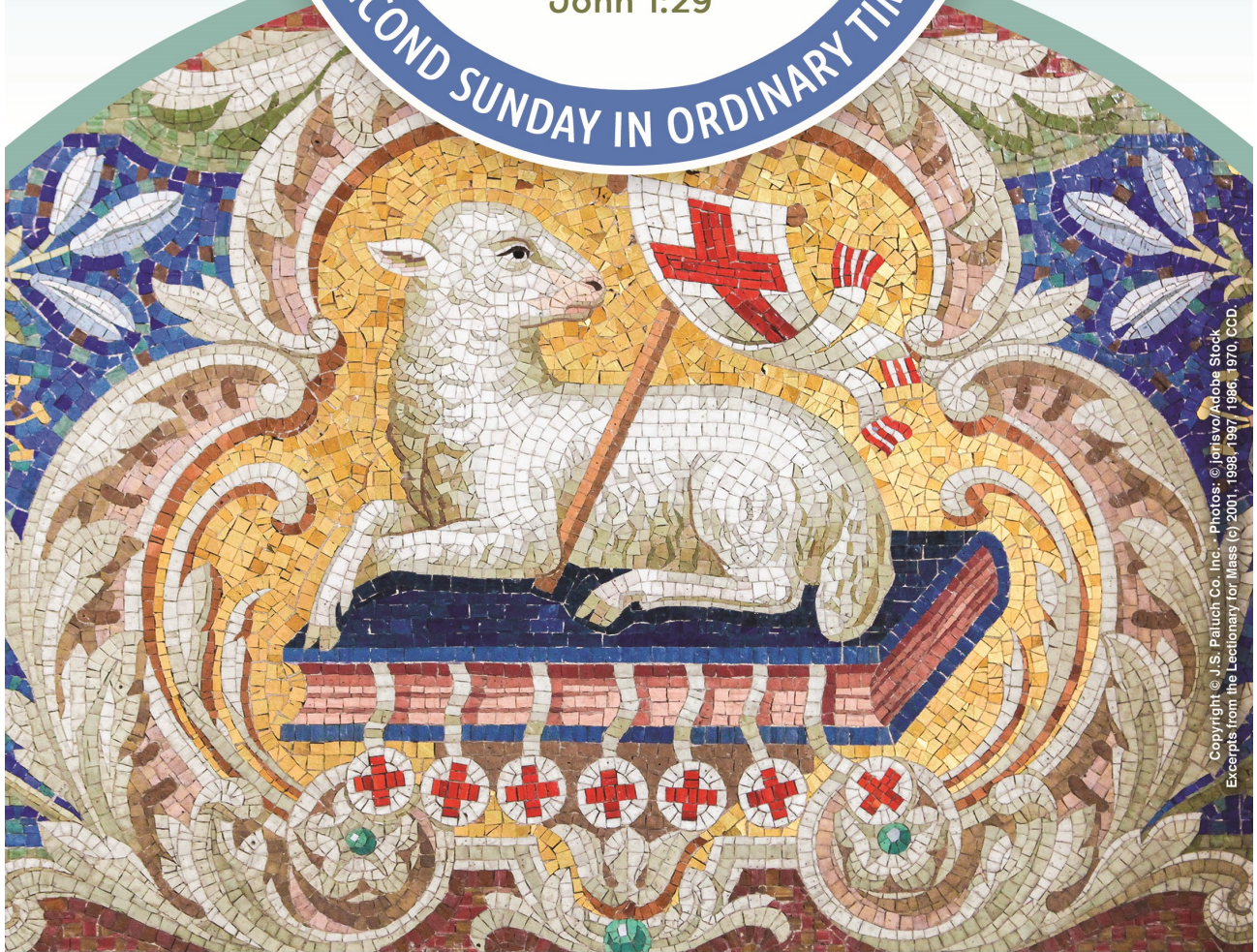

Every five years, pastors in the Diocese of Chicago is a subject to an objective assessment of the "**Evaluation process**". Representatives of the parish council, associate pastors, religious sisters, parish workers and parishioners are asked to assess the work of the pastor. This process is needed, among other things, to recommend improvement in the future of the pastoral work and to be more effective. My future here or in another parish also depends on this assessment and your opinions. I thank you from all my heart for your prayer, kindness, understanding, objectivity and fair assessment. Below you can read a special letter on this matter by bishop Andrew Wypych.

Your Pastor, Fr. Mariusz Nawalaniec, is participating in the Catholic Leadership 360 Review process. This review is part of the ordinary structure required by Archdiocesan Policy of every diocesan priest approximately every five years. It is an opportunity for Fr. Nawalaniec to recognize his talents and to grow to become a better priest and pastoral minister. Selected members of the parish staff and parish leadership, your Dean, and I will be asked to be reviewers using this instrument.

Archdiocesan policies also state that parish lay leadership and parishioners be given the opportunity to recognize Fr. Mariusz Nawalaniec gifts and to share their sentiments about his ministry. So, we are providing a parish-wide survey as part of his review process. The survey can be easily accessed by going to the Archdiocese's web page (<https://www.archchicago.org/>) and clicking on Offices and Ministries, located on the top panel. This will bring you to an alphabetical listing of offices. Under 'M', select Ministerial Resources for Parishes which will take you to our website. In the middle of the page, you will find "Parish-wide survey for priests". Please click on the word 'Link' next to your appropriate language to access the survey. The survey is available in English, Spanish, and Polish.

If you have any concerns or comments pertaining to father's review, feel free to contact me directly. If you have any further questions or suggestions about the review process, you may contact Fr. Bob Heidenreich, Coordinator of the Ministerial Review and Priest Programs at 312-534-5237.

When the Catholic Leadership 360 Review process has been completed Fr. Nawalaniec will be sked to share the insights he has received and his further developmental plans with you in the parish bulletin and on the parish web site.

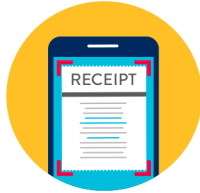
