Periodically I give you updates on recent projects and improvements that were completed for our church and our parish and community. Today, with great joy and pride I give you a list of things we accomplished during the last six months;

- A new website for the parish (it is updated with new photos and information);
- We have ordered new information boards for all parish buildings and a special bronze plaque for the church tower (names of all renovation and Our Lady of Fatima sponsors will be engraved on this plaque);
- We have ordered beautiful figures of Our Lady of Fatima and the visionary children;
- The beautiful garden of Our Lady of Fatima will be built in the coming days;
- A new hot water tank has been installed in Rogers Hall;
- We have a new shelf for the holy oils in the church;
- New information boards in the church vestibule;

## Moi Kochani Bracia i Siostry!

Co jakiś czas na bieżąco informuję was o wszystkich pracach wykonywanych w naszej wspólnocie parafialnej. Dziś z wielką radością i dumą informuję was o tym co udało nam się zrobić w ciągu zaledwie kolejnych 6 miesięcy. A zatem:

**BOSKA KSIĘGA IMION** Czego to ludzie nie wymyślą, aby ich imię zostało wpisane do Księgi rekordów Guinnessa? Można się śmiać z tego rodzaju ambicji, ale ona również świadczy o nieusuwalnym pragnieniu ludzkiego serca, aby zaistnieć, wybić się spośród anonimowego tłumu.
