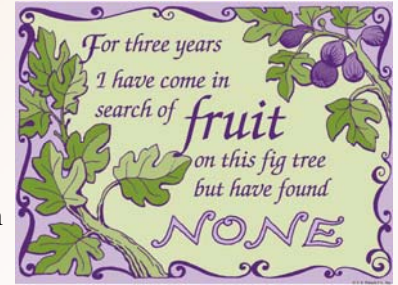

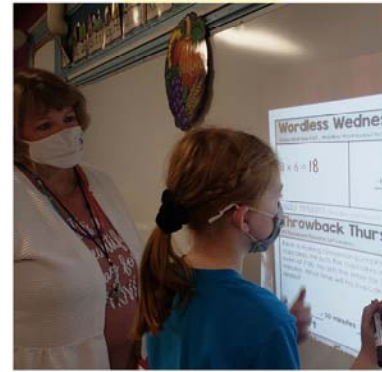

NAWRÓCENIE CHRONI PRZED ZŁEM

Słyszac o przerażających katastrofach i tragicznych wypadkach, które przynoszą dużą liczbę ofiar śmiertelnych, zastanawiamy się nad ich źródłem i sensem. Nie czekajmy, aż zawali się kolejna wieża albo przerażający atak terrorystyczny. Zła dopuszcza się człowiek. On też cierpi najbardziej z jego powodu. Trzeba, byśmy wrócili do Boga, który ratuje nas od skutków grzechu. On jest Panem. Jest Nim dla nas, dla naszego ocalenia od zła.
