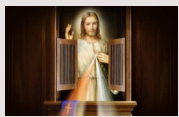

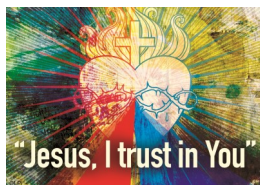

## From the Pastor's Desk

**Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!**



On the occasion of today's **Divine Mercy Sunday**, the installation of the relics of Saint Faustina Kowalska is taking place in our church today. We invite everyone to participate at 3:00 p.m. in the **"Hour of Mercy"** in Roger's Hall. The relics will be brought to the altar by our pastor, Fr. Mariusz Nawalaniec surrounded by priests and altar servants'. His Excellency Bishop Andrzej P. Wypych will bless the reliquary, which will be placed in the prepared reliquary. Together with the entire parish community, we decide to recite the Chaplet of Divine Mercy daily and the Novena to Divine Mercy before the feast of Divine Mercy Sunday every year and nine days novena before the feast of St. Faustina with the opportunity to honor the relics. Let Saint Sister Faustina become a guide for the inhabitants of our city and parish to God, rich in mercy, and an intermediary in obtaining graces. We hope that the presence of St. Faustina will bring blessed fruits and contribute to deepening the devotion to Divine Mercy among the faithful of our parish.

Presence of Saint Sister Faustina in a fragment of the relics fills our hearts with great joy, because the Lord Jesus said: **"For your sake I grant graces to the entire region (Diary 719), for you I bless the land"**. *Our Father, Hail Mary, the Creed.*

**On the Our Father beads, pray:**  
*Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.*

**On the Hail Mary beads, pray:**  
*For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.*

**In conclusion, pray 3 times:**  
*Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.*

### Divine Mercy Sunday

The Octave Day of Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday, therefore points us to the merciful love of God, and the forgiveness of sins, that lies behind the whole Paschal Mystery – the whole mystery of the death, burial and resurrection of Christ – made present for us in the Eucharist. In this way, it also sums up the whole Easter Octave. As Saint John Paul II pointed out in his Regina Caeli address on Divine Mercy Sunday, 1995: “the whole octave of Easter is like a single day,” and the Octave Sunday is meant to be the day of “thanksgiving for the goodness God has shown to man in the whole Easter mystery.”

## Things That Catholics Need To Know

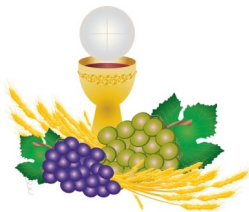
“What really matters in life is that we are loved by Christ and that we love Him in return. In comparison to the love of Jesus, everything else is secondary. And, without the love of Jesus, everything is useless.” – Pope Saint John Paul II  
The most extraordinary and profound truth is that God’s love for you is beyond anything that you can imagine. As a Catholic Christian, it is essential that you accept and understand this wonderful truth. God loves you regardless of your past or your sins. Jesus died to save all of us from sin and spiritual death; He loves you so very much that if you were the only person in need of salvation, He would lay down His life just for you. “No one has greater love than this, to lay down one’s life for one’s friends” (John 15:13).

Without accepting God’s invitation to have a deep and loving relationship with Him, nothing else that you do will make much sense. First and foremost, you are loved, chosen, and called into communion with the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. All that you become depends upon your willingness to accept God’s grace, to enter into a love relationship with Him, and to be transformed into a more faith filled, knowledgeable, cherished, intimate, and loving member of the body of Christ, the Church.

**THE GREAT COMMANDMENT** - The Ten Commandments are fulfilled in Jesus’ Great Commandment: “You shall love...God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength....You shall love your neighbor as yourself.” (Mark 12:30-31)

**THE NEW COMMANDMENT** - Before his death on the cross, Jesus gave his disciples a new commandment: “Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another” (John 13:34).

### THE HOLY EUCHARIST – (HOLY COMMUNION)



- 1) The bread and wine of the Eucharist becomes the true transubstantiated body and blood of Christ. It is not a mere symbol.
- 2) The Eucharist is the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Christ Jesus.
- 3) The reception of Holy Communion is the center of Catholic Faith.
- 4) Communion is by definition to be in union with God and with His Church, to be one in faith.
- 5) To receive Communion, a person must be a practicing Catholic in the state of grace.
- 6) Only an ordained Catholic priest, in the person of Jesus Christ, the High Priest, can transform bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ.

