## SACRIFICE

Today the Church focuses on the Eucharist. Today's readings remind us how connected to ancient blood sacrifices we are when offering our unbloody sacrifice. The reading from Exodus describes a solemn ritual designed so the Israelites would never forget their covenant with God.

The reading from the Letter to the Hebrews turns us from those ancient animal sacrifices, the first efforts to worship the living God. Our sacrifice is the body and blood of the Son of God. Because of Christ we have a new covenant.

The Gospel from Mark retells the establishment of that covenant, the familiar story of the Last Supper. Juxtaposed with the story of animal sacrifice as it is here, we are challenged to listen with new attention, to remember the great price paid for our salvation. Jesus gave his body and every drop of his blood for us.

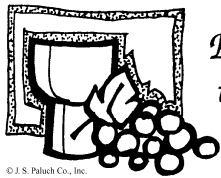
## From the Pastor's Desk

*My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!*

Today the entire Catholic Church, as well as our beloved parish observes the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) Sunday**. Corpus Christi Sunday was celebrated for the first time in Liege (Belgium), in 1246 and in 1317 was established as a Catholic Holiday for the entire Church. On this day the faithful participate in a procession to four altars, which are located in the vicinity of the church.

Corpus Christi procession creates an opportunity for us to profess the presence of the Eucharistic Jesus and it is our plea to Jesus to lead us through our lives. During the procession we stop at each of the four altars to read fragment from the Gospel. The number „four” symbolizes the four Gospels and the four directions of the world. I kindly invite you to participate in the procession after the 1:30 pm Mass.

I encourage you to pray the Litany to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, who is full of goodness and love. May we all learn goodness from God and share it with all our brothers and sisters in Christ.

### **FEAST OF FAITH** The *Corpus Christi* Procession

In the thirteenth century, a Belgian nun by the name of Juliana had a vision: she saw the full moon silvery and radiant except for one dark spot. The meaning of the vision was revealed to her: the moon was the Church’s liturgical year, the dark spot a missing feast in honor of the Blessed Sacrament. Today’s feast of *Corpus Christi*—the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ—grew from Juliana’s vision.

On this feast, many parishes observe the traditional *Corpus Christi* procession, giving honor to the Eucharist by carrying this greatest treasure out of the safety of our churches and into our streets. At the end of every Mass we are not just let out, we are sent forth, strengthened by the Eucharist, to be the Body of Christ in the world. The *Corpus Christi* procession is the dismissal writ large! We take Jesus with us, not only in our hearts, but carried in our midst and exposed in a monstrance. It is a public profession of faith and a blessing of the world. Jesus walks with us on these streets that we walk day after day, among those who know him but yearn to know him better, and among those who do not know him. 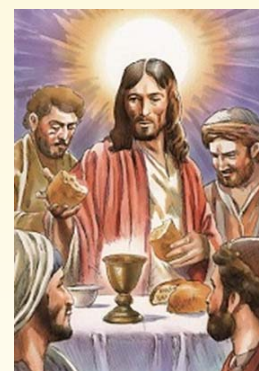
## Z biurka Ks. Proboszcza

**Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście !**

Dziś w Kościele Katolickim i w naszej ukochanej parafii obchodzimy **Niedzielę Bożego Ciała**. Pierwszy raz **Boże Ciało** było obchodzone w 1246 roku w Liege (Belgia), a w 1317 roku zostało ustanowione świętem dla całego Kościoła Zachodniego. W tym dniu wierni biorą udział w procesji do czterech ołtarzy, które umieszczone są w sąsiedztwie kościoła. Procesja ma w założeniu dać możliwość publicznego wyznawania wiary w obecność Jezusa Eucharystycznego i jest formą prośby żeby Pan Jezus przez życie nas prowadził. W trakcie procesji wierni zatrzymują się przy czterech ołtarzach, przy którym odczytuje się fragment Ewangelii. Liczba „cztery” jest symbolem czterech Ewangelii oraz czterech stron świata. Serdecznie więc zapraszamy wszystkich do udziału w procesji eucharystycznej po Mszy Świętej o godz. 1:30 po południu.

Zachęcam także, aby w miesiącu czerwcu odmawiać Litanię do Serca Pana Jezusa, które jest dobroci i miłości pełne. Tej miłości i dobroci uczmy się od Boga i dawajmy te cnoty naszym bliskim.

### **Boże Ciało bliżej niż myślisz**

Jałmużnik papieski, ksiądz abp Konrad Krajewski w rekolekcjach dla kapłanów poświęconych kapłaństwu i miłosierdziu opowiedział pewną historię, która przy okazji dzisiejszej uroczystości może poruszyć nasze serca. Jego historia dotyczyła Świętej Matki Teresy z Kalkuty. Pewien dziennikarz śledził ją cały dzień. Widział, jak chodziła po ulicach, odnajdywała bezdomnych. Bardzo wielu z nich wyciągała wprost ze śmietników. Liczni mieli ciała oszpecone przez choroby. Bez rąk, bez nóg odnajdowali w Świętej anioła przysłanego od Boga. W pewnej chwili dziennikarz nie wytrzymał i powiedział starszej już siostrze: „Matko, żeby mi dawano milion dolarów, ja bym tego nigdy nie zrobił”. A święta z rozbrajającą szczerością i bezżębnym uśmiechem odpowiedziała: „Ja też nie. Tylko, że ja, kiedy się go dotykam, dotykam się Jezusa. Ale żeby Go zobaczyła, muszę przed tym Jezusem (Eucharystycznym) się opalać”. Dlatego nie pozwalała swoim siostronom iść do ubogich na ulice, jeśli najpierw nie adorowały Najświętszego Sakramentu. Dziś świętujemy Boże Ciało. Wychodzimy na ulice odświętnie ubrani, śpiewamy pieśni eucharystyczne, dziewczynki w białych sukienkach sypią kwiatki, dajemy jasne i wyraźne świadectwo nie tylko naszej wiary, ale również miłości do Boga. Ewangeliczny wymiar tej uroczystości zawiera się w tym, że tego samego Jezusa, którego kochamy i czcimy adorując, nie możemy nie kochać obecnego w potrzebujących.
