### February 14th, Saints Cyril and Methodius

Cyril had missionary experience with the Arabs and had been a professor of philosophy. He began to work with his brother Methodius, in 862. They started their work among the Slavs in 863, using Slavonic in the liturgy. In 867 the brothers accepted Pope Nicholas I's invitation to Rome to explain their conflict with the German archbishop of Salzburg and bishop of Passau, who claimed control of the same Slavic territory and who wanted to enforce the exclusive use of the Latin liturgy. Cyril and Methodius arrived in Rome in 868, where the new pope, Adrian II, took their side and formally authorized the use of the Slavic liturgy. When Cyril died in 869, Adrian sent Methodius back to the Slavs as his legate and archbishop of Sirmium. Methodius's ecclesiastical province included all of Moravia. When Rostislav's nephew and successor, Svatopluk, failed to support Methodius, he was tried in 870 by the German clergy, brutally treated, and jailed until liberated by the intervention of Pope John VIII. When Methodius's diocesan bishop, Wiching, continued to make trouble by advocating for use of the Latin liturgy, Methodius tried to strengthen his position in the Eastern Church by visiting Constantinople in 882. After Methodius's death, Pope Stephen V forbade the use of the Slavonic liturgy. Wiching, as Methodius's successor, forced the disciples of Cyril and Methodius into exile. The posthumous influence of Cyril and Methodius reached distant Kiev in Russia and left traces among the Slavs of Croatia, Bohemia, and Poland. They were recognized as saints quite early by the Eastern Orthodox churches and were celebrated by the Roman Catholic Church in 1880. They were honoured by Pope John Paul II in his 1985 encyclical *Slavorum Apostoli* ("Apostles of the Slavs").

## Z liurka Ks. Proboszcza

### Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście !

Już za tydzień 19/20 luty zostanie przeprowadzona w naszej Diecezji Chicago **Doroczna Kwesta Katolicka**.



Hasło tegorocznej kwesty brzmi: „**Odnówić wszystko... Boża obietnica i nasza odpowiedzialność**”. W tym dniu wysłuchamy specjalnego przemówienia kardynała Cupich i będziemy mogli złożyć swoje finansowe zobowiązania. Bardzo was proszę, abyście rozważyli taką duchową i materialną możliwość wsparcia tego dzieła. Ten cel finansowy został ponownie podniesiony przez Diecezję i wynosi na ten rok 62,060.00 \$. Dla porównania w roku 2021 wynosił on 53,368.70 \$. Wiem, że czas w którym się obecnie znajdujemy nie pomaga nam w realizacji i osiągnięciu wyznaczonego nam przez Diecezję celu finansowego. Trwa pandemia, wiele parafian zwłaszcza angielskojęzycznych nie powróciło do kościoła, wiele rodzin boryka się z problemami finansowymi, wiele osób zmieniło także swoje zapatrywanie na ten temat. Niestety, niektórzy z naszych parafian zmarli oraz kilkanaście rodzin przeprowadziło się do innych bezpieczniejszych miejscowości lub stanów w USA. Dlatego tym bardziej módlmy się w intencji zbliżającej się Kwesty Katolickiej i jej pomyślnego przebiegu.

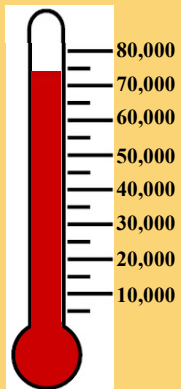
### 14ty Luty - Święty Cyryl, mnich, i Metody, biskup - patroni Europy

Cyryl urodził się w Tesalonikach w 826 r. jako siódme dziecko w rodzinie Leona, który był wyższym oficerem miejscowego garnizonu. Po studiach w Konstantynopolu został bibliotekarzem przy kościele Hagia Sophia. Później usunął się na ubocze. Z czasem podjął w szkole cesarskiej wykłady z filozofii. Wkrótce potem, w 855 r. udał się na górę Olimp do klasztoru w Bitynii, gdzie przebywał już jego starszy brat - św. Metody. Na żądanie cesarza Michała III obaj wyruszyli do kraju Chazarów na Krym, aby rozwiązać spory religijne między chrześcijanami, Żydami i Saracenami. Z Panonii (Węgier) bracia udali się do Wenecji, by tam dla swoich uczniów uzyskać święcenia kapłańskie. Jednak duchowieństwo tamtejsze przyjęło ich wrogo. Daremnie Cyryl przekonywał swoich przeciwników, że język nie powinien odgrywać warunku istotnego dla przyjęcia chrześcijaństwa. Bracia zostali oskarżeni w Rzymie przed papieżem św. Mikołajem o herezję. Posłuszni wezwaniu namiestnika Chrystusowego na ziemi, udali się do Rzymu. W tym jednak czasie zmarł papież św. Mikołaj I (+ 867), a po nim został wybrany Hadrian II. Ku radości misjonarzy nowy papież przyjął ich bardzo serdecznie, kazał wyświęcić ich uczniów na kapłanów, a ich słowiańskie księgi liturgiczne kazał uroczyście złożyć na ołtarzu w kościele Matki Bożej, zwanym Fatne. Wkrótce potem Cyryl wstąpił do jednego z greckich klasztorów, gdzie zmarł na rękach swego brata 14 lutego 869 r. Papież Hadrian (Adrian) urządził Cyrylowi uroczysty pogrzeb.

**Metody** urodził się między 815 a 820 r. W młodym wieku został archontem - zarządcą cesarskim w jednej ze słowiańskich prowincji. Zrezygnował z urzędu, wstępując do klasztoru w Bitynii, gdzie został przełożonym. Po śmierci Cyryla Hadrian II konsekrował Metodego na arcybiskupa Moraw i Panonii (Węgier) oraz dał mu uprawnienia legata. Jako biskup, Metody kontynuował rozpoczęte dzieło. W tym czasie doszło do pojednania Rzymu z Konstantynopolem. Metody udał się więc do patriarchy Focjusza, by mu zdać sprawę ze swojej działalności. Został przyjęty uroczyście przez cesarza. Kiedy powracał, przyprowadził ze sobą liczny zastęp kapłanów. Powróciwszy na Morawy, umarł w Welehradzie 6 kwietnia 885 r. W roku 907 rozpadło się państwo wielkomorawskie, a z jego rozpadem został usunięty obrządek słowiański na rzecz łacińskiego. Mimo tego dzieło św. Cyryla i św. Metodego nie upadło. Obaj święci są uważani za apostołów Słowian. W roku 1980 papież św. Jan Paweł II ogłosił ich - obok św. Benedykta - współpatronami Europy, tym samym podnosząc dotychczas obowiązujące wspomnienie do rangi święta.
