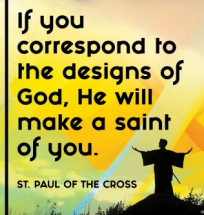

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

Last week, Sunday, October 8, 56 of our parishioners participated in a pilgrimage to the **National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help in Champion, Wisconsin**. The apparitions of Our Lady took place in October 1859. Mary appeared three times to the Belgian emigrant **Adele Brise**. Consistent with her message, Mary appeared in a white dress, girded with a gold sash. On her head was a crown with twelve stars. **"I am the Queen of Heaven who prays for the conversion of sinners, and I want you to do the same,"** said Mary. Our Lady also called Adele Brise to gather the children and teach them the catechism. **"Don't be afraid of anything. I will help you"**, the Blessed Virgin assured. The apparitions in Champion were approved by the Ordinary of the Diocese of Green Bay. You can see photos from the pilgrimage on the parish website and Facebook.

Let us remember that each of us is called by God to pray for sinners. We are also responsible for the religious education of children and young people, and we are to perform acts of mercy every day. **"Our Lady of Good Help, pray for us!"**

Join the group for fun activities and get to know some new friends! During the month of October for one hour 10:00-11:00 classes begin on **October 17**.

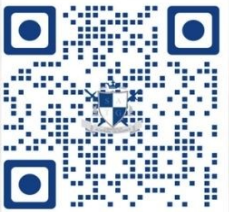

Tydzień temu w niedzielę 8 października 56 naszych parafian uczestniczyło w pielgrzymce do **Narodowego Sanktuarium Matki Bożej Dobrej Pomocy w Champion, Wisconsin**. To tam w październiku 1859 roku miały miejsce objawienia Matki Bożej. Maryja trzykrotnie objawiła się belgijskiej emigrantce **Adele Brise**. Zgodni z jej przekazem, Maryja ukazała się w białej sukni, przepasanej złotą szarfą. Na Jej głowie widniała korona z dwunastoma gwiazdami. „**Jestem Królową Nieba**”, która modli się o nawrócenie grzeszników i pragnę, abyś robiła to samo” – powiedziała Maryja. Matka Boża wezwała także **Adele Brise**, aby zebrała dzieci i uczyła je katechizmu. „**Nie bój się niczego. Ja ci pomogę** – zapewniła Najświętsza Panna. Objawienia maryjne w Champion zostały zatwierdzone przez ordynariusza diecezji Green Bay. Zdjęcia z pielgrzymki możecie zobaczyć na stronie internetowej parafii oraz Facebook.

Pamiętajmy, że każdy z nas jest powołany przez Boga do modlitwy za grzeszników. Jesteśmy odpowiedzialni także za religijne wychowanie dzieci i młodzieży oraz każdego dnia mamy pełnić czyny miłosierdzia. „**Matko Boża Dobrej Pomocy, módl się za nami!**”.
