## FEAST OF FAITH Concluding Rites

The Prayer after Communion gives us a glimpse of the heavenly banquet, of which we have had a foretaste in the Eucharist. The concluding rites speak of what we are to do with this great gift of God. That includes the parish announcements, which are usually given following the Prayer after Communion. Believe it or not, the announcements, which are not an “official” part of the Mass, have been included in the Mass from as early as the fifth century! The deacon or the homilist—even the bishop—would announce coming liturgical celebrations and encourage the people to participate. Today’s parish announcements include opportunities for prayer, service, learning, and community building. They should be succinct and should include only significant events and activities in the life of the parish. But even when they are long and tedious, the announcements (and the parish bulletin) flow out of the concluding rites of the Mass. They offer us ways to live the Eucharist, to become what we have received—the Body of Christ, living and active in our local community. —Corinna Laughlin, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

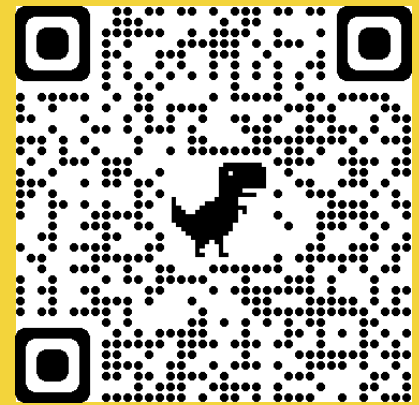

## Z biurka Ks. Proboszcza

### Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście !

W miesiącu października (3,10,17,24) jak zazwyczaj w naszej Archidiecezji Chicago odbywało się liczenie wiernych. Było to o tyle interesujące, że wciąż żyjemy w czasie pandemii. Jak to liczenie wypadło w naszej parafii? Napewno jesteście ciekawi! Otóż, wciąż kilkanaście osób oraz rodzin w obawie przed pandemią pozostaje w domach oglądając Msze Święte w TV lub w internecie; ludzie „*slabej wiary*” odeszli od Kościoła; kilkanaście rodzin zmieniło adres swojego zamieszkania i przeprowadzili się do innych stanów USA (*Arizona, Texas, Floryda, Indiana, Wisconsin, North and South Carolina, Minnesota, Tennessee*). Kilka rodzin powróciło do Polski lub przeprowadzili się do innych krajów Unii Europejskiej. Są też tacy, którzy niestety „*obrazili*” się na parafię z powodu maseczek. Dzięki Bogu znacznie więcej jest też nowych osób oraz rodzin z okolicznych parafii i miejscowości. Bogu niech będą dzięki za to, że wciąż parafia św. Alberta Wielkiego w Burbank pod względem ilości wiernych jest największą parafią w Archidiecezji Chicago. W każdą niedzielę modli się w naszym kościele średnio około **4 tysiące wiernych**. W szkołach na terenie parafii mamy **1260** uczniów. Jest to powód do wielkiej radości, wdzięczności i odpowiedzialności za wszystkich parafian oraz gości. Cieszę się bardzo, że wciąż tworzymy piękną Wspólnotę Parafialną pod względem duchowym i materialnym. Wszystkim Wam z głębi serca dziękuję za to i ogarniam was oraz wasze rodziny nieustanną życzliwą kapłańską modlitwą. Sw. Albercie Wielki, módl się za nami!

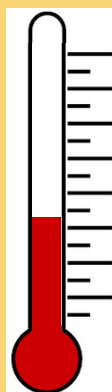
