GOD'S OVERFLOWING KINDNESS

The superabundance of God's kindness ties all of today's readings together. Especially when life overwhelms us, the Lord provides all we need, and then some. In the Acts of the Apostles, Peter takes the lead when facing the Sanhedrin. We might expect the man who denied Jesus to crumble under the imposing glare of the high priest. Instead, the Holy Spirit helps him testify to his faith in Jesus Christ. What Peter had lacked before, courage and conviction, God provides in abundance. Similarly, today's Gospel shows Jesus providing a surplus of fish for the disciples. They have no luck fishing until the Lord intercedes. Jesus supplies an almost ridiculous number of fish, and he cooks it for them, too. As our reading from Revelation affirms, the overflowing riches of God require constant praise. Countless creatures—"everything in the universe"—cry out to honor the Lord, forever and ever.

It is impossible to truly meet Jesus and remain the same. It is impossible to truly meet Jesus and remain the same. Meeting Jesus changes us. Two days ago we reflected on the two disciples on the road to Emmaus being changed through meeting Jesus. In today's Gospel (John 21:1-14), we see Peter growing into his new role in his Petrine ministry through his encounter with the risen Jesus. When the Beloved Disciple told Peter it was the Lord on the shore, Peter jumped into the lake, and we presume Peter preceded the boat to land and secured it when it landed. By the time this Gospel was written a boat was already being used as an image of the Church. When Jesus asked to bring some of the fish, it was Peter who went back into the water a second time to bring the fish. He dragged the net to the shore full of the fish, one hundred and fifty-three large fish and the net was not torn. St. Jerome



tells us that Greek zoologists say there were one hundred and fifty-three species of fish in the world so Peter dragging this net to shore full of one hundred and fifty-three fish surely bespeaks Peter's ministry serving the entire Church. Even though zoologists now know many more species of fish, the message of the Gospel about Peter's ministry for the Church is clear. Peter was called by the Lord to drag the net full of fish to the shore, to preside over and serve the Church. Meeting Jesus changed Peter and he began his Petrine ministry. Peter's denials of Jesus during the Passion are healed and forgiven and explicitly so during this same encounter with Jesus just after breakfast on the shore when Jesus three times asked Peter if he loved him and commanded him to look after the flock. *Fr. T. Lane*

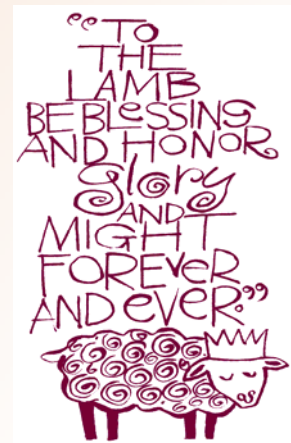

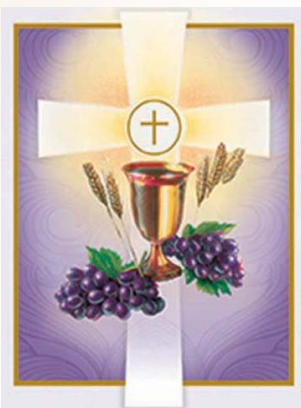
„TY WIESZ, TY WSZYSTKO WIESZ”

Bezowocny, nocny połów przemienił się w doświadczenie obfitości wraz z pojawieniem się Jezusa, który jest jak światło dnia rozpraszające mroki nocy. Wiara umiłowanego ucznia znów pozwala mu rozpoznać Jezusa, który troszczy się o swoich uczniów i przygotowuje im posiłek. Piotr, ogołocony przez doświadczenie swojego grzechu zaparcia się Jezusa, chce przeżyć spotkanie z Jego przebaczącą miłością. Paradoksalnie to właśnie Piotr zostaje zaproszony przez Jezusa do przyjęcia daru Jego miłości. Pytając Piotra o miłość, Jezus chce go do niej uzdolnić. Doświadczenie grzechu nauczyło Piotra, iż nie może opierać się na własnych siłach. Wcześniej chciał oddać swoje życie za Jezusa, a w momencie próby trzykrotnie się Go zaparł. Teraz Piotr swoją wolę kochania Jezusa opiera nie na sobie, a na łasce Pana: „Ty wiesz, Ty wszystko wiesz”.

Choć Jezus zaprasza Piotra do wielkiej miłości, miłości agape, daru z siebie, to ostatecznie przyjmuje to, co Piotr może w tym momencie dać, miłość przyjaźni, którą wyraża greckie słowo filia. Odpowiedź miłości Piotra do Jezusa ma się realizować w byciu pasterzem wspólnoty uczniów, Kościoła. Piotr, jak Jezus dobry pasterz, ma troszczyć się o duchowe potrzeby wspólnoty, ma ją prowadzić i chronić od niebezpieczeństw. W ten sposób rozpoczyna się nowy etap powołania Piotra. Słowami „pójdź za Mną” Jezus zaprasza go do podjęcia na nowo drogi ucznia, który naśladuje swojego Mistrza i Pana. Piotr, odpowiadając na wezwanie do życia w miłości, staje się „umiłowanym uczniem”, który ostatecznie odda swoje życie w darze za Jezusa i za Kościół. Każdy z nas jest zaproszony do przyjęcia daru miłości Jezusa i naśladowania Go w miłości według własnego powołania.
