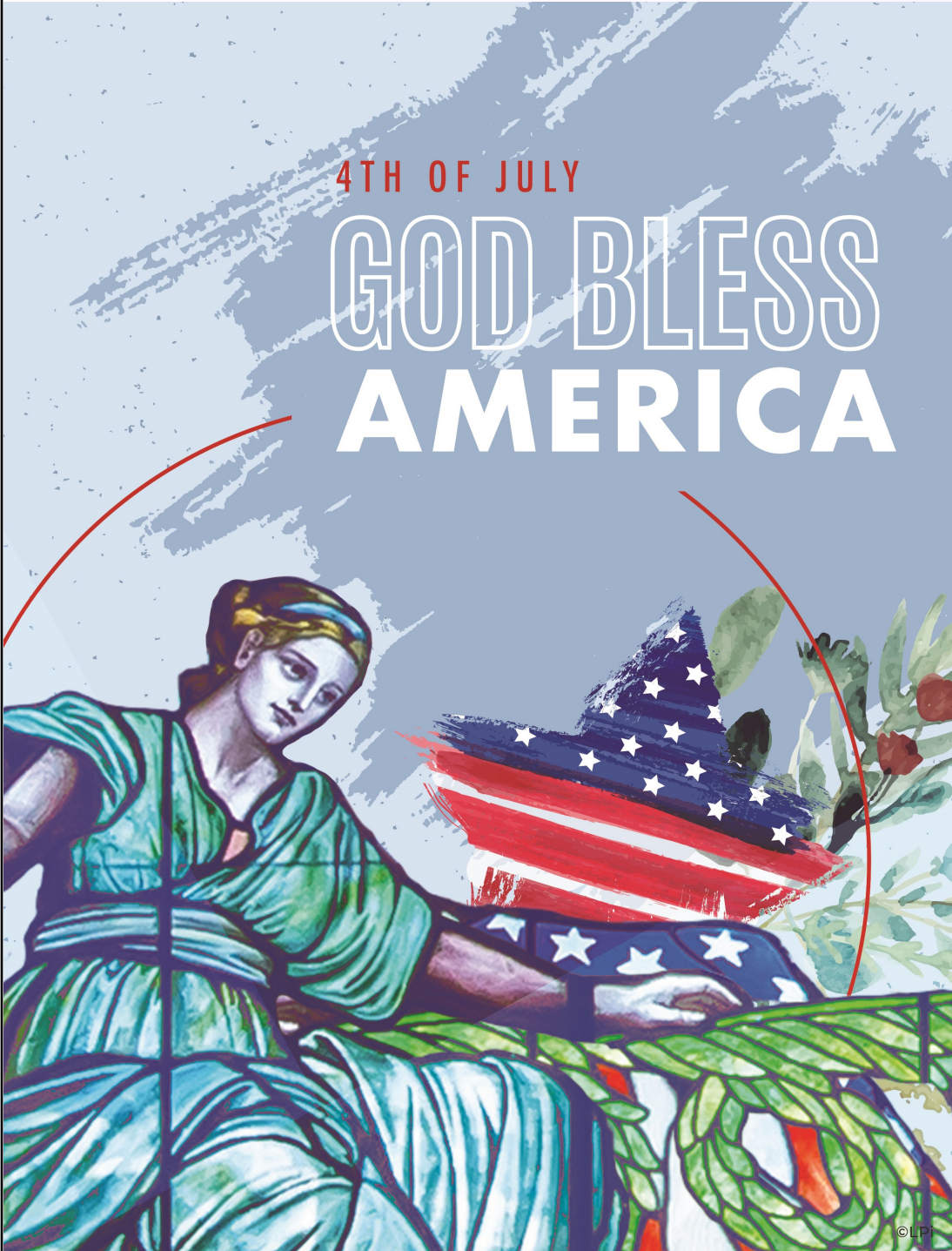

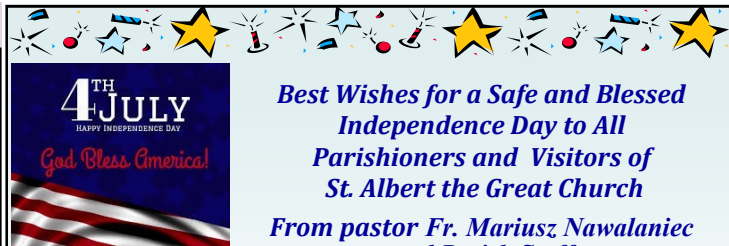

The Touch of Christ

For a long time, I didn't understand why the virtual Masses of the pandemic were so wearisome to me. Theoretically, shouldn't it be a tired mother's dream, fulfilling her Sunday obligation from the couch, not having to worry how much noise the kids are making? But it wasn't. Seeing Mass without experiencing it left me hungry. It left me starving. Then a wise priest explained it to me. **“Watching virtual Mass is like taking a virtual shower,”** he said.

Grace might not be something we can see with our eyes, but it is very much something that is transmitted physically. Jesus has a human body for a reason. He needs to touch people. We see that nowhere more clearly than in this Gospel. The crowds are pressing on him, everyone trying to get close, everyone trying to share his space. The hemorrhaging woman claws her way through, desperate to make physical contact with him, any part of him, even his cloak. The synagogue official begs Jesus to come and “lay hands” on his daughter, knowing that this is the only way for her to survive. He doesn't ask for Jesus' good thoughts or approving gaze. He knows that isn't what he needs.

In the Gospels, Jesus saves people chiefly through his own touch because he wants to show us — you and me, sitting in the pews — something very important about how we are saved. But where do you and I find the touch of Jesus Christ? Where do you and I find salvation?

