October is the month of the Rosary. Through the intercession of **“Mary, Our Lady of the Rosary”** let us pray in the following intentions:

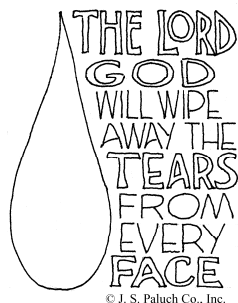
- for an end to the Covid-19 epidemic;

SAINT TERESA OF JESUS (1515-1582) October 15

Let nothing disturb you; let nothing frighten you. Gifted with a passionate spirit, young Teresa dreamed of



converting Muslims and becoming a martyr. *All things are passing; God never changes.* But her mother’s death when Teresa was fourteen inspired lifelong devotion to Our Lady, and Teresa entered the Carmelites, Mary’s order, despite her father’s objections and her own fragile health. *Patience gains everything.* Initially, she enjoyed her lax convent’s sociability and “busyness,” but mystical prayer and John of the Cross’s collaboration inspired her to reform the Carmelites. *Whoever has God, lacks nothing.* When her ideals encountered resistance and brought suffering, she maintained her peace—and humor. Discovered devouring leftovers, she told her mildly scandalized nuns, “When I fast, I fast! When I eat, I eat!” To nuns demanding less work and more prayer in the convent schedule, she retorted: “What we really need around here are fewer starry eyes and more strong arms!” *God alone is enough!* The italicized sentences here are her “Breviary Bookmark,” the simple, profound prayer of Teresa, the first woman Doctor of the Church. —Peter Scagnelli, Copyright © J. 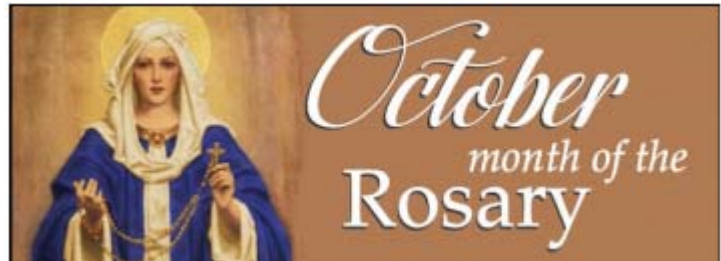

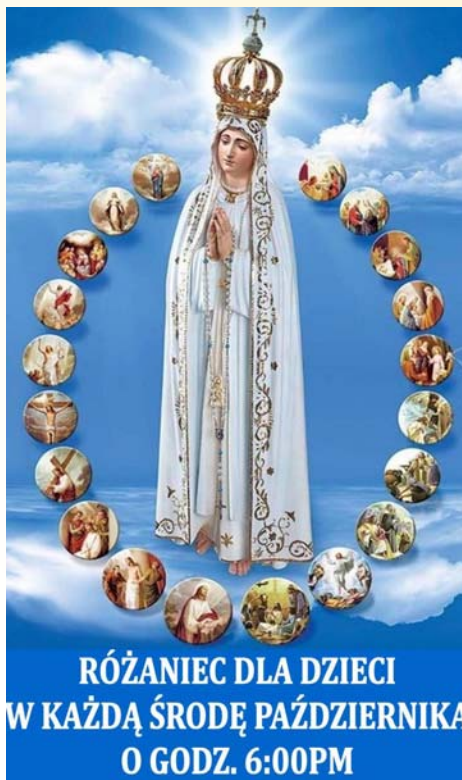
- o ustanie pandemii wirusa Covid-19;

On Sam jest Nagrodą

Może i dobrze, że prawdopodobnie nikt nie przeprowadził badań ukazujących, o co ludzie proszą Pana Boga. Ale często podczas sprawowanych Mszy Świętych słyszymy prośby o zdrowie, o powodzenie podczas egzaminu, o zgodę w rodzinie, o trzeźwość i wiele, wiele innych spraw. Pisma Świętego zapewne pamiętamy choćby wspaniałą modlitwę Salomona o mądrość w rządzeniu narodem wybranym, o błogosławieństwo z Księgi Liczb, wiele próśb o zwycięstwo nad wrogami. Dzisiaj mamy rzadką okazję, by wysłuchać pięknej lekcji o modlitwie, w której prosimy o obecność Pana Boga w naszym życiu. Mądrość Boga jest wartością wyższą niż wszystko na ziemi (I czytanie), słowo Boga jest darem, który pomaga dobrze decydować i wybierać: przyjmować dobro i odrzucać zło (II czytanie), wolność od tego, co materialne, jest warunkiem swobodnego pójścia za Chrystusem (Ewangelia). Oczywiście, nie znaczy to, że nie mamy prosić o to, co potrzebne jest w naszej codzienności, przeciwnie, warto, a nawet trzeba wypowiadać z ufnością przed Panem Bogiem to wszystko, co jest naszą bolączką, problemem, potrzebą. Ale też warto zauważyć, że nieraz podczas wypowiedzania prośby otwierają się nasze oczy i dzięki temu otwarciu możemy zauważyć coś znacznie ważniejszego niż to, o co prosiliśmy. No i trzeba pamiętać, że Pan Bóg uważnie słucha tego, co mówimy, ale nie wszystkie prośby spełnia tak, jak my byśmy tego pragnęli. Miał rację święty Ignacy, który prosił, by Pan Bóg zabrał mu wszystkie zdolności, pamięć i talenty, a dał sobie, swą obecność. To naprawdę wystarczy! ks. Zbigniew Kaplański
