## **I** Confess

One form of the penitential rite at the beginning of Mass is the traditional Confiteor, or "I confess," a prayer that was formerly prayed by the priest alone at the foot of the altar, but which is now prayed by the entire assembly. The Confiteor is at once personal—"I confess"—and communal, prayed aloud, together. We recognize that sin does not just separate us from God; sin comes between us and others, isolating us. We acknowledge that sin has many dimensions, individual and communal: sins of thought, sins of speech, sins of action, sins of omission. Sin is not something that happens to us; sin is something we do. In the Confiteor, we take responsibility for our own actions. The repeated insistence on our "fault," with the ritual gesture of striking the breast, an ancient sign of penitence, is not meant to lower our self-esteem. Rather, it acknowledges our human instinct to transfer the blame whenever we can ("The devil made me do it!"). This prayer stops us short. We take responsibility for ourselves, our actions, our failure to act. Then we cry out to God in those ancient words, Kyrie, eleison-Lord, have mercy. For the sinner who repents, there is mercy. This truth is at the heart of our faith, and it is where the Mass, our feast of faith, begins. -Corinna Laughlin, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

## FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE OF CHICAGO

Over the past several months, the groupings' Feedback and Discernment Teams, made up of representatives from each of the parishes and schools met to discern the future parish, school and church structures for their respective areas. Based on their meetings and discussions with the larger parish communities, they submitted feedback reports to the Archdiocesan Standards and Recommendations Commission, which includes representatives from across the archdiocese. The commission reviewed the feedback reports and other materials and information, including demographic data, financial summaries, and parish and grouping trends. Over the course of the past several weeks, Cardinal Blase J. Cupich, archbishop of Chicago, the archdiocese's auxiliary bishops and Presbyteral Council discussed the commission's recommendations. Based on those discussions and prayerful consideration, the following decisions have been made: **Oak Lawn, Burbank, Bridgeview Grouping**. The Oak Lawn, Burbank, Bridgeview Renew My Church grouping includes the following parishes and schools: St. Albert the Great Parish and School (Burbank), St. Fabian Parish (Bridgeview), St. Gerald Parish and School (Oak Lawn), St. Louis de Montfort Parish (Oak Lawn)

**The new structure will be:** Effective July 1, 2021, St. Louis de Montfort will close and its parishioners are invited to join any of the neighboring parishes. The patrimony (financial assets and physical property) of St. Louis de Montfort will be shared equally among St. Albert the Great, St. Fabian and St. Gerald. St. Gerald will manage the campus and lead the process for deciding the future of the campus. Other than these changes, St. Albert the Great, St. Fabian and St. Gerald parishes will remain in their current structure, including pastors. The Commission recommends St. Louis de Montfort wind down its ministry by June 30, 2021, including a final regularly scheduled Mass.

Operations at the current parish schools (St. Albert the Great and St. Gerald) will remain the same.

## FALSE PROPHETS, TRUE PROPHETS

In Deuteronomy today we hear that God's very words will fill the mouth of a true prophet, but a false prophet will, in a manner of speaking, put mere mortal words into God's mouth. In Mark's Gospel, we see Jesus teaching and healing as a true prophet, one filled with the authority of God's own voice, the Holy One of God. The whole history of our church is filled with both true and false prophets. But in today's Gospel we learn that Jesus' fame spread because he taught with authority; he wasn't an authority because he was popular or famous. We also learn from him, in his desert temptation confrontations with Satan, that anyone can quote scripture, even against God's purposes. And today we hear that his authority was not like that of the scribes, who held the official positions of religious authority in his day. Our work is to do our best to discern the true prophets in our midst, and to be true prophets as well. The psalmist tells us how to do this: by not hardening our hearts when God speaks. If we truly listen to God, it will be God's very words filling our mouths. Paluch Co.

#### Etap rozeznawania

Jesienią 2020 roku, w ramach inicjatywy Odnów Mój Kościół parafie św. Alberta Wielkiego, św. Fabiana, św. Geralda i św. Ludwika de Montfort zaangażowały się w proces rozeznawania. Komisja ds. Rozeznawania i Opinii, w skład której weszli członkowie z każdej parafii, spotkała się, aby omówić i rozeznać przyszłe struktury parafii na naszym obszarze. Wyrazy podziękowania kierowane są pod adresem Komisji ds. Rozeznawania i Opinii, która podczas tego trudnego momentu. rozeznawała na modlitwie strukture parafii w grupie.

Kardynał Cupich i biskup Wypych składają swoje podziękowania księżom Nawalaniec, ks. Warmuz, ks. Pajor, ks. Stuglik, grupom, które spotykały się w ciągu ostatnich kilku miesięcy, oraz wszystkim prafianom, którzy zgłaszali swoje uwagi w procesie rozeznawania.

#### Decyzja

W ciągu ostatnich kilku tygodni, kardynał Błażej J. Cupich, arcybiskup Chicago, archidiecezjalni biskupi pomocniczy oraz archidiecezjalna rada prezbiterialna spotkali się, aby zapoznać się z zaleceniami komisji. W wyniku dyskusji oraz modlitewnego rozważenia, kardynał Cupich podjął następującą decyzję dotyczącą struktury parafii na terenie Oak Lawn, Bridgeview i Burbank.

- Obowiązuje od 1 lipca 2021 r, Kościół św. Ludwika de Montfort zostanie zamknięty i nie będzie funkcjonować jako niezależna parafia. Zachęca się wiernych do zapisania się do sąsiednich parafii.
  - Majątek (aktywa finansowe i własność fizyczna), parafii św. Ludwika będzie po równo podzielone pomiędzy parafie św. Alberta Wielkiego, św. Fabiana i św. Geralda.
  - Parafia św. Geralda będzie zarządzać kościołem i zadecyduje do przyszłości obiektu.
- Poza tymi zmianami parafie św. Alberta Wielkiego, św. Fabiana i św. Geralda pozostaną w dotychczasowej strukturze, w tym z duszpasterskim kierownictwem ks. Nawalaniec, ks. Warmuz i ks. Pajor
- Komisja zaleca parafii św. Ludwika de Montfort wygaszenie duszpasterstwa, z regularnie odprawianymi mszami św. włacznie, do 30 czerwca.
- Szkoły przy parafiach (św. Alberta Wielkiego i św. Geralda) pozostaną w obecnym kształcie i konfiguracji.
- Istnieje potrzeba duszpasterstwa w języku hiszpańskim. Archidiecezjalna Rada Mianowania Księży zostanie poproszona o zarekomendowanie wikariusza, który będzie mógł sprostać tym potrzebom w obrębie grupy.

#### Uzasadnienie decyzji

- Podczas procesu rozeznawania stało się jasne, że utrzymanie kościoła św. Ludwika de Montfort nie będzie możliwe.
- Opierając się na danych przedstawionych Komisji, równy podział parafii św. Ludwika de Montfort będzie również wiązał się z tym do której parafii przejdą parafianie.
- Komisja ufa, że nowy układ będzie wspierać silne duszpasterstwo w środowisku, co w efekcie będzie prowadzić do stabilności i trwałości pozostałych parafii.
