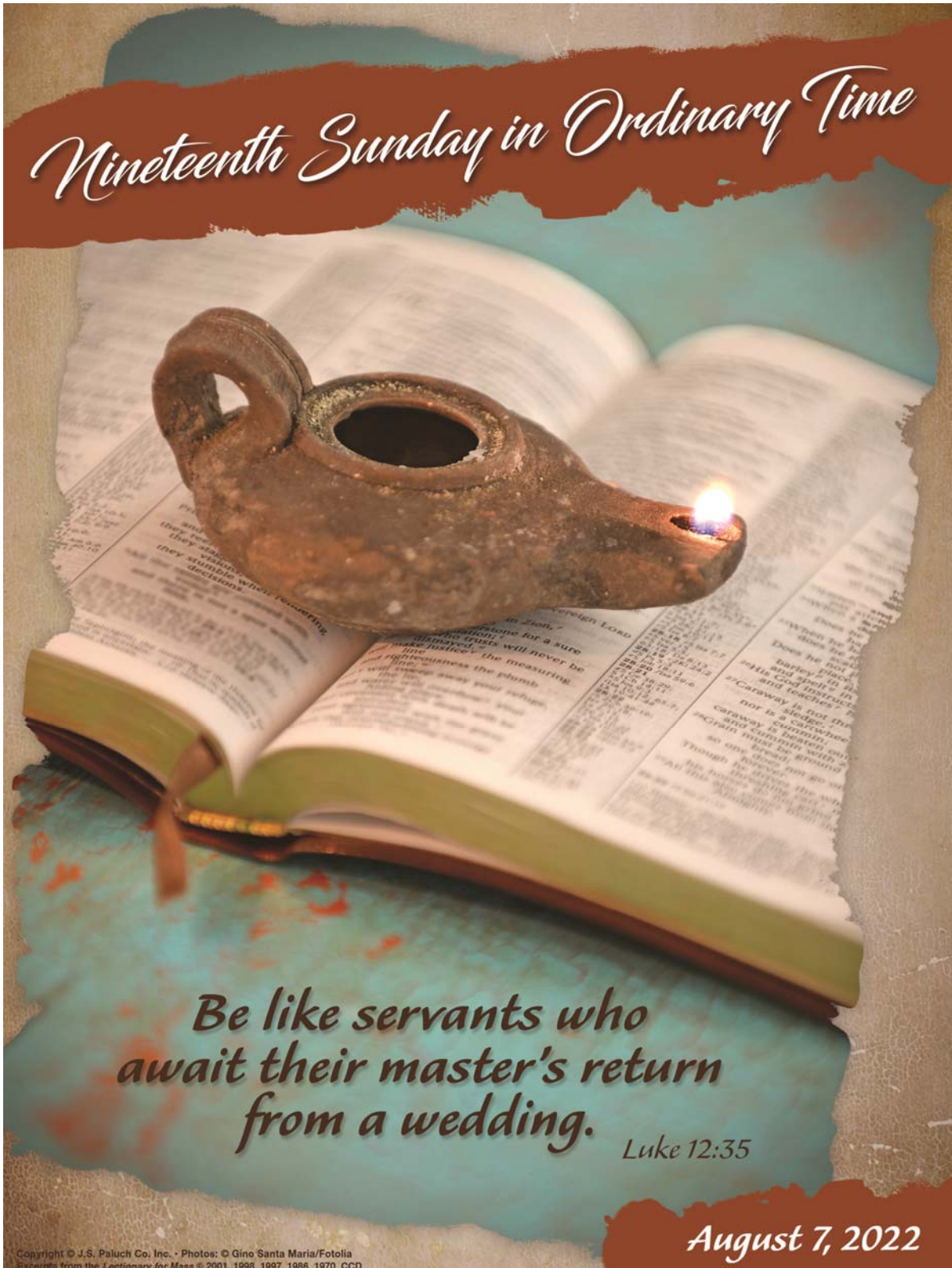

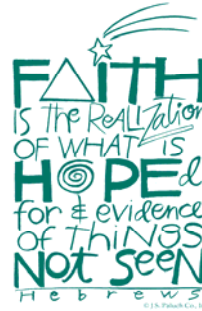

### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

When Pope Pius XII died in 1958, there was the usual buzz of speculation about likely successors. Cardinal Agajanian, Patriarch of the Armenians, was highly thought of as a likely choice. This took many Catholics by surprise, since he had never celebrated the same liturgy as Pope Pius, but followed ancient Armenian customs according to the Eastern Church, which veils the Eucharistic liturgy from sight by a series of curtains, and in which the priest kneels while the people stand for Communion. In the years that followed, the Second Vatican Council would affirm the dignity and independence of the Eastern Churches, in complete union with Rome, yet different in patterns of life and worship. We have the same faith, the same sacraments, and the same pope. Yet everywhere in the world our separate Churches are combined into families held together by the ministry of bishops. All of this serves as warning: If you ever say, "But we've always done it this way," you are on very thin ice indeed! —James Field, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

### MIŁOŚĆ POTRZEBUJE POKARMU

Pan Jezus wzywa nas dzisiaj do czujności, do przebudzenia się z duchowego snu, który uniemożliwia nam dostrzeżenie Jego przyjścia. Nagrodą za taką czujność jest uczestnictwo w uczcie, na której On sam będzie nam usługiwał. Łatwo popaść w duchowy marazm, kiedy zalewa nas szara codzienność. Nasze ideały i postanowienia pierzchają gdzieś, a my sami stajemy się duchowo ospali. Nic przecież się nie wydarzy, biblijne zapowiedzi wskazują na daleką przyszłość, która nie ma nic wspólnego z codziennością. Tak przynajmniej myślimy. Każdy z nas wielokrotnie musi mierzyć się z taką duchową ospałością. Pan Jezus zachęca nas dzisiaj do czujności i gotowości. Wzywa do tego, abyśmy wypatrywali Jego przyjścia tak, jak Izraelici w Egipcie, którzy w paschalną noc wyzwolenia spożywać mieli baranka gotowi do drogi i z przepasanymi biodrami (por. Wj 12,11). Miłość wymaga jednak pokarmu, aby mogła się nim umacniać. Jeśli go zabraknie, to miłość będzie stopniowo wygasać, aż do całkowitego wypalenia. Dlatego Jezus zaprasza nas do ciągłego wypatrywania Go i rozświetlania naszych ciemności światłem Jego nauki. On jest wierny swemu słowu, możemy być więc pewni, że przyjdzie.
