GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

September 24, 2023 - 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Once I gave my three-year-old niece a certain toy for Christmas. When she opened it, she was happy. Shortly thereafter her five-year old sister opened another present from me: the same toy, along with some play jewelry. The three-year-old cried out: **“That’s not fair! Why’d she get the jewelry, too?!”** Let’s face it: there’s something about God’s grace in our religion which bugs us. We love to look at others’ blessings and cry out: **“That’s not fair!”** Catholicism is not fair in the sense that it is a religion founded on God’s grace which is unmerited favor. God pours his mercy, love, and divine life upon us not because we’re good but because He is infinitely good.

If you think the **“not fair”** quality of grace is easy to accept, consider how typically angry we get when we hear the parable of the workers who get paid way more than they deserve. The hyper-generous landowner says to the indignant hard workers, **“Are you envious because I am generous?”** Well, yes, they are, and so are we! Therefore, we have to reckon with this painful truth in order to move into the divine sphere of gifts, which is the world of Christ and his Church. Then we are able to move beyond a tit-for-tat world and into one where gifts are poured forth on those who don’t deserve it — namely, upon us. — Father John Muir ©LPi

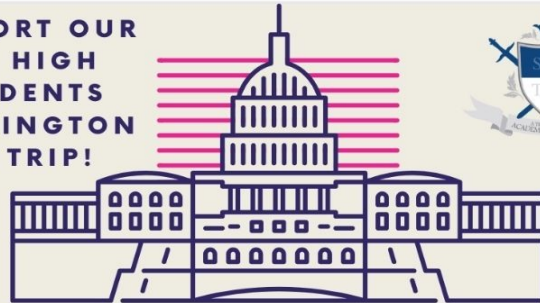

Kilka tygodni temu rozpoczęliśmy nowy rok szkolny i katechetyczny. W dzisiejszym świecie nie jest łatwo wychowywać i kształcić młode pokolenie. Jest to wielka odpowiedzialność, która musi mieć wsparcie ze strony rodziny. Jeśli tego wsparcia nie ma, to pamiętajmy, że szkoła nie jest w stanie wszystkiego dopilnować. Wychowanie religijne jest zadaniem nas wszystkich. Poniżej możecie zobaczyć jak wiele dzieci oraz młodzieży jest zarejestrowanych w naszych szkołach i programach religijnych.

Boża sprawiedliwość

Przypowieść o robotnikach w winnicy przypomina nam, że sprawiedliwość Boga jest inna niż ludzkie oczekiwania. On kieruje się miłością także w ocenie zasług człowieka. Robotnicy pracujący w winnicy cały dzień symbolizują Naród wybrany, w którego dziejach Bóg się objawił. Robotnicy ostatniej godziny to poganie, którzy uwierzyli w Chrystusa po Zesłaniu Ducha Świętego. Przez wiarę ci ostatni zostali zrównani z tymi, którzy uwierzyli wcześniej, dlatego wszyscy otrzymują tę samą zapłatę — wieczne zbawienie. Pamiętajmy o tej Bożej logice miłosierdzia w naszym własnym myśleniu i działaniu. Nie ulegajmy temu, co nam brutalnie narzucają środki przekazu, goniąc za sensacją i zalewając nas niezliczonymi informacjami i komentarzami, z których zdecydowana większość dotyczy burzliwych i dramatycznych wydarzeń: zbrodni, walk, zamachów, wszelkiego rodzaju przestępstw, afer i skandali. Ponieważ dla dziennikarzy dobro zazwyczaj nie jest wiadomością interesującą, w mediach dominuje negatywny obraz rzeczywistości. My jednak umiemy spojrzeć na przekazywane nam informacje krytycznie i nie popadamy w pesymizm i zniechęcenie. Nie dajmy się zwieść medialnej perswazji, że w świecie dominuje zło. Pamiętajmy, że dobra jest więcej, chociaż pozostaje ono ukryte. Aby je dostrzec, trzeba umieć rozeznaczyć drogi Pana, a następnie samemu nimi podążać. Zbawcza miłość Boga i Jego wspaniałomyślność przynagla nas do naśladowania.
