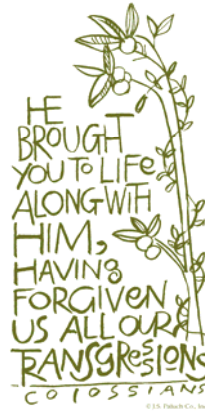
CONVERSATION WITH GOD

Prayer is our focus this weekend. In the Gospel, Jesus gives his disciples, and us, the Lord's Prayer, which we have cherished through the centuries. The first two words encompass much about our faith—unity among all Christians (Our), and a sense that we are in a deeply bonded relationship with God (Father). In Genesis, we see Abraham in conversational prayer, in his creaturely humility before his Creator, seeking mercy and compassion for the innocent. The psalm is a lyrical prayer of thanksgiving and praise for the God who answered the sincere prayers of a people who had called out for help, showing them mercy. In Luke's Gospel, the disciples want to pray like Jesus, with the same intimacy—to experience God as Abba in the depths of their being. Do we try to talk

Pełniąc funkcję sekretarki w biurze parafialnym jednym z moich obowiązków było opracowanie cotygodniowego biuletynu parafialnego, a tym samym rubryki: „Słowo od Księdza Proboszcza” do wiernych. Ponieważ moja postęga w parafii Św. Alberta dobiega końca (Sierpień 27, 2022), w miejscu „Słowo od ks. Proboszcza” dane mi jest napisać do Was kilka słów.

Moje pragnienie postęgi Bogu i ludziom spełniło się we wspólnocie Parafii p.w. Św. Alberta Wielkiego. Przez szesnaście lat wykonywałam swoje obowiązki pracując tuż obok Pana Jezusa, który jest zawsze obecny w Najświętszym Sakramencie w naszej kaplicy adoracji. Wielu z Was przychodzi codziennie do niej, by adorować Pana Jezusa w Najświętszym Sakramencie, tysiące uczestniczy w Mszach świętych w naszym kościele.



W ciągu minionych lat spotkałam wielu szlachetnych ludzi i rozumiałam, że bycie blisko Boga oznacza również - bycie blisko człowieka. Dziękuję więc Panu Bogu i Wam wszystkim za okazane dobro i życzliwość. Jestem wdzięczna za tę jedyną w życiu okazję do licznych spotkań, gdzie dane mi było dzielić Wasze radości i smutki. Dziękuję za okazaną wyrozumiałość i cierpliwość. Jestem wdzięczna Panu Bogu za to, że mamy ks. Mariusza, oddanego parafii Proboszcza, Księżę Wikariuszy, Siostry Misjonarki, Diakonów oraz oddanych parafian, zaangażowanych w życie parafii.

Pomimo tego, że mamy różne korzenie i pochodzenie: amerykańskie, polskie, hiszpańskie, filipińskie, włoskie, niemieckie i wiele innych, to jednak wszyscy jesteśmy dziećmi jednego Boga, a to już jest wielkim powodem do radości i dzielenia się darami duchowymi oraz budowania Królestwa Bożego na ziemi. Jezus dał nam Swoje Przykazanie; **„To jest moje przykazanie, abyście się wzajemnie miłowali, tak jak Ja was umiłowalem”**. Niech te Jego słowa będą naszym życiowym przewodnikiem i duchowym pożywieniem.

Kończąc, pragnę zapewnić Was, że na zawsze zostaniecie w mojej pamięci. Niech Wam Bóg błogostawi, a Maryja Niepokalana ma zawsze w swojej opiece.

NAJWIĘKSZY DAR

W Chrystusie została objawiona prawda o relacji każdego człowieka z Bogiem. O niej właśnie odpowiada liturgia dzisiejszej niedzieli. Pierwsze czytanie wskazuje na źródło i cel mądrości, o której – w odniesieniu do Salomona możemy przeczytać w Pierwszej Księdze Królewskiej: „Mądrość Salomona przewyższała mądrość wszystkich ludzi Wschodu i mądrość Egipcjan” (1 Krl 5, 10). Mądrość jest darem Boga dla człowieka – nie tylko Salomona – by mógł odróżniać dobro od zła i w ten sposób wypełniać to, czego Bóg dla nas pragnie. W drugim czytaniu św. Paweł ukazuje pięć działań Boga: poznał, przeznaczył, powołał, usprawiedliwił i obdarzył chwałą. Poznanie każdego człowieka przez Boga prowadzi do udzielenia mu kolejnych darów, o których wspomina Apostoła narodów, aż do udziału w chwale samego Boga. Możemy ją osiągnąć, podejmując trud poszukiwania tego, co najcenniejsze, jak wskazują nam na to dziś czytane ewangeliczne przypowieści. Są one przede wszystkim apelem Boga o dokonywanie właściwych wyborów wobec dóbr ziemskich, które są niczym w porównaniu z największym dobrem, jakie człowiek może otrzymać. Jesteśmy zatem wezwani nie tylko do odrzucenia tego, co nam nie służy w drodze do domu Ojca, ale również do pozostawienia tych dóbr, które na tej drodze mogłyby nas zatrzymać. Dla chrześcijan nieocenionym skarbem na tej drodze jest Eucharystia. Wszystko jest jej podporządkowane, z niej promieniuje moc na wszystkie dziedziny życia zarówno wspólnoty Kościoła, jak i poszczególnych wierzących. Bez Boga bowiem nic nie jest ani święte, ani mocne. To Bóg jest tym, dzięki któremu otrzymujemy właściwe rozeznanie tego, co jest dobre, i uczymy się dobrze korzystać z rzeczy przemijających i nieustannie zabiegać o dobra wieczne (por. kolekta).
