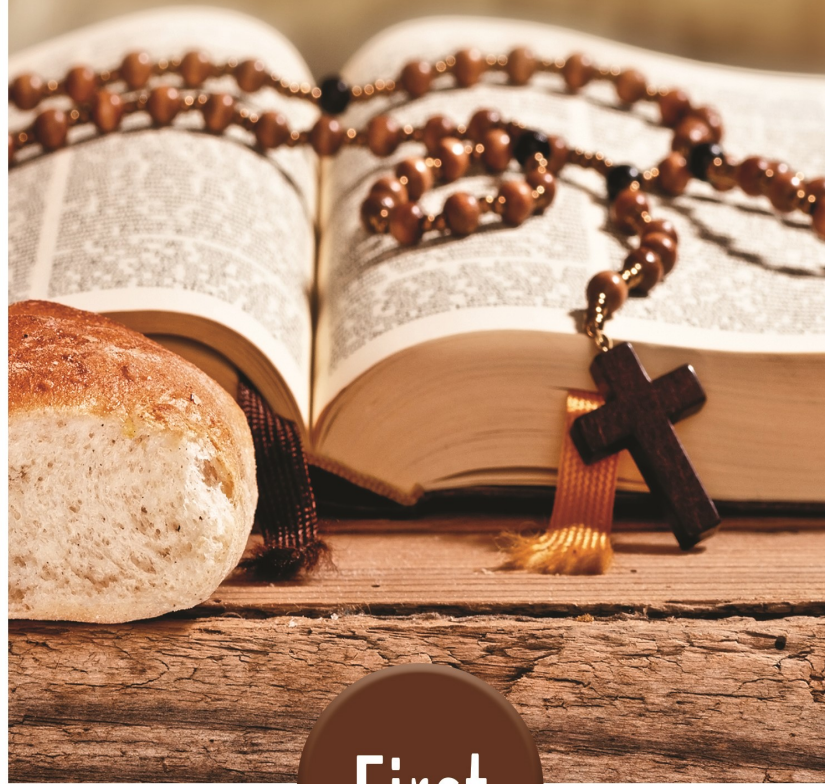

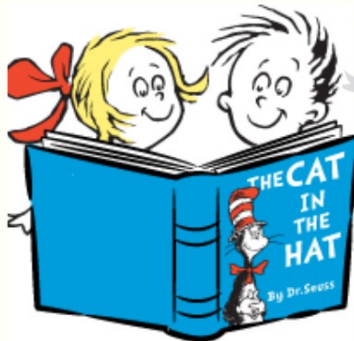

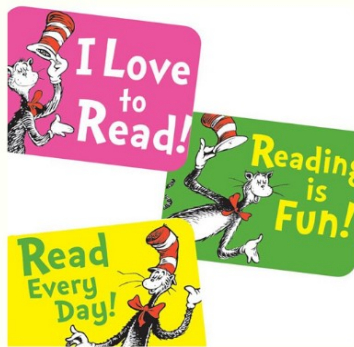

Zaczęło się! Nareszcie! Trwa Święty czas **Wielkiego Postu**. Czas modlitwy, nawrócenia, jałmużny i czas pełnienia dobrych uczynków. Dziękuję Wam za bardzo liczny udział w nabożeństwach Środy Popielcowej. Zapraszam Was z całymi rodzinami na kolejne pasyjne nabożeństwa **Drogi Krzyżowej** w piątki oraz nabożeństwo Gorzkich Żali w niedziele. 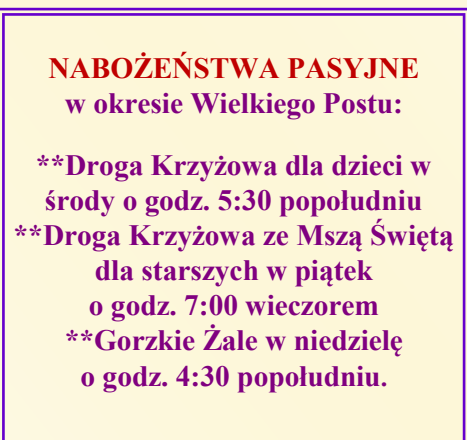
