FEAST OF FAITH The Prayer Over the Offerings

In the liturgy of the 1570 Missal, this prayer was called the “secret” prayer. It was “secret” not because its content was mysterious, but because it was prayed in silence by the priest, who only recited the conclusion aloud: . . . *per omnia saecula saeculorum*. With the reforms of the Second Vatican Council, we again hear these rich prayers spoken aloud. They remind us to prepare ourselves for what is to happen in the Eucharistic Prayer, for it is not only the bread and wine that will be transformed.

The Prayer Over the Offerings is a prayer for transformation, an expression, in a few words, of all that we hope that the liturgy will accomplish in our lives. We ask God to accept the gifts we present, and to change us even as God hallows the bread and wine. As we listen carefully to the Prayer Over the Offerings, we are reminded of what it is that we seek in the Eucharist: to be made holy; to be drawn closer to God; to come to eternal joy, unity, peace, and salvation. —Corinna Laughlin, Copyright © J. THE DAYS ARE COMING

Separation, isolation, and hostility are terrible things. We are, sadly, too familiar with all of them in our modern life, whether we look at world events or events in our own neighborhoods and families. All three readings today refer to these same sad human conditions.

The prophet Jeremiah describes world conditions as if the people of his time were sheep who had been scattered by poor leadership and corrupt shepherds. But "the days are coming," he assures us (Jeremiah 23:5), when a new shepherd, a just king, will come. We meet that king in the second reading and the Gospel. Paul reminds us in the Letter to the Ephesians that all divisions can now cease in Christ Jesus, who has brought us together through his blood. 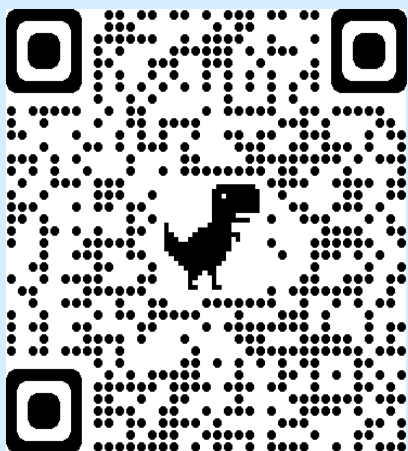

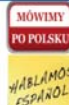

W dzisiejszym biuletynie parafialnym możecie wszyscy zobaczyć zdjęcie naszego nowego zadaszenia nad głównym wejściem do kościoła. Ten kolejny ważny projekt był zaplanowany ponad rok temu. Niestety z powodu pandemii projekt ten został czasowo wstrzymany. Dzięki Bogu nadszedł czas kiedy wznawiamy realizację tego projektu. Znaleźć czas, aby odpocząć nieco.

Jezus przypomina nam dzisiaj o konieczności wypoczynku. I nawet jeśli wydaje się nam, że wciąż mamy tyle spraw do zrobienia, dajmy się zaprosić Boskiemu Mistrzowi i odetchnijmy nieco. Jezus, widząc zmęczenie uczniów, postąpił jak dobry szef, który szanuje swoich współpracowników i, widząc, że pracują resztkami sił, wysłał ich na obowiązkowy urlop. W dzisiejszym zagalopowanym świecie coraz większą sztuką staje się zdolność zatrzymania się. Umiejętność powiedzenia sobie w odpowiednim momencie: dosyć, teraz muszę odpocząć! Chcę poświęcić więcej czasu na wyciszenie, na modlitwę i dla najbliższych. Pragnę odrodzić w sobie „duchowego człowieka”.
