## THIS IS MY BELOVED SON

This Sunday's celebration of the Baptism of the Lord closes the Christmas season. In the scriptures we see one more epiphany, or manifestation, of the Spirit of God in Jesus—but this time it is as an adult, rather than as a child. Jesus' baptism also serves as the inauguration of his prophetic mission and the messianic age.

Today's reading from Isaiah describes God's chosen Messiah, upon whom God's spirit rests. In the Acts of the Apostles Peter says that "God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power" (Acts 10:38). Finally, in the proclamation from Matthew's Gospel Jesus' baptism in water goes almost unnoticed. The crucial moment comes when the Spirit of God comes upon Jesus and a voice from heaven echoes the words of Isaiah: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased" (Matthew 3:17). I like to call all works done in our parish "beautifications and upgrades". Today with a great joy and gratitude I share with you the list of our most recent accomplishments.

**Church**: Jesus with children statues and bench, a special statue dedicated for the unborn children, 70th parish anniversary plaque, two pictures of St. Albert the Great, cleaning of the church and choir pew cushions, purchase of jackets for all ushers, resurfacing of the main parking lot, five new picture holders used in our parish processions, two new pictures of St. Joseph for the "Cry Rooms", new pictures for the church vestibule, restoration of two candle holders, installation of the new alarm system in the church, information signs for all the parish buildings, painting of the front church wall.

St. Albert's Room: new tables and chairs, new concrete entrance stairs and main door to State Road.

**Rogers Hall**: two large refrigerators, fire alarm system, new chairs for bartenders, special beverage refrigerator, new granite bar countertop, new lighting under the granite.

Mrs. Klimek was born in Brighton Park in Chicago. She attended Shields School, Kelly High School, and DePaul University. And did some graduate work at St. Xavier University as well. She is married to the love of her life, John, for 43 years. She has two children, Kristen—who is a physical therapist and is married to Jay, and Jonathan—who is a pharmacist and is married to Kate. She has six grandchildren—4 girls (Annabelle, Genevieve, Corinne and Maeve) and 2 boys (Declan and Everett). They range in age from 7 to 3 months.

Over her lifetime, she has had many wonderful experiences. In grade school, she gave the closing speech at graduation. She was part of the group that went to the Orange Bowl in high school. Diane was also the female representative to go to Washington, DC as the Junior Citizen from the Chicago Park District area 4. And was an Illinois State Scholar, a Pullman Foundation Scholar and a DePaul Scholar. She was part of the PomPom group at DePaul and choreographed a ribbon routine for a basketball halftime game. I've had so many good and wonderful people touch my life. I can only hope that I have touched some of my students' lives in the same way."

Co jakiś czas informuję was na bieżąco o tym wszystkim co udało nam się zrobić w naszej parafii. Te bieżące prace nazywam "*kosmetyką, upiększeniem i ulepszeniem*" wszystkich budynków parafialnych. Dziś z radością i wdzięcznością dzielę się kolejnymi informacjami.

Kościół: nowa figura Pana Jezusa z dziećmi oraz ławka, specjalny mały pomnik dedykowany dzieciom nienarodzonym, specjalna tablica pamiątkowa z okazji 70 rocznicy powstania parafii, 2 obrazy św. Alberta Wielkiego, wyprane poduszki na ławkach w kościele oraz na chórze, zakupiono jednakowe marynarki dla wszystkich marszałków, wymalowany pierwszy parking, nowe feletrony (5), dwa nowe obrazy św.
