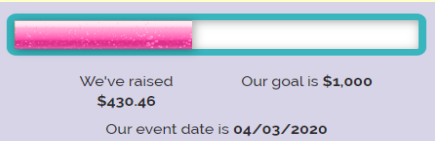

## Z biurka Ks. Proboszcza

### Moi Kochani Bracia i Siostry!

Trwa święty czas **Wielkiego Postu**. Czas modlitwy, nawrócenia, jałmużny i czas pełnienia dobrych uczynków. Jest to czas duchowego wzrostu w wierze, nadziei i miłości. Chyba nikt z was nie może narzekać na brak możliwości do wspólnotowej czy indywidualnej modlitwy w naszej parafii. Dziękuję wszystkim parafianom i gościom za liczny udział w naszych nabożeństwach pasyjnych Drogi Krzyżowej w poniedziałki, środy i piątki oraz w nabożeństwach Gorzkich Żali w niedzielę.

Cieszę się bardzo, że w naszej parafii dbamy nie tylko o zewnętrzny wygląd naszego kościoła, ale przede wszystkim dbamy o duchowy wzrost naszej wspólnoty. Dla przykładu podam, że tylko w ostatnim tygodniu w naszej parafii celebrowaliśmy 26 różnych nabożeństw w trzech różnych językach. To co jest przed nami poniżej jest też przykładem duchowej troski o waszą duszę i serca!

Naszą modlitwą ogarnijmy młodzież naszej parafii oraz naszych polskich szkół, która **4 kwietnia przyjmie Sakrament Bierzmowania** z rąk ks. biskupa Andrzeja Wypych.

Zapamiętajcie już dziś także tę datę **4 kwietnia godz. 7:00 wieczorem Droga Krzyżowa ulicami naszego miasta Burbank**. To piękne nabożeństwo rozpoczniemy na parkingu Tobin Elementary School. Zapraszam do jak najliczniejszego udziału w publicznym wyznaniu naszej wiary świętej.

W dniach od **29 marca** (V Niedziela Wielkiego Postu) aż do **1 kwietnia** (środa) będziemy przeżywać w naszej parafii **rekolekcje wielkopostne** na które również gorąco wszystkich zapraszam!

**Spowiedź przed wielkanocą** z udziałem licznie zaproszonych księży odbędzie się w **poniedziałek 6 kwietnia od godz. 5:00 do 6:30 wieczorem (po angielsku) oraz w Wielką Środę od godz. 11:00 rano do 1:00 po południu i od godz. 6:00 do 9:00 w nocy (po angielsku, polsku i hiszpańsku)**.

Czas **Wielkiego Postu** to także w naszej parafii czas bycia razem na tzw. „**obiadach rybnych**”. Te obiady cieszą się ogromną popularnością, gromadzą nie tylko naszych parafian, ale i gości z całej południowej strony Chicago. Jest to tzw. „**social time**”, czas bycia razem, czas rozmów, czas dzielenia się swoimi radościami i smutkami. Gorąco was wszystkich zapraszam. Istnieje też możliwość zamówienia obiadów rybnych na wynos. Przez ostatnie trzy piątki zostało sprzedane ponad **2,400 obiadów!!!** Czekamy na **WAS!!!**

W dalszym ciągu zachęcam poszczególne grupy parafialne oraz wszystkich naszych parafian i modlących się w naszym kościele do zaangażowania się w projekt budowy specjalnego zadaszania nad głównymi drzwiami do kościoła. Wszystkich chętnych proszę o kontakt ze mną lub z kancelarią parafialną. Z wielką radością dziękuję dziś kolejnym ofiarodawcom: **Koło # 54 Kościelisko-Polaniorze i Ludwina & Piotr Strama**.

W swojej pracy duszpasterskiej staram się zawsze kierować przede wszystkim duchową troską o powierzonych mi parafian oraz modlących się w naszym kościele. Widzicie sami, że każda grupa etniczna ma na przykład „**swojego księdza, mówiącego w ich własnym języku**”. To samo dotyczy będzie w niedalekiej przyszłości muzyki liturgicznej w czasie naszych nabożeństw. Obecna niełatwa sytuacja z organistami jest tylko tymczasową i wymaga kilku poprawek nad którymi już pracuję. Dziękuję jednocześnie za wyrozumiałość i cierpliwość w tej materii.

Bardzo was wszystkich proszę o respektowanie zaleceń sanitarnych w związku z epidemią „**koronawirusa**”. Bądźmy czujni i ostrożni!

Na koniec chcę podziękować wszystkim tym, którzy uczestniczyli w mojej „**ewaluacji proboszczowskiej**”. **Wypadła ona wzorowo!** Dziękuję za bardzo dobre, liczne i życzliwe opinie. Obiecuję, że nadal z gorliwością i radością młodzieńczą będę **WAM** służyć jak najlepiej potrafię! Cieszę się, że wspólnie przyjdzie nam spędzić kolejne lata w naszej kwitnącej wspólnotie parafialnej. Pamiętajcie zawsze i wszędzie, że jest to nasz wspólny drugi „**DOM**”!
