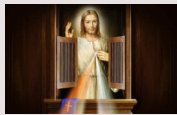

Love in Deed

It's a Wonderful Life is one of my favorite Christmas movies. It only occurred to me recently, though, that this film, for all its yuletide aesthetic, is actually more of an Easter story. I love this movie because it's a very Catholic film - not overtly, although we do see the main character, George Bailey, going to Mass. No, it's the themes that are Catholic, not the set dressing. It's a story about the choices we make - to love, or not to love? To sacrifice, or not to sacrifice? To put oneself first, or to put oneself last? It's a story about what the consequences of those choices look like here in the world, and what they look like in heaven. In the film, we meet a young George Bailey who dreams of growing up to do amazing, impressive things. Over the years, he makes a choice here and he makes a choice there ... and when all is said and done, the adult George Bailey is a tired, overworked husband and father with no worldly attributes that anyone would envy. But he's a man who has loved in deed, not just in word, and who has reaped the spiritual rewards of those choices. The season of Easter is about rejoicing in true redemption, not in worldly triumph. The Word of God is not a bedtime story. It's a pruning shear. To hear it is to be changed, to be shaped. To live it is to lose some things, so that you might bloom in unexpected ways. To welcome the Word is to be willing to look different, to feel different. Anyone can say, **"I love you, I accept you, I want to help you."** But what does it actually look like, to love in deed and not just in word? It looks like giving something up: free time, wealth, comfort, worldly approval. It looks, to the casual observer, like pain. To someone who has no concept of how plants grow and thrive, a gardener's pruning shears look like an executioner's sword. To someone who has no concept of how souls grow and thrive, a tomb barred by a stone looks like the end of a story, when in fact it's just the beginning. **"Children, let us love not in word or speech, but in deed and truth."** — 1 John 3:18 ©LPi

Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście !

W sobotę 11 maja o godz. 10:00 rano w katedrze Najświętszego Imienia w Chicago odbędą się święcenia diakonatu stałego dla osób świeckich. Jesteśmy bardzo dumni, że wśród tych osób będzie nasz parafianin Victor De Avila. Dzięki tym przyjętym święceniom diakonatu będzie on mógł udzielać Sakramentu Chrztu Świętego, będzie głosić kazania oraz homilie, będzie mógł asystować w czasie celebracji Mszy Świętej oraz będzie mógł asystować przy udzielaniu Sakramentu Małżeństwa. Diakon stały może ponadto przewodniczyć różnym nabożeństwom liturgicznym w kościele lub w kaplicy. Może prowadzić modlitwy pogrzebowe. Jezus albo pustka

Lekcje w szkole Ewangelii mają różne poziomy trudności. Ale wbrew odczuciom bezpośrednich uczniów Jezusa, którzy mówią: „Trudna jest ta mowa. Któż jej może słuchać?” program nauczania nie przekracza naszych możliwości. Boski Nauczyciel dostosowuje jego realizację do rytmu naszego dojrzwania. Tłumacząc trudne kwestie wskazuje na sposób przyjęcia ich umysłem i sercem. Jest nim wiara. W dzisiejszej Ewangelii Jezus mówi o sobie jako o pokarmie. Informacja o najcenniejszym darze, jakim jest Eucharystia, spowodowała zgorszenie i odejście wielu uczniów. Jezus nie pobiegł za nimi. Nie powiedział, że zmodyfikuje swoje nauczanie i dostosuje je do ich oczekiwań. Nie uległ pokusie powierzchownej popularności kosztem prawdy. Nie obniża także przed nami poprzeczki. Raczej zachęca do duchowego treningu, abyśmy mogli ją pokonać. Ci, którzy przed wiekami i dziś odchodzą od Jezusa oraz wspólnoty Kościoła dokonują tragicznego wyboru. W pierwszej kolejności krzywdzą jednak samych siebie. Tragiczny jest los człowieka odchodzącego od Boga. To jak odcięcie gałęzi od drzewa. W szybkim tempie tracą one vitalność, możliwość owocowania i życie. Jezus dziś pyta także nas: „Czyż i wy chcecie odejść?” Pozytywnej lub negatywnej odpowiedzi udzielamy każdego dnia. Słowa Szymona Piotra: „Panie, do kogoż pójdziemy? Ty masz słowa życia wiecznego” to odpowiedź pełna realizmu i świadomości konsekwencji wynikających z odejścia od Jezusa i pozostania z Nim. Mamy wybór między Jezusem a pustką.

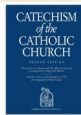
