GOOD NEWS IS ON THE WAY

This week, in the midst of summer, the scriptures greet us with joy, peace, mercy, and more peace! Sounds a little like Advent, doesn't it? We often associate the prophet Isaiah with that preparatory season, and our first reading rings with such words as exult, comfort, and rejoice. The Israelites had reason to rejoice, for they had returned, come home, to a rebuilt Jerusalem from their exile in Babylon. In the Gospel, the seventy-two disciples who were sent out have their own "homecoming," returning to Jesus from spreading the Good News of the Kingdom and preparing people for the "advent" of Jesus into their cities and towns on his long road to Jerusalem. Like the exiles in Isaiah, the disciples return rejoicing. The Good News, the Kingdom of God, is coming, even in summer. As today's psalm reminds us, "Shout joyfully to God, all the earth!" 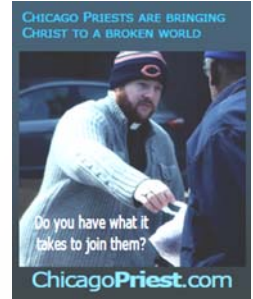

- A baby's heart starts beating about 22 days after fertilization.
- The baby's heart pumps 26 quarts of blood per day.
- By 15 weeks the baby's heart has already beat approximately 15,800,000 times.
- In total, a baby's heart beats about 54 million times between conception and birth.
- Brain connections formed by 15 weeks gestation last into adulthood.
- Starting at 10 weeks of gestational age, the fetus begins the breathing process.
- The kidneys already filter toxins.
- Intestines have started the lifelong contractions that propel food through the digestive system.
- Surgeons have successfully performed surgery on 15-week-old babies in utero.
- By 15 weeks, unborn babies show a preference for their right or left hand; they can respond to touch and bend their fingers as if to grasp an object.

BOSKA KSIĘGA IMION

Czego to ludzie nie wymyślą, aby ich imię zostało wpisane do Księgi rekordów Guinnessa? Można się uśmiechać z tego rodzaju ambicji, ale ona również świadczy o nieusuwalnym pragnieniu ludzkiego serca, aby zaistnieć, wybić się spośród anonimowego tłumu. Poniekąd świadczy też o pragnieniu nieśmiertelności. A że nieco oryginalnym, to inna sprawa. Zdrowe pragnienie zapisania się w historii ludzkości czymś wyjątkowym nie jest w gruncie rzeczy niczym złym. Ostatecznie chyba nikt nie chce przejść przez życie niezauważonym, pominiętym. I słusznie. Nie po to dał nam Pan Bóg istnienie, abyśmy nie zaistnieli. Nie każdemu jednak udaje się uczynić coś naprawdę godnego zauważenia w oczach tego świata. Dla nas, wierzących nie powinno to być jednak najmniejszym zmartwieniem. Nie do świata bowiem należymy, ale do Boga. O tym fakcie między innymi mówi dzisiejsza Ewangelia. Święty Łukasz, opisując wysłanie siedemdziesięciu dwóch uczniów Jezusa z misją głoszenia królestwa Bożego, nie podaje ich imion. Mimo że wiernie wypełnili polecenie Pana Jezusa i dokonali wielkich czynów, pozostają dla nas anonimowi. W oczach świata i to nawet tego pobożnego nie zasłużyli, aby ich imiona zostały zapisane. Nie znaczy to jednak, że ich dzieło nie zostało zauważone, a ich imiona pominięte. Wyraźnie zaznacza to Jezus, podsumowując misję swoich uczniów: „Nie z tego się cieszcie, że duchy się wam poddają, lecz cieszcie się, że wasze imiona zapisane są w niebie”. I my również możemy się cieszyć, bo jeśli w jakikolwiek sposób pracujemy dla Jezusa, to nasze imiona zapisane są w niebie. *o. Marek Cul*

CYTATY, MYŚLI, AFORYZMY

Chciałabym przemierzyć ziemię, głosząc Twoje imię, o Jezu, i zasadzić na niewiernym gruncie Twój chwalebny krzyż, ale jedna misja nie wystarczy mi, chciałabym w tym samym czasie głosić Ewangelię w czterech stronach świata i na dalekich wyspach. *św. Teresa z Lisieux*

Wy wszyscy, którzy nie podejmujecie posługi na terenach misyjnych – nie zapominajcie, że nasza własna, polska Ojczyzna wciąż potrzebuje nowej ewangelizacji. Podobnie jak cała chrześcijańska Europa. Po setkach lat – i tysiącletniach – wciąż na nowo! Cała Europa stała się kontynentem nowego wielkiego wyzwania dla Ewangelii. I Polska też. *(św. Jan Paweł II)*

Uczestnicząc w ofierze krzyża, chrześcijanin dostępuje udziału w ofiarnej miłości Chrystusa i zostaje uzdolniony oraz zobowiązany do okazywania miłości w życiu poprzez wszystkie swoje postawy i czyny. W samym kulcie, w Komunii eucharystycznej zawiera się bycie miłowanym i jednocześnie miłowanie innych. Eucharystia, która nie przekłada się na miłość konkretnie praktykowaną, jest sama w sobie fragmentaryczna. *(Benedykt XVI)*
