## TO BE A PROPHET

Today's readings show us what it is like to be a prophet. As Jeremiah recounts his call, God warns him that he will need strength and perseverance to withstand the hostility he will face from "Judah's kings and princes" and "its priests and people" (Jeremiah 1:18b). God also assures him that they "will not prevail over you, for I am with you" (1:19). The psalm reflects both of these struggles as well as deliverance from them ("salvation"). This is exactly what Jesus experiences in today's



Gospel. After he claims that his own mission is the same as what Isaiah proclaimed, at first the people marvel at his "gracious words" (Luke 4:22). Soon, however, they become suspicious, skeptical, and hostile, even threatening to kill him. But just as God promised to deliver Jeremiah, so Jesus "passed through the midst of them and went away" (4:30). Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

**THE FEAST OF ST. BLASE 2/3/2022**  
**Thursday, February 3rd we will celebrate the feast of St. Blasé, blessing of the throats will take place after each morning Mass.**

**Saint Blaise is a bishop and martyr who lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia.** For a time, Blaise lived in a cave to escape persecution. On his feast **the church recalls a miracle cure associated with him and celebrates the blessing of the throats.**



St. Blaise died around 316 and was a bishop, physician and martyr who is the patron saint of throats. He was the bishop of Sebaste, Turkey. When the persecutions started under Emperor Diocletian (284-305), Blaise took refuge in a cave, where he cared for wild animals. Years later, hunters found him and took him to Governor Agricolaus of Cappadocia and Lower Armenia during the persecution of Emperor Licinius Licinianus (308-324). Blaise was tortured with iron rods and beheaded. The custom of blessing throats on his feast day is taken from Blaise's healing of a young boy who had a fish bone stuck in his throat. The candles used in the ceremonies are commemoratives of the candles brought to Blaise in prison by the boy's mother. Many other miraculous events are recorded as part of Blaise's legends. He is patron saint of doctors, builders, wind musicians, tailors, stone carvers, wool dealers, cattle, tanners, plasterers, pets, hat makers, shoemakers, hosier workers and weavers. He is invoked against neck and throat complaints and his relics are in Brunswick, Mainz, Lubeck, Trier and Cologne, Germany; in Taranto, Milan and Rome, Italy; in Paray-le-Monial, France; and in Dubrovnik, Croatia. His feast day is Feb. 3.

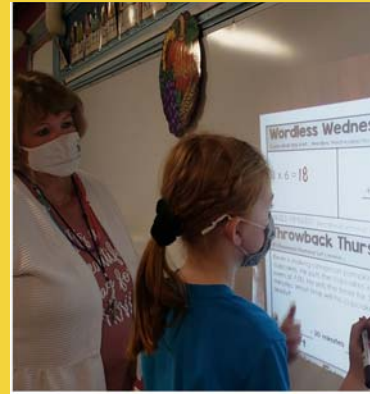

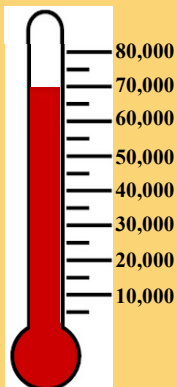
