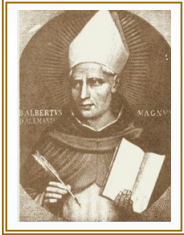

SAINT ALBERT THE GREAT PARISH

A number of families living in Stickney Township went door to door collecting signatures for a request that parish be established in their area to meet peoples spiritual needs. The petition was presented to Cardinal Stritch. He responded by appointing the Pastor of St. Gerald's, Fr. Loras Welsch to investigate. Fr. Welsch arranged for the first Mass to be celebrated at the old Tobin School. He delegated his associate, Fr. Joseph Phelan to care for this new flock. From that point on Mass was celebrated each Sunday at the school.

A business meeting was set for May 9, 1949. The major outcome was the decision to erect a Mission Church with volunteer labor. The construction on the first church was put into the hands of hundred thirty one man of the parish who literally built the church themselves. The crew worked late at night under flood lights. Despite the weather, with the physical help of the temporary Pastor they poured the foundation of the church.

On December 18 the cornerstone was laid. On Christmas Eve, December 24th, 1949 the first Mass was celebrated. The church was completed in 1950 and formally dedicated by Cardinal Stritch on April 29, 1951.

Because of the continued growth of the parish the original church was enlarged in 1954 and 1955. Finally plans for a large, permanent church on the corner of State Road and Central Avenue were presented to the congregation.

The ground breaking ceremony was held on April 19, 1964 and the cornerstone was laid on the Feast of St. Albert the Great, November 15, 1964. The new church was dedicated on October 3, 1966 by Cardinal Cody.

The contemporary church structure is symbolic of the hill on which Christ was crucified with its steps that lead to a free standing altar. The church has a marble background for figure of the crucified Christ with wood paneling on either side. Seats are arranged so that all may feel part of the liturgy. Light from the beautiful stained glass windows produces a soft and inspiring atmosphere.

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

Today is a very special day for our parish community; today we are celebrating the **70th Anniversary** of our beloved parish (1949-2019). I am grateful to the Lord God for our patron the **Saint Albert the Great (1200-1280)**, the bishop and Doctor of the Church. Reading his biography and getting acquainted with his teachings I learned that in a some sense he was a "*prophet for our times*." In today's parish bulletin we can read his spiritual testament, where he points out that as a parish community we should serve people in various aspects of their traditions, cultures and languages. This is a personal message to each one of us! Therefore, as the disciples of Our Lord Jesus and St. Albert the Great we should bring to life this timeless teaching! Let us keep in mind that times are changing, demography of our parish area is changing and we as a community of faith must keep up with the changing times. We are here to serve all the people!

Today I would like to thank our parishioners and all who come to pray in our church for "*being together here and now*." Thank you for participating in many Sacramental ministries in our church. **During the last 70 years of our parish we celebrated 13,509 baptisms. 12,864 children received the Sacrament of First Holy Communion. 11,263 young adults received the Sacrament of Confirmation. 3,982 couples were joined the Sacrament of Matrimony, and 4,629 of our departed loved ones had their funeral Mass celebrated in our church. 177 adults joined the Catholic faith. As of today, our parish has the highest Sunday Mass attendance (4,600) in the Archdiocese of Chicago. Because of this we can be proud of ourselves! This is the great merit for our patron and our parish!**

I also would like to thank parish groups for their special donations made for the benefit of our parish. We are accepting donations for our next year's project, which will be a canopy for our church doors. Today I would like to thank **Kolo #38 Ludzmiarz** for their generous contribution. I invite everyone to financially support this important undertaking. We will acknowledge names of all donors on a special commemorative wall. Let us remember that we are doing all this because of our love for Jesus and His Church. My most sincere thank you goes to **Marie and Ken Shipman, the "Pro Life" group members and several volunteers** who helped to prepare and sell delicious cream pies last weekend. My dearly beloved – you are all exceptional!

