Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

We continue our food donations for the poor in Haiti and Jamaica until Sunday, October 13th. Please, drop off your donations at the parish office throughout the week and in the special bin in the church vestibule on Sunday. I ask you to please, share your food with those who go to sleep hungry!

We are very fortunate to have in our church two "Cry Rooms" designated for families with small children. Sometimes it happens that these little ones need to cry during the Mass. I urge parents of these children to take advantage of these special rooms. It is not about the priests who celebrate the Eucharist, but about our fellow parishioners who sometimes get anxious and tell me that they are not able to hear well or concentrate, especially during the sermon. I ask all of you for patience, cooperation and kindness in this matter.

I invite all parishioners St. Albert the Great and all who come to pray in our church to join in our annual "**Holy Rosary and Our Lady of Fatima Procession**" on Saturday, October 19th. As in prior years, we will gather in the parking lot of the Tobin Elementary School (8501 Narragansett Ave. Burbank). I invite all parish groups, ministers, choirs, altar servers, students of our St. Albert the Great Catholic School as well as all students of the Fr. Ignacy Posadzy and Adam Mickiewicz Polish Schools to take part in this beautiful event. The Rosary and procession will end with a Holy Mass in our church. TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Sometimes human relationships go awry, but Christ's choice for us is irrevocable. In marriage celebrations, the Church always recalls God's faithfulness to help prepare married couples for enduring the inevitable rough spots. The Byzantine liturgy does this by adorning the couple with crowns that remind them of the martyr's crown. The couple therefore takes on a vocation of witnessing to the sacredness of life in all of its suffering and joy, and of keeping their eyes fixed on the banquet of heaven.

In Eastern theology, people have a liturgical vocation to give God praise, and marriage fits within that plan. It is not so much saying prayers that counts, but becoming prayer. Interestingly, in this liturgy the couple never utters a word other than joining in the community's chants; there are no marriage vows as such. There is therefore not a hint of our Western Christian sense that marriage is a legal contract. Rather, it is all about living out one's baptismal vocation, embracing the cross, pouring oneself out in love, and opening to the grace of the Holy Spirit. —James Field, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

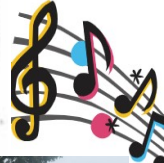

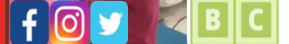

Zbiórka Ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry!

Wciąż kontynuujemy naszą zbiórkę żywności oraz środków higienicznych dla *Misjonarzy Ubogich* w Haiti i Jamaica. Te wszystkie rzeczy dla ubogich dzieci możemy przynosić w tygodniu do kancelarii parafialnej oraz w niedzielę do kościoła i składać to wszystko do specjalnych pojemników w tyle naszej świątyni. Nasza zbiórka charytatywna trwa aż do niedzieli 13 października. Bardzo was proszę; **podzielcie się chlebem z tymi, którzy go nie mają!**

W naszym kościele mamy to szczęście, że po obydwu stronach świątyni posiadamy specjalne pokoje dla małych dzieci tzw. „*Crying Room*”. Zdarza się czasami, że te maleństwa płaczą. Zachęcam więc rodziców tych dzieci do skorzystania z tych specjalnych pokoi. Tu nie chodzi o księży, którzy celebrować Eucharystię, ale o naszych bliźnich w ławkach, którzy czasami się denerwują i skarżą, że im to przeszkadza się skupić szczególnie w czasie kazania. Wszystkich zachęcam do cierpliwości i życzliwości w tej materii.

Za tydzień w sobotę 12 października pamiętajmy też o patriotycznym obowiązku uczestnictwa w wyborach parlamentarnych tutaj w Chicago. Będąc ludźmi wiary brońmy chrześcijańskich wartości oraz krzyża z którym dzisiaj tak wielu walczy! Głosujmy więc zgodnie ze swoimi przekonaniem oraz zgodnie ze swoim sumieniem! A zatem zapraszam wszystkich, którzy mogą głosować do *Domu Podhalan* na ulicy 4808 South Archer Ave. w Chicago w godzinach od 7:00 rano do 9:00 wieczorem.

I na koniec zapraszam wszystkich parafian św. Alberta Wielkiego, modlących się w naszym kościele, przyjaciół i gości z sąsiednich parafii do udziału w pleneryjnym nabożeństwie *Różańcowym* oraz *Procesji Fatimskiej* ulicami naszego miasta Burbank w sobotę 19 października.
