## FEAST OF FAITH Little Mysteries



Two small rites—or, as one liturgist has called them, “little mysteries”—accompany the preparation of the gifts. The priest or deacon takes a small cruet of water from the server and adds a drop of water to the wine. Then, after the elevation of the chalice (and the incensation, if incense is used), the priest washes his hands. Both of these actions were at first practical, matter-of-fact realities: in the ancient world the wine was usually quite thick, and was generally mixed with water before it was drunk. And in the early church, when the faithful brought forward a great variety of gifts at this time, there was a definite need for the presider to wash his hands!

But now these rites serve a purely symbolic function. The mingling of the water and wine is accompanied by a prayer that speaks of the wonderful exchange of the Mass, the mingling of Christ’s divinity and our humanity. And as the priest washes his hands, he prays words of supplication from Psalm 51, acknowledging his own sinfulness in the presence of the assembly before he dares to approach the altar for this most sacred action. 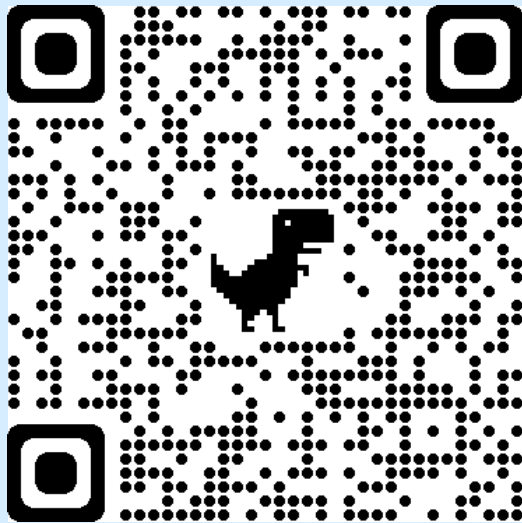

### ZLEKCEWAŻONY PROROK

Dla wielu prorokowanie jest odniesieniem do przyszłości i często dotyczy jakiś niezwykłych wydarzeń. Choć proroctwo kieruje nasze myśli i działania ku przyszłości, to swojej mocy i autentyczności nabiera w czasie teraźniejszym. Tak też było w życiu ludzi współczesnych Jezusowi, kiedy jako Bóg-Człowiek pełnił misję ziemską. Czynił to przez głoszenie Słowa Bożego jak wszyscy prorocy biblijni. Potwierdzał to niezwykłymi znakami i cudami, które działy wśród ludu. Jednak pycha żywota zamknęła serca ludzkie na znaki Bożej dobroci, a nadto odrzuciła Boże orędzie zbawienia. Być może była to zwykła ludzka zazdrość. Jednak zazdrość nie jest czymś zwyczajnym, gdyż jej działanie jest często ślepe i irracjonalne. Może naprawdę sprowadzić każdego z nas na manowce życia. Nie powinno się jej lekceważyć. Serce skore do słuchania i otwarte na Słowo Boga jest lekarstwem na złą, a nawet śmiertelną zazdrość. Prorocy ukazują prawdziwą i sprawiedliwą drogę Pańską. Nieprzyjęcie Jezusa Proroka i Jego wysłanników proroków sprzyja błądzeniu i traceniu prawdziwego szczęścia, które jest w Bogu. Słowo Boga zostaje zastąpione słowami czysto ludzkimi. A może nawet dojść do gorszego stanu, gdy ciemności opanują serce z powodu braku słowa Boga, wówczas w sercu rodzi się nienawiść i agresja. Tak też to miało miejsce w spotkaniu Jezusa ze „swoimi” w Nazarecie. Wnieśmy zatem nasze oczy ku Bogu i prosimy z wiarą Ducha Świętego, aby słowa proroctwa Bożego były światłem i lampą na ścieżce naszego życia!
