogusia, Anna, Andrzej, Janina, Jacenty, Hugo, Miguel i Luis** każdego dnia dbają o kwiaty wokół kościoła, kaplicy, figury św. Alberta Wielkiego, garaży i budynku administracyjnego.

Wielu z was pyta, jak może jeszcze wesprzeć dzieła, które każdego dnia realizujemy. Nowym pomysłem jest odmalowanie wieży przy kościele oraz umieszczenie na niej wizerunku krzyża na Giewoncie. Tą naszą odnowioną wieżę nazwiemy: „**Sursum Corda – W górę Serca – Lift up your Hearts**”. Ta nazwa jest zaczerpnięta od słów św. **Jana Pawła II**, które wypowiedział w 1997 roku w czasie pielgrzymki w Zakopanym. Proszę więc wszystkie Koła Góralski i zespoły muzyczne, które się gromadzą przy naszym kościele na piknikach, odpustach, opłatkach i próbach o rozważenie możliwości wsparcia finansowego dla tego pomysłu. Zachęcam też do zaangażowania się w ten projekt osoby indywidualne oraz rodziny naszej parafii. Wszyscy, którzy chcą złożyć donację na ten cel zostaną umieszczeni na specjalnej płycie, która zostanie zamontowana na tej wieży. Osoby oraz rodziny zainteresowane wsparciem tej idei proszę jak zawsze o kontakt ze mną lub z kancelarią parafialną. Przy okazji dziękuję tym, którzy już złożyli donacje na ten cel: **Koło nr 65 Ciche Dolne i Koło nr 52 Czerwienne-parafii Miętustwo (prezes Władzia Kowalczyk), Marian i Helena Bafia, Sylwester i Grażyna Stypa z dziećmi, Katarzyna Palmer.**

Wciąż czekamy na ostatnie pozwolenia z kurii Chicago, aby rozpocząć instalację systemu przeciwpożarowego w kościele oraz w sali pod kościołem. Czekamy również na specjalne pozwolenie stanowe dotyczące instalacji w kościele specjalnego krzeselka-podnośnika dla osób niepełnosprawnych. Na bieżąco będę was informował o wszystkich kolejnych postępkach w pracach w naszej wspólniejszej wspólnoty parafialnej św. Alberta Wielkiego. Wszystkich was codziennie polecam Jezusowi w kapłańskiej modlitwie.
