SAINT THÉRÈSE OF THE CHILD JESUS (1873-1897) October 1



"The cornerstone's dated 1872, but the stained glass is much later," explained the pastor, astonished when his visitor accurately dated it to just before the Great Depression, explaining, "The window for the Little Flower"—Thérèse's nickname—"gives it away." From her canonization in 1925, her statues and windows adorn most churches where European immigrants worshiped. Entering Carmel at fifteen, victim of tuberculosis at twenty-four, Thérèse proposed her "Little Way" to sanctity: doing ordinary tasks with extraordinary love. Thus ordinary Catholics, many of whom had lost loved ones to tuberculosis, embraced her. Though she never left her cloister, this Carmelite's spiritual communion and devoted correspondence with missionaries earned her the title Patroness of Missions. Her autobiography, *Story of a Soul*, continuously in print since her death, chronicles her prayerful perseverance through doubt and caused her to be the youngest person ever named a Doctor of the Church. Countless physical healings and spiritual conversions testify to her fulfillment of her deathbed promise: "After my death, I will let fall a shower of roses. 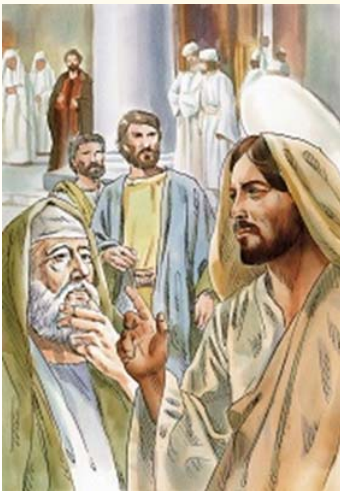

BÓG INNY NIŻ MY

My, ludzie, doświadczamy kruchości własnych postaw. Często w trudnych sytuacjach sprawdza się, jak głęboko zakorzenione jest w człowieku dobro lub zło. Czasem dziwimy się, jak dany człowiek mógł przejść z jednej skrajności w drugą. Zachwycamy się spektakularnymi nawróceniami i smucimy z równie spektakularnych upadków. Jak wiele może się zmienić w człowieku pod wpływem jego doświadczeń! Dzisiejsza liturgia słowa mówi: nic nie



jest raz na zawsze przesądzone, jeśli chodzi o kondycję duchową człowieka... A Pan Bóg jest wierny i niezmienny w miłości.

Dzisiejsze czytania zdaje się łączyć jedna myśl: Bóg jest całkowicie inny niż my. Prawda na pozór oczywista. A gdybyśmy naprawdę ją przyjęli i zaczęli naśladować Pana Jezusa? Każdy z ludzi chce być kimś, a Chrystus – Bóg Człowiek – jako jedyny nie korzysta z tej sposobności, choć to właśnie On ma do tego prawo. Jezus jako Bóg ogołocił się z Bóstwa, a jako Człowiek uniżył się w swoim człowieczeństwie aż do końca. Stał się naprawdę najmniejszy aż do całkowitej utraty siebie samego, czyli do śmierci. Przyjął Bożą logikę – za Jego łaską – to kierować się zasadami odwrotnymi, niż podpowiada „świat”. Duchowymi oczami widzimy, że im trudniej, tym lepiej, jak mawiali św. Ignacy czy św. Teresa Wielka. Po co aż tak? By doświadczyć, że życie to dar Ojca.

Dzisiejsza Ewangelia pokazuje, że gdy człowiek stawia na słowa, Bóg patrzy na czyny, bo po zaangażowaniu woli rozpoznaje serce człowieka.
