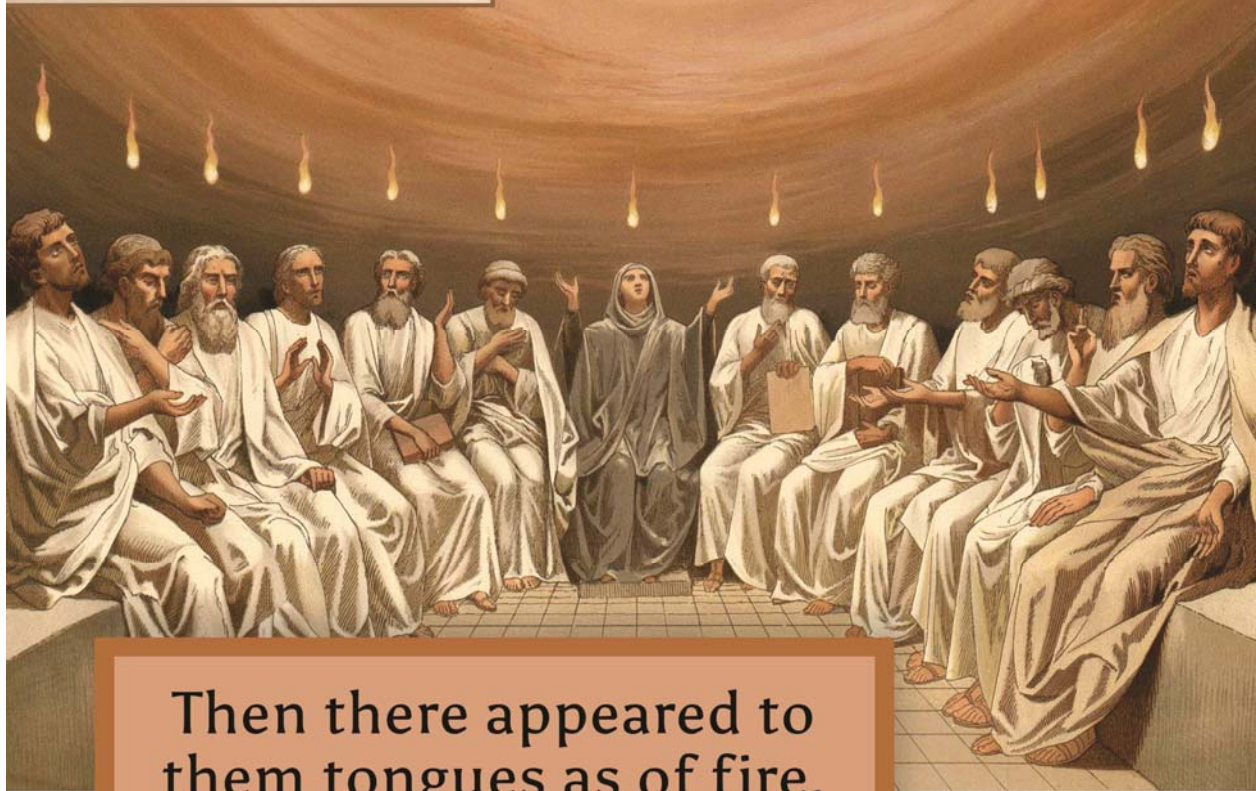

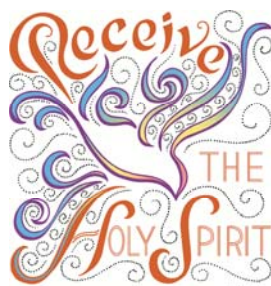

THE SPIRIT'S ACTIVE POWER

The mystery of the Trinity refers to one God in three persons. We frequently acknowledge Jesus as "the second person of the Trinity," but referring also to the Spirit as a "person" comes less naturally. In religious art, the Holy Spirit often appears as a dove or, as in today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, tongues of fire. Much rarer are images of the Spirit as a "person" in recognizable human form. Today's readings do not settle the issue of how to picture the Spirit, but they certainly give shape to the Spirit's active power in the world and in each human heart. In Acts, the Spirit enables people to speak and understand a variety of languages. Paul's letter to the Corinthians praises the Spirit for all kinds of spiritual gifts, services, and "workings." Finally, in John's Gospel, Jesus calls the Spirit our Advocate and our divine teacher.

