## From the Pastor's Desk

**Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!**

Today I would like to share with you some thoughts that have been bothering my heart and mind for a long time. I pray to the Holy Spirit for a proper discernment of the situation and for prudent and good decisions not for myself but for the future of our parish.

The last two years (*the time of the pandemic*) have not only changed the modern world, but also changed the image of our parish. About 20% of our English-speaking parishioners did not return to church and most likely will not return. Many people have died, many deteriorated in health, many families have changed their place of residence, many families have left. Our neighborhood is changing. Businesses are moving. Unfortunately, our area also becomes more dangerous. So the question arises: do we still need as many as 8 Masses on Sunday? Wouldn't it be better to reduce the number of Sunday Masses, so that more faithful could attend them. Let's also think about the fact that by reducing their number, we can also save on our expenses, e.g. electricity, gas, water, etc. You know how expensive everything is today. This also applies to our parish and school fees. Due to the situation, I think it is time to change the number our Sunday Mass from 8 to 7 or 6. Looking at the number of parishioners during Sunday services, I believe this will be wise and prudent decision. In connection with the planned changes, I ask for your understanding and kindness! I will come back to this topic in a short future.

In a near future we will resume work on the church canopy. After consultation with the Archdiocese, their architect, inspector and our contractor, some changes have been introduced for the final jobs. Plans for this year include sealcoating of the main parking lot. Due to the huge costs of repairing the second parking lot, I think this project will have to wait, unless we find a generous sponsor. We will see what time will bring. My duty is to properly use the money that you donate with dedication in our church. I think it will be sufficient to fix the existing potholes on it.

Finally, I would like to invite you all to our parish picnic: **"The Taste of St. Albert the Great Parish", which will take place on Sunday, September 18 from 11:30 am to 7:00 pm.** In the program we will have: music, tasty food, ice cream, beer, drinks, face painting, and games for children, etc. Everyone will find something to enjoy. I ask all families with children, parishioners and guests to come all together on this day and in this special way show your support for our beloved parish

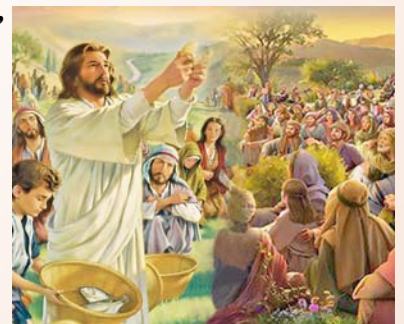

## Z biurka Ks. Proboszcza

### Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście !

Dziś pragnę podzielić się z wami kilkoma myślami, które od dłuższego czasu nurtują moje serce i umysł. Modłę się do Ducha Świętego o właściwe rozeznanie sytuacji oraz o podjęcie roztropnych i dobrych decyzji nie dla mnie, ale dla przyszłości naszej parafii.

Okres ostatnich dwóch lat (*czas pandemii*) zmienił nie tylko współczesny świat, ale również zmienił oblicze naszej parafii. Około **20 %** naszych angielskojęzycznych parafian nie powróciło do kościoła i już nie powróci. Wiele osób zmarło, wiele osób podupadło na zdrowiu, wiele rodzin zmieniło miejsce zamieszkania, wiele rodzin wyjechało. Zmienia się nasza okolica. Upadają biznesy. Niestety i nasza miejscowość staje się też bardziej niebezpieczna. Rodzi się więc pytanie: czy wciąż potrzebujemy aż 8 Mszy w niedzielę. Czy nie lepiej by było zredukować ilość niedzielnych Mszy, tak aby w niej uczestniczyło więcej wiernych. Pomyślmy też i o tym, że redukując ich ilość możemy także zaoszczędzić nasze wydatki np. prąd, gaz, woda itp. Sami wiecie jak wszystko dziś jest drogie. To też dotyczy naszych opłat parafialnych i szkolnych. W związku z zaistniałą sytuacją myślę, że jest już czas zmienić nasz niedzielny rozkład Mszy Świętych z 8 do 7 lub 6. Patrząc na ilość wiernych w czasie niedzielnych nabożeństw uważam, że to będzie mądre i rozropne. W związku z planowanymi zmianami proszę o wyrozumiałość i życzliwość! Do tego tematu jeszcze powrócę.

W najbliższym czasie wreszcie wznowimy prace dokończenia zadania przed kościołem. Po pewnych konsultacjach z diecezją, architektem, inspektorem oraz naszym kontraktorem pewne prace wykończeniowe uległy korekcje. W planach na ten rok będzie jeszcze pomalowanie parkingu przed świątynią.

W związku z ogromnymi kosztami naprawy drugiego parkingu myślę, że ten projekt musi poczekać, chyba że znajdzie się hojny sponsor. Zobaczymy co czas przyniesie. Moim obowiązkiem jest dbanie o pieniądze, które wy składacie z poświęceniem w naszym kościele.
