TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The wonderful diversity of life and worship among Roman Catholics of East and West is an example of God writing straight with crooked lines. The steady hand of the villainous Emperor Diocletian drew a line across Europe and Africa that split the empire in two, and for the most part determined how Christians would worship two thousand years later.

Italy's heel and the far northern city of Trieste fell on the Eastern side, and have had a form of Eastern liturgy ever since. Constantinople, which soon became the seat of the Roman Empire, became a base for Christianizing the East up to Russia and Poland. Poland was on the Eastern side, but a series of wars and medieval mayhem pushed the religious boundary back to the Ukraine, and Poland remains an outpost of the Latin Church to this day.

An old rule of thumb declared that whatever religion was observed by the local prince, the people had to follow. This gave rise to persecution and migration as people sought toleration for their expressions of faith. In the United States, we are accustomed to peaceful collaboration among Christians of East and West, a situation that challenges churches that still feel the pinch of age-old division. —James Field, Copyright © J. Building Updates

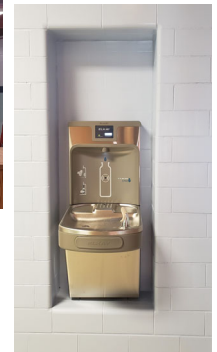
This summer has been extremely busy at St. Albert the Great. Mr. Ferreri and his crew have been working hard to make our school a comfortable and vibrant place. Here are some of our improvements:

Technology Updates

Teachers will continue using Google Classroom for their subjects. This includes PreK and Kindergarten as well. These sites will be available to parents, so that you can track homework assignments, class announcements, or just to learn more about what your child is doing in school. We are now entering into year 3 of our 5 year - 6 million dollar grant. Our school's tech infrastructure is being upgraded once again to support the use of more chromebooks. Additionally, more chromebooks will be ordered in January for our school. We intentionally choose not to be a 1:1 device school because we believe that while students should have access to the latest technology, it should not be all that they do during the school day. Our teachers are trained in personalized learning to ensure that students get the proper use out of our technological resources, while implementing 21st century classroom strategies.

The tech resources we use in our classes are:

- PreK: iPads
- Kindergarten: Chromepads, Chromebooks, Computer pod
- 1st - 8th: Chromebooks & Computer pod

Additional wireless access points have been added to the school for high speed internet availability. We continue to update our school website, as we hope to make our school website the main source of information for our families. Please refer to the website often for up-to-date information.

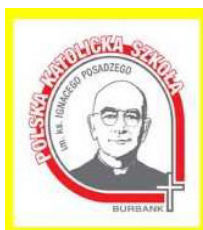