From the Pastor's Desk

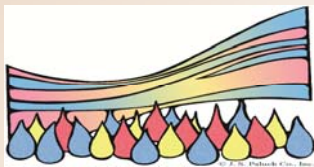
Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Today we are at the fiftieth day of the Easter celebration: seven weeks of seven days, a week of weeks, now culminating in a festival fiftieth day. While the liturgical color of the Easter season is gold, on this last day we have red. For the first thousand years of the church, there were no firm rules for using colors. Only wealthy churches could afford a full array of colors, and most places used the best vestments, no matter the color, for the greatest feasts. The Church spelled out an exact plan for color, including red for Pentecost, only in 1570, but local differences held on until the 1800s.



Color experts tell us that red is a hot color, best used for fast-paced, upbeat, active experiences. It is hard to be neutral before red, as any matador will tell you. It invites commitment, draws you in. It is a stimulating color, engaging the eye, stirring hunger. It is the most fitting color for this day when we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit into our lives, a dynamic presence overturning neutrality in favor of passion and commitment. J.J. S. 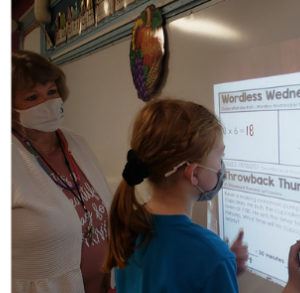

NA KOGO (NIE) ZSTĄPI DUCH ŚWIĘTY?

Prorok Joel zapowiada, że Bóg wyleje swego Ducha na wszelkie stworzenie (Jl 3, 1nn). Wszyscy będą prorokować. Pan Jezus mówi o konieczności narodzenia z Ducha (J 3, 5nn). Wiatr wieje kędy chce i jak chce. Szum jego słyszysz, ale nie wiesz, dokąd podążą. Tak też dzieje się z tym, kto przyjmuje Ducha Świętego. Święta Faustyna Kowalska napisała w Dzienniczku, że Bóg udziela wszystkim łaski, ale w różnym stopniu. Udzielam ci tyle łask, ile udźwignąć zdołasz (Dz 164). Nie wszystkie [dusze] dostąpią tej łaski, ale same temu winne. Kto nie korzysta z małych łask – nie otrzymuje wielkich (1633325). Dusza, która ma otwarte serce otrzyma więcej. Dusza otrzyma obficie, jeżeli nie zmarnuje łaski. Podobnie jest z darami Ducha Świętego. Czy więc wylanie Ducha jest warunkowe? Przecież miłość Boga jest bezwarunkowa. Ze strony Boga i Ducha Świętego tak, ale nie zawsze z naszej. Kiedy upieramy się przy swoim, to my stawiamy warunki. Co ma na to odpowiedzieć Duch Święty? Jest Duchem pokory i miłości. Będzie próbował rozgrzać nasze serce płomieniem wiary i ufności. Czasami ta droga może być długa i niełatwa. Mimo to Duch Święty zawsze będzie walczył o naszą wiarę. A na pewno przejdzie czas, kiedy zrozumiemy Jego działanie. Wtedy odczujemy jeszcze większą Jego moc. Duch Święty już działa, ale pragnie jeszcze silniej i skuteczniej płonąć w naszych sercach. 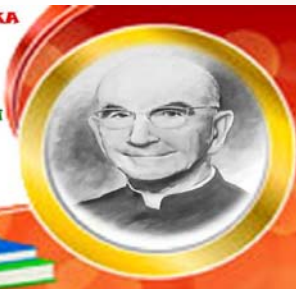
Cytaty, myśli, aforyzmy.
