My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

I remind all parishioners and guests that today on **Saturday (August 21)** and tomorrow on **Sunday (August 22)** we are having a two-day **Parish Picnic** in the parking lot in front of the Church. FEAST OF FAITH Come, Spirit!

The presider at the Eucharist can choose from among a number of different Eucharistic Prayers, all of which follow a similar pattern. Almost always, they begin with an *epiclesis*, a Greek word that means “invocation upon” or “calling over here.” At this moment in the prayer, the priest calls down the Holy Spirit upon the gifts of bread and wine that we have brought to the altar: “Father, we bring you these gifts. We ask you to make them holy by the power of your Spirit, that they may become the body and blood of your Son” (Eucharistic Prayer III). The words of the prayer are accompanied by the ritual gesture of the laying on of hands, the ancient sign of the gift of the Spirit, which is also used in most sacramental celebrations, from the rite of confirmation to the ordination of deacons, priests, and bishops. Liturgists sometimes call this first *epiclesis* the *epiclesis* of consecration. Later in the Eucharistic Prayer, there will be another *epiclesis*, the *epiclesis* of communion, as the priest asks that the Holy Spirit be sent upon us to transform us. “Grant that we, who are nourished by his body and blood, may be filled with his Holy Spirit, and become one body, one spirit in Christ” (Eucharistic Prayer III). –

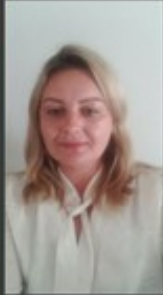

Mrs. Rychtarczyk



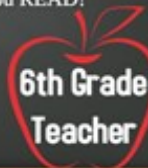

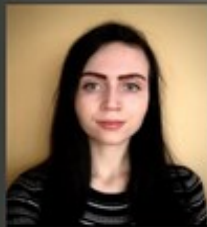
Mrs. Kuzminski



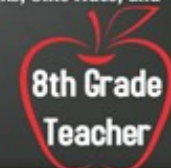

Z biurka Ks. Proboszcza

Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście !

Przypominam wszystkim parafianom i gościom, że dziś w **sobotę (21 sierpnia)** i jutro w **niedzielę (22 sierpnia)** na parkingu przed kościołem mamy dwudniowy **Piknik Parafialny**. W programie: muzyka na żywo, wysmienite jedzenie, lody, zimne piwo, zabawy dla dzieci oraz losowanie głównej nagrody w niedzielę o godz. 9:00 wieczorem. Bądźmy razem na pikniku i wesprzyjmy finansowo naszą parafię oraz plany, które są przed nami w najbliższych miesiącach do zrealizowania. Jednym z planów jest budowa specjalnego zadaszania przed głównym wejściem do kościoła.

Zachęcam wszystkich modlących się w naszym kościele (2 tysiące rodzin) do zaangażowania się w to dzieło. Pomyślmy, gdyby każda rodzina, która modli się w tym kościele zaangażowała się w to dzieło składając na przykład \$50.00 lub \$100.00 od rodziny to z pewnością nasz planowany projekt zostałby wykonany jeszcze przed jesienią i zimą bieżącego roku. Bardzo was proszę o rozważenie możliwości finansowego wsparcia projektu. Wszystkich was ogarniam serdeczną kapłańską modlitwą.

Polska Kana

Dziś Kana to miasteczko liczące około dwudziestu tysięcy mieszkańców, z których niektórzy są katolikami rzymskimi lub obrządku melchickiego, inni zaś to wyznawcy islamu. Stojący pośrodku miejscowości kościół, który upamiętnia pierwszy cud Jezusa, stanął na ruinach kościoła z II w. W fasadzie widoczne są cztery kolumny tej antycznej budowli. Ściany świątyni ozdobiono łacińskimi napisami, zaczerpniętymi z ewangelicznego opowiadania o weselu w Kanie. Proste wnętrze kościoła ozdabiają także dzbany wykonane na wzór antycznych stągwi. Pod głównym ołtarzem znajduje się krypta ze śladami starożytnych zabudowań gospodarczych, autentycznymi stągwiemi oraz mykwa ozdobiona wizerunkiem Jezusa i sześciu dzbanów.



Dziś Częstochowa staje się polską Kaną. Obchodzimy Uroczystość Najświętszej Maryi Panny Częstochowskiej. Dziś każdy wierzący Polak słyszy głos Maryi: „Zróbcie wszystko, cokolwiek Jezus wam powie”. A Jego orędzie od wieków się nie zmienia. To wezwanie do wiary, nawrócenia i miłości okazywanej Bogu i bliźniemu. Starania o ustanowienie dzisiejszej uroczystości rozpoczęli paulini tuż po cudownej obronie Jasnej Góry przed najazdem Szwedów. Ostatecznie W 1931 r. papież Pius XI ustalił dzień 26 sierpnia. Po raz pierwszy czczono Matkę Bożą Częstochowską w 1932 roku. Od tego czasu co roku cześć Maryi rozbrzmiewa z Częstochowy na cały nasz kraj. Niech więc towarzyszą nam dziś słowa papieża Franciszka, który w racji dzisiejszej uroczystości dwa lata temu na Jasnej Górze wołał: „Niech Ona, Przyczyna naszej radości, która wnosi pokój pośród obfitości grzechu i zawirowań historii, wyprasza nam obfitość Ducha Świętego, abyśmy byli sługami dobrymi i wiernymi”. (Dzień Pański)