### THE SIX TRUTHS

To be known and believed by all.



- 1) There is one God, who created, who preserves and governs all things.
- 2) God is a just Judge, who rewards the good and punishes the wicked.
- 3) In God there are three Persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.
- 4) The Second Person, Jesus Christ, became man and died on the cross to save us.
- 5) The soul of man is immortal.
- 6) Grace is necessary for salvation.

### THE TEN COMMANDMENTS OF GOD

- 1) I am the Lord thy God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. Thou shalt not have strange gods before Me. Thou shalt not make to yourself a graven thing, not the likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or in the earth beneath, nor of those things that are in the waters under the earth. Thou shalt not adore them nor serve them.
- 2) Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain.
- 3) Remember that thou keep holy the Sabbath – day.
- 4) Honor thy father and thy mother.
- 5) Thou shalt not kill.
- 6) Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- 7) Thou shalt not steal.
- 8) Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.
- 9) Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor’s wife.
- 10) Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor’s goods.



### THE SIX PRECEPTS OF THE CHURCH

- 1) To attend Mass on Sundays and Holy days of obligation.
- 2) To fast and abstain on the days appointed.
- 3) To confess at least once a year.
- 4) To receive the Most Blessed Sacrament during the Easter time.
- 5) To contribute to the support of our pastors.
- 6) Matrimony is a Sacrament between one Man and one Woman. It provides grace to the couple and the Church helps prepare couples for the Sacrament. Please see Sacraments and Matrimony on our website.

## Z liwka Ks. Proboszcza

### Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście !

Z okazji Niedzieli Bożego Miłosierdzia odbywa się dzisiaj 7 kwietnia, 2024 w naszym kościele instalacja relikwii Świętej Faustyny Kowalskiej. Ponadto o godzinie 3:00 po południu w sali pod kościołem zapraszamy do udziału w nabożeństwie - „**Godziny Miłosierdzia**”. Relikwie do świątyni wniesie ks. Mariusz Nawalaniec, Proboszcz w otoczeniu kapłanów i ministrantów. Jego Eksceleńcja ks. Biskup Andrzej P. Wypych poświęci relikwiarz, który zostanie wstawiony do przygotowanego relikwiarium. Z całą wspólnotą parafialną postanowimy codziennie odmawiać Koronkę do Miłosierdzia Bożego i Nowennę do Bożego Miłosierdzia. Dziś będzie możliwość ucałowania relikwii. Niech Św. Faustyna stanie się dla mieszkańców naszego miasta i parafii przewodniczką do Boga bogatego w miłosierdzie i pośredniczką w wyprasaniu łask. Mamy nadzieję, że obecność Św. Faustyny przyniesie błogosławione owoce i przyczyni się do pogłębienia nabożeństwa do Miłosierdzia Bożego wśród wiernych naszej parafii.



Obecność Św. Faustyny w częście relikwii napełnia nasze serca wielką radością, gdyż Pan Jezus powiedział: „**Ze względu na ciebie udzielam łask całej okolicy (Dz.719), dla ciebie błogosławię ziemi.**” (Dz. 431). Niech błogosławieństwo Jezusa Miłosiernego, Który wskazuje na swoje serce, ciche i pokorne, będzie udziałem całej naszej wspólnoty parafialnej i wszystkich modlących się w obecności Św. Siostry Faustyny w naszym kościele parafialnym.

Chrystus - Król Miłosierdzia wybrał pokorną siostrę zakonną Faustynę Kowalską na Apostolkę Miłości Miłosierniej. Siostra Faustyna została ogłoszona Świętą 30 kwietnia 2000 roku. Jej kanonizacji dokonał papież Jan Paweł II. Jezus Miłosierny pozostawił nam wierzącym wielką obietnicę w słowach:

- **”Dusze, które szerczą cześć miłosierdzia Mojego, osłaniam je przez życie całe, jak czuła matka swe niemowlę, a w godzinę śmierci nie będę im Sędzią, ale miłosiernym Zbawicielem”.** (Dz. 1075)
- **„Kto ufa Miłosierdziu Mojemu, nie zginie”.** (Dz. 723).
- **„O jak wielkich łask udzielię duszom, które odmawiać będą tę koronkę”.** (Dz. 848)
- **„Przez nią uprosisz wszystko, jeżeli to, o co prosisz, będzie zgodne z wolą moją”.** (Dz. 1731)

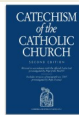
