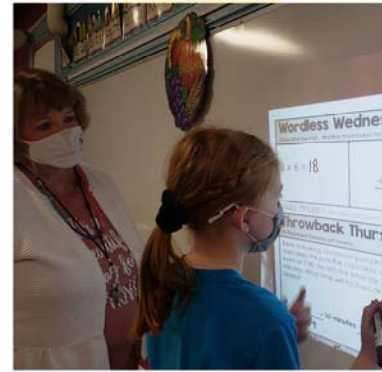

Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście!

Od ponad tygodnia jesteśmy świadkami wojny na Ukrainie. Widzimy i słyszymy jak wojska Putina atakują i mordują niewinnych ludzi. Z pewnością w najbliższych dniach będziemy mogli finansowo wesprzeć broniącą się Ukrainę. Zachęcam wszystkich ludzi dobrej woli do modlitwy o dar pokoju słowami św. Jana Pawła II:

„Boże ojców naszych, wielki i miłosierny! Panie życia i pokoju, Ojciec wszystkich ludzi. Twoją wolą jest pokój, a nie udręczenie. Potęp wojny i obal pychę gwałtowników. Wysłałeś Syna swego Jezusa Chrystusa, aby głosił pokój bliskim i dalekim i zjednoczył w jedną rodzinę ludzi wszystkich ras i pokoleń. Niech już nie będzie więcej wojny – złej przygody, z której nie ma odwrotu, niech już nie będzie więcej wojny – kłębowska walki i przemocy. Spraw, niech ustanie wojna w Ukrainie, która zagraża Twoim stworzeniom na niebie, na ziemi i w morzu. Z Maryją, Matką Jezusa i naszą, błagamy Cię, przemów do serc ludzi odpowiedzialnych za losy narodów. Zniszcz logikę odwetów i zemsty, a poddaj przez Ducha Świętego nowe rozwiązania wielkoduszne i szlachetne, w dialogu i cierpliwym wyczekiwaniu – bardziej owocne niż gwałtowne działania wojenne. Ojciec, obdarz nasze czasy dniami pokoju. Niech już nie będzie więcej wojny. Amen”.

Kontynuujemy w naszej Archidiecezji Chicago oraz we wszystkich jej parafiach **Doroczną Kwestę Katolicką**. Hasłem tegorocznej kwesty są słowa: **„Odnówić wszystko... Bardzo was proszę, abyście rozważyli taką duchową lub materialną możliwość wsparcia tego dzieła.