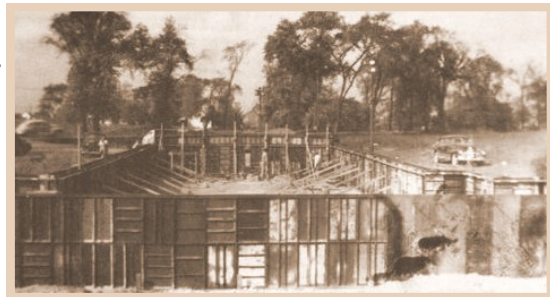

Saint Albert the Great, patron of our parish, was born in 1206. At the age of sixteen, while a student at the University of Padua in northern Italy, he presented himself to enter as a postulant the newly formed Dominican Order, the Friars Preachers. He was formally received into the Order in 1222. In Parish he studied under the great masters until taking his master's degree at the University of Paris. He crowned this achievement with a doctorate in 1245 at the age of 39. He returned again to Cologne where in 1248 encountered his most renowned pupil and protégé, a young Italian friar, Thomas of Aquinas. Albert, during his lifetime, was known as the Universal Doctor because of the breadth of his knowledge and scholarship. Unlike many scholars, Albert never lost touch for practical and administrative affairs. In 1254, he was elected prior provincial of the German province of the Dominicans. He was given the title of "Master of the Apostolic Palace" or more simply, the "Pope's Theologian." Since then this office has always been occupied by a Dominican friar. In 1260 Pope Alexander IV requested that he accept consecration as Bishop of Regensburg with charge of German diocese. Albert died in Cologne on November 15, 1280 sitting among his Dominican colleagues. He was declared Blessed Albert in the 17th Century and was declared Saint and Doctor of the Universal Church by Pope Pius II in 1931 and in 1941, Pius XII declared him patron before God of those who study and probe the natural sciences, a fitting response to a world that was in those very moments of 1941 splitting the atom.

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry!

Dzisiejszy dzień jest wyjątkowy dla naszej wspólnoty parafialnej ponieważ przeżywamy **70 rocznicę** powstania naszej ukochanej parafii (1949-2019). Jestem wdzięczny Panu Bogu, że naszym patronem jest **Święty Albert Wielki (1200-1280), biskup i doktor Kościoła**. Czytając jego życiorys i poznając jego naukę chcę wam powiedzieć, że był On w jakimś sensie „**prorokiem naszych czasów**”. W biuletynie parafialnym możemy bowiem znaleźć jego duchowy testament, w którym zaznaczył, że jako wspólnota parafialna służymy każdemu człowiekowi w różnych jego aspektach min. tradycji, kultury i języka. To jest dokładnie jego przesłanie do każdego z nas! Jako więc uczniowie Pana Jezusa i św. Alberta Wielkiego realizujemy w naszej parafii to ponadczasowe przesłanie! I jestem za to Panu Bogu bardzo wdzięczny! Pamiętajmy też, że czasy się zmieniają, demografia się zmienia i musimy iść jako wspólnota parafialna z biegiem czasu. Mamy być dla ludzi! Służyć ludziom!!!

Chcę wszystkim parafianom i modlącym się w naszym kościele podziękować za „**bycie razem tu i teraz**”. Dziękuję, że tak licznie korzystacie z posługi sakramentalnej w naszym kościele. **Przez 70 lat istnienia naszej parafii sakrament chrztu przyjęło 13,509 dzieci. Sakrament pierwszej Komunii Świętej przyjęło 12,864 osób. Do sakramentu bierzmowania przystąpiło 11,263 osób. Do sakrament małżeństwa przystąpiło 3,982 par. Na miejsce wiecznego spoczynku odprowadziliśmy 4,629 osób. Do wiary katolickiej tzw. „katechumenat” przystąpiło 177 osób dorosłych. Na dzień dzisiejszy parafia św. Alberta Wielkiego w Burbank jest największą parafią katolicką (uczestnictwo w niedzielnych nabożeństwach) w naszej Diecezji Chicago. W każdą niedzielę około 4,600 osób modli się w naszej pięknej świątyni. A zatem możemy być dumni z samych siebie! To wielka zasługa naszego Patrona i wszystkich Was!**

Pragnę też dziś podziękować kolejnym grupom za specjalne donacje dla dobra naszej wspólnoty parafialnej. Rozpoczynamy bowiem zbieranie donacji, które w przyszłym roku zostaną przeznaczone na wybudowanie specjalnego zadaszenia nad głównym wejściem do naszego kościoła. Moje podziękowanie kieruję więc do **Kola nr 38 Ludźmierz.** Wszystkich chętnych zapraszam do zaangażowania się w to wielkie i bardzo potrzebne dzieło. Wszyscy ofiarodawcy będą mieć w przyszłości wybudowaną specjalną ścianę ze swoimi imionami i nazwiskami. Pamiętajmy, że to wszystko robimy z miłości do Jezusa i Jego Kościoła. Dziękuję też **Marii i Kenneth Shipman, grupie „Pro-Life” oraz kilku wolontariuszom** za przygotowanie, pomoc oraz sprzedaż bardzo smacznego „**Albertyńskich Kremówek**” tydzień temu.
