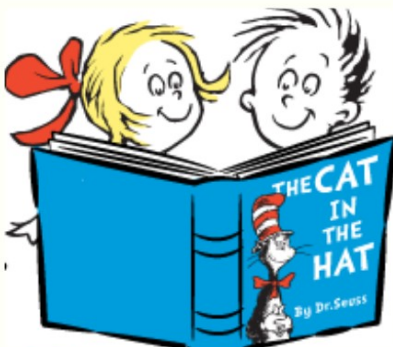

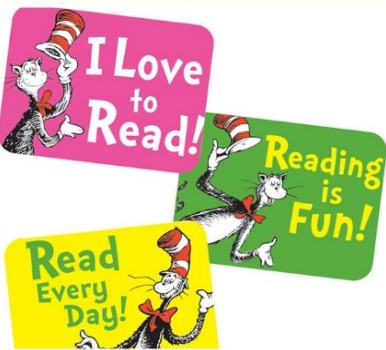

### Moi Kochani Bracia i Siostry!

Przed nami wyczekiwany okres **Wielkiego Postu**. Zaczynamy go w najbliższą środę 26 lutego. Tego dnia w Popielec posypiemy nasze głowy popiołem na znak nawrócenia i zadośćuczynienia za nasze grzechy. W biuletynie parafialnym znajdziemy dokładny rozkład wszystkich nabożeństw na które was gorąco zapraszam. Zapraszam dzieci i młodzież, zapraszam całe rodziny i starszych. Zapraszam parafian i gości z całej okolicy. Pamiętajcie także o nabożeństwach pasyjnych **Drogi Krzyżowej** w piątki dla starszych (godz. 7:00 wieczorem) i w środy dla dzieci (godz. 5:30 po południu). W każdą niedzielę Wielkiego Postu o godz. 4:30 po południu zapraszam całymi rodzinami do udziału w pięknym polskim nabożeństwie **Gorzkich Żali**. **Zapamiętajcie też tę datę 4 kwietnia godz. 7:00 wieczorem Droga Krzyżowa ulicami naszego miasta Burbank**. 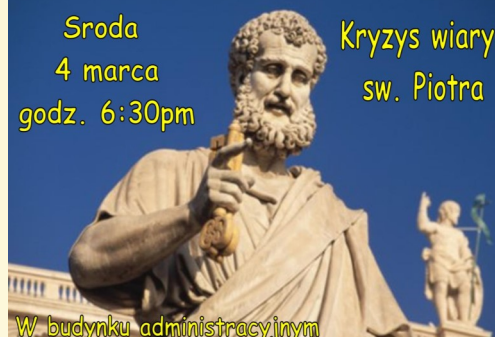
