We are asked to relinquish the need to control the results of our efforts; to risk, as Jesus did, the loss of everything we are working to achieve. A "LARGE" FAITH

The letter of James is designed to enlarge your faith. James knew that his community faced trials that could lead them to abandon the faith, or perhaps to reduce faith to a comfortable, manageable size. In today's passage, James calls the reader to resist reducing faith to safe, intellectual assent to teachings, and instead to expand one's faith to actively engage in good works, especially in service to the poor.

To have a "large" faith is to move from apathy toward others' sufferings to empathy and to action. A large faith leads to a large heart, where we can take in the enormity of suffering in the world around us, not become overwhelmed by it, and do what we can to relieve it. With a large heart, we can even squarely face our own sufferings, accepting our own tragedies with forgiveness and hope, and walking in empathy with all who share in suffering.

FEAST OF FAITH Offering and Intercessions

In this holy moment—with the consecrated bread and wine, the Body and Blood of Christ, upon the altar—we pray for a share in the fruits of Christ's sacrifice. We offer to God what God has given to us, and we intercede for the Church and the world. We pray for the pope and for all the bishops, and we mention the bishop of our local church by name. We pray for the clergy and for all the people of God. We pray in a special way for those who have died. And we pray for ourselves, that one day, with Mary and all the saints, we may come to that place where Jesus already reigns. These prayers of intercession, like the General Intercessions earlier in the Mass, broaden our focus and remind us that the Eucharist is offered not just for those gathered, but for the salvation of the entire world. The Eucharistic Prayer leads us from an intense focus on Christ, present in the consecrated host in the hands of the priest, to a loving sweep of prayer that embraces the world. J. S. Paluch Co.

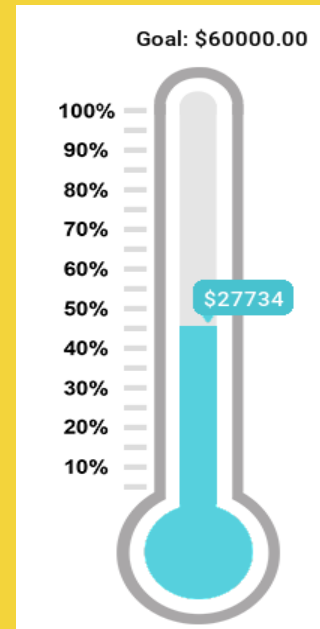

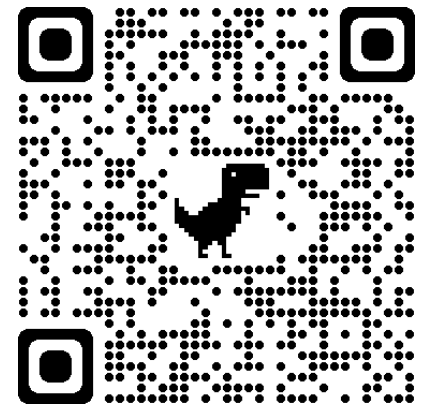

Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście !

Jednym z celów planowanych na ten rok jest budowa specjalnego zadania przed głównym wejściem do kościoła. Kilka tygodni temu prosiłem Was o możliwość rozważenia i złożenia specjalnego daru finansowego na ten cel (50 \$ lub 100 \$). Chcę podziękować tym wszystkim, którzy odpowiedzieli na moją prośbę. Specjalną donację na dzień dzisiejszy złożyło **61 rodzin**. (23,017 \$). Oczywiście wciąż możemy te donacje składać. Osoby, rodziny czy grupy parafialne zainteresowane wsparciem tego projektu bardzo proszę o kontakt ze mną. Jeśli nie w tym roku to na pewno w następnym roku 2022 ten cel zrealizujemy! Za kilka dni rozpoczniemy także budowę specjalnej „**Wiaty Góralskiej-Picnic Area**” na pikniki lub odpusty, które tak chętnie organizujecie w naszej parafii. Składając specjalną donację będziecie mogli wciąż organizować swoje pikniki oraz odpusty u „**Alberta**” w Burbank! Nie zwlekajcie, bo już kilka Koł Góralskich zrobiło swoje rezerwacje na pikniki! Nasze plany i nadzieje polećmy Jezusowi przez wstawiennictwo Matki Bożej i św. Alberta Wielkiego!

JAKA JEST MOJA ODPOWIEDŹ?

Jezus stawia uczniom podwójne pytanie: co o Nim mówią inni, a potem pyta, za kogo oni sami, tzn. uczniowie, Go uważają. To podwójne pytanie przypomina, że uczeń nieustannie musi się



konfrontować ze światem, ale nie po to, żeby iść za głosem tego świata, zasugerować się tym, co mówią i czynią inni, ale żeby pośród tych wszystkich głosów, które do niego docierają, usłyszeć głos Boga. W Ewangelii według św. Mateusza (Mt 16, 13-20) Jezus zaznacza, że odpowiedź Piotra, której udziela w imieniu uczniów, pochodzi od Ojca: „albowiem, nie objawiły ci tego ciało i krew, ale Ojciec, który jest w niebie”. Piotr zaufał temu głosowi bardziej niż swoim zmysłom, bardziej niż opiniom innych, bardziej niż swojemu ludzkiemu rozumowi. A jednak chwilę później, gdy Jezus mówił o swojej męce, Apostoł zaprotestował, gdy to, co usłyszał od Zbawiciela, okazało się dla niego niewygodne i zbyt trudne oraz kłóciło się z obrazem Mesjasza, który nosił w swym sercu. Zaprotestował, bo tym razem poszedł za głosem natury, za głosem tego świata. I usłyszał mocne słowa Jezusa: „szatanie [czyli przeciwniku!], odejdz ode mnie! Bo nie myślisz po Bożemu, ale po ludzku”. Przyjął Jezusa za Zbawiciela to pozwolić, aby On zmieniał nasze myślenie z ludzkiego na Boże, a więc słuchać Jego nauki i iść za Nim, aż do końca – także wtedy, gdy wydaje się nam to nużące i mało efektywne, czy też trudne i bolesne, a nawet niemożliwe. Odpowiedź na pytanie, kim jest dla mnie Jezus Chrystus, tak naprawdę piszemy naszym życiem, które już teraz

zakorzenione jest w wieczności. ks. W. Wiśniewski
