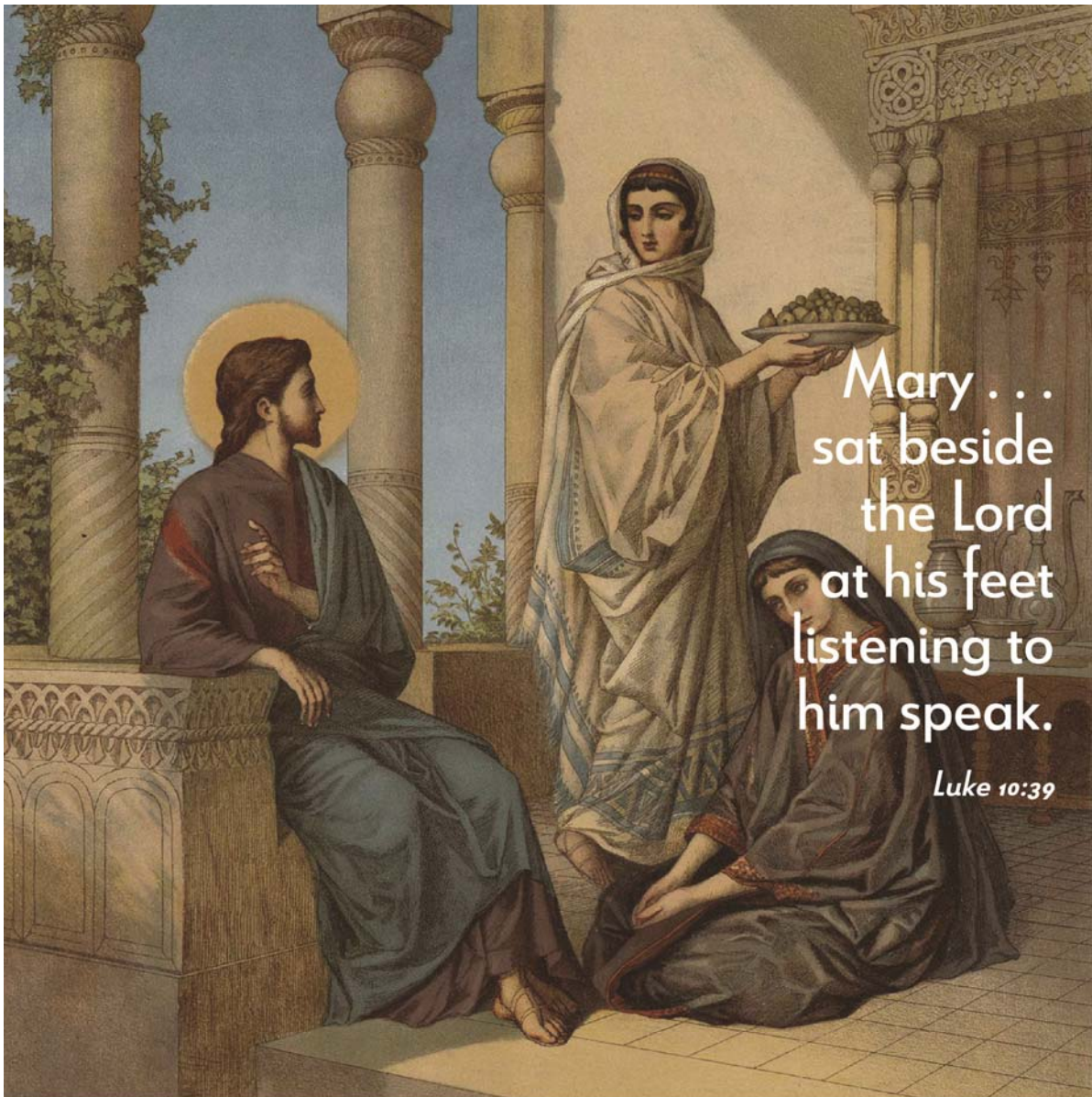

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

Holidays are underway, but not in our parish. Right now we are in the process of building a canopy in front of the main entrance to the church. We are closer to the end than further. The biggest problem is waiting for some materials. But we can do it! I want to thank all those who have worked, are working and will continue to carry out this project. Our plans for this year also include the renovation of the second parking lot behind the Catholic school building, which was laid in 1981. It has been waiting for its reparation for 41 years. The condition of the second parking lot is "deplorable". As you remember, in 2019/2020 we collected donations for the parking lot project. However, this was before the pandemic. We are currently learning that everything has become more expensive (food, building materials, electricity, water and gas, fuel, etc.). Unfortunately, the costs of repairing the second parking lot rose by 100%. In the current situation, we have to think hard about whether the renovation of the second parking lot makes sense and whether we will financially cope with this challenge. Let us offer all our plans and hopes to God through the intercession of Our Lady of Perpetual Help and our patron Saint Albert the Great.

Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście !

Trwają wakacje. Ale nie w naszej parafii ponieważ jesteśmy w trakcie prac związanych z budową specjalnego zadania przed głównym wejściem do kościoła. Jesteśmy bliżej końca niż dalej. Największym problem jest oczekiwanie na poszczególne materiały. Ale damy radę! Chcę podziękować tym wszystkim, którzy pracowali, pracują i będą wciąż realizować ten projekt. W naszych planach na ten rok był również remont drugiego parkingu za budynkiem katolickiej szkoły, który był zrobiony w roku 1981. Aż 41 lat czeka on na swoje odnowienie. Stan drugiego parkingu jest „opłakany”. Jak pamiętacie w roku 2019/2020 zbieraliśmy donacje na ten cel. Było to jednak przed pandemią. Obecnie doświadczamy tego jak wszystko podrożało (jedzenie, materiały budowlane, opłaty za prąd, wodę i gaz, paliwo itd.). Niestety, zmieniły się też koszty naprawy drugiego parkingu o 100 %. W obecnej więc sytuacji musimy się mocno zastanowić nad tym czy remont drugiego parkingu ma sens i czy finansowo podaliśmy temu wyzwaniu. Wszystkie nasze plany oraz nadzieje polecamy Panu Bogu przez wstawiennictwo Matki Bożej Nieustającej Pomocy i naszego patrona św. Alberta Wielkiego.

CIERPLIWOŚĆ BOGA

W każdym człowieku kąkol, o którym opowiada dzisiejsza Ewangelia, jest zmieszany z ewangelicznym dobrym ziarnem. Dlatego też wszyscy wierzący są zaproszeni do podjęcia przemiany swojego życia, aby stało się ono eucharystyczne. Wezwanie to znajdujemy zarówno w pierwszym czytaniu z Księgi Mądrości jak i w Ewangelii. Pierwsze czytanie jest kontynuacją rozważań o łagodności Boga wobec dawnych mieszkańców ziemi świętej. Karząc za nieprawości, stopniowo Pan dawał czas na zmianę postępowania, przemianę życia. W drugim czytaniu Paweł poucza Rzymian o szczególnych modlitwach, które wspiera Duch Święty. Sprawia On, że każdy wznoszony do Boga głos, zwłaszcza ten wydawany z bólu i smutku, staje się wołaniem dzieci do Ojca. Przypowieść Jezusa o chwaście przypomina prawdę zawartą w pierwszym czytaniu: to Bóg jest Panem czasu. Dlatego cierpliwie czeka na ukazanie się owoców Bożej działalności w świecie. Jednak Boże panowanie nad czasem i Jego oczekiwanie na owoce nie oznacza Jego obojętności czy nieobecności wobec panoszącego się zła albo nie dość szybkiego zwycięstwa dobra. Liturgia słowa podejmuje jedną z trudniejszych prawd królestwa Bożego, jaką jest współtłnienie zła i dobra w świecie aż do końca czasów. Istotna jest tutaj Boża cierpliwość, dzięki której każdy z nas ma możliwość przemiany swojego życia. W ten sposób ludzie błędzący i zaprzędani czynieniu zła także mają szansę na nawrócenie i powrót do Boga. Problem ten dotyczy jednak każdego człowieka. Także nas, którzy być może uważamy się za porządną katolików. W każdym z nas bowiem toczy się nieustanna walka dobra ze złem i dlatego też każdy z nas powinien z ufnością wołać do Boga, wzywając przy tym pomocy Ducha Świętego, aby to On przedstawiał Ojcu nasze prośby i błagania i aby to On był autorem naszej wewnętrznej przemiany.
