From the ARCHDIOCESE OF CHICAGO

Pastors are still urged to encourage the faithful to receive in the hand, as it is the safest way to distribute / receive Holy Communion. However, out of respect for those who insist on receiving on the tongue and with the hope of avoiding conflicts at this most sacred time of the Holy Mass, an exception may be made in a given parish at the full discretion of the pastor, and only in accord with a strict observance of the procedure provided here.

Procedure for Distributing Holy Communion on the Tongue:

Parishes are to establish a dedicated station for those receiving Holy Communion on the tongue, separate from those coming to receive communion in the hand;

Communicants move forward to the designated station in single file maintaining six feet between each person assisted by markers on the floor;

The minister distributing Holy Communion wearing a mask/face shield, sanitizes his / her hands, either from a nearby table, or offered by an usher;

The communicant sanitizes his/her hands from a table or from sanitizer offered by usher, removes the strap of the mask or face covering from one ear, letting it hang from the other ear and exercises care not to touch the face, clothing or any other surface after sanitizing the hands;

After having sanitized his/her hands, the communicant approaches the priest or extraordinary minister, and receives the Host on the tongue;

The communicant steps six feet to the side, replaces the mask over the mouth and nose and returns to his/her seat;

It should be observed from the outset that more care and time will be required in implementing this exception, as communion on the tongue poses additional health risks to both the minister and the communicant. Out of regard for specific health protocols, this process may not be rushed, particularly the sanitizing and drying of the minister’s hands between communicants.

ON SAM JEST NAGRODĄ


Może i dobrze, że prawdopodobnie nikt nie przeprowadził badań ukazujących, o co ludzie proszą Pana Boga. Ale często podczas sprawowanych Mszy Świętych słyszmy prośby o zdrowie, o powodzenie podczas egzaminu, o zgodę w rodzinie, o trzeźwość i wiele, wiele innych spraw.

Z Pisma Świętego zapewne pamiętamy choćby wspaniałą modlitwę Salomona o mądrość w rządzeniu narodem

wybranym (1 Krl 3, 11nn), o błogosławieństwo z Księgi Liczb (Lb 6, 24), wiele prośb o zwycięstwo nad wrogami.

Dzisiaj mamy rzadką okazję, by wysuchać pięknej lekcji o modlitwie, w której prosimy o obecność Pana Boga w naszym życiu. Mądrość Boga jest wartością wyższą niż wszystko na ziemi (I czytanie), słowo Boga jest darem, który pomaga dobrze decydować i wybierać: przyjmować dobro i odrzucać зло (II czytanie), wolność od tego, co materialne, jest warunkiem swobodnego pójścia za Chrystusem (Ewangelia).

Oczywiście, nie znaczy to, że nie mamy prosić o to, co potrzebne jest w naszej codzienności, przeciwnie, warto, a nawet trzeba wypowiadać z ufnością przed Panem Bogiem to wszystko, co jest naszą bolączką, problemem, potrzebą. Ale też warto zauważać, że nieraz podczas wypowiadania prośby otwierają się nasze oczy i dzięki temu otwarciu możemy zauważać coś znacznie ważniejszego niż to, o co prosiliśmy. No i trzeba pamiętać, że Pan Bóg uważnie słucha tego, co mówimy, ale nie wszystkie prośby spełnia tak, jak my byśmy tego pragnęli.