It's in the water flowing over the infant's forehead. It's in the Host dissolving on our tongues. It's in the oil that is pressed to the skin of the confirmand, the dying man, and the brand-new priest. It's in the embrace of the newly married couple. It's in the extended hand of the priest as he says, **“Your sins are forgiven.”** It's still here, two thousand years later. It's still waiting for us to reach out and grasp it. **“If I but touch his clothes, I shall be cured.”** — Mark 5:28 ©LPi

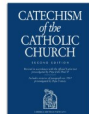

SPOSOBY PRZYWRÓCENIA DZIECI DO KOŚCIOŁA

Nierzadko zdarza się, że rodzice martwią się o dziecko, które odeszło od Kościoła. Synowie i córki, którzy nie dostrzegają znaczenia Boga w swoim życiu, mogą być głównym źródłem niepokoju rodziców. Kiedy rodzice pragną dla swoich dzieci największego dobra, a mianowicie zbawienia wiecznego, w naturalny sposób pytają: „Co możemy zrobić, aby sprowadzić nasze dziecko z powrotem do Kościoła?” Rozważanie Pisma Świętego może pomóc w zrozumieniu tej kwestii. Księga Apokalipsy, pełna niezwykłych wizji i opisów grozy, często budzi strach, zwłaszcza gdy czytamy o sędzie na niewiernych. Wśród tych, którzy zastanawiali się nad tymi wersetami, był artysta Holman Hunt. Jego obraz „Światło światła” powstał na podstawie Objawienia 3:21: „**Oto jestem! Stoję u drzwi i pukam. Jeśli ktoś usłyszy mój głos i drzwi otworzy, wejść i będę z nim wieczerzał, a on ze mną**”. Obraz przedstawia Jezusa stojącego w ciemnym sadzie, a jedyne światło wydobywa się z Jego latarni. Puka do drzwi porośniętych winoroślą i chwastami. Drzwi najwyraźniej były zamknięte przez długi czas. Hunt celowo nie namalował klamki na drzwiach, mówiąc, że drzwi do ludzkiego serca można otworzyć tylko od środka. Ponad 150 lat po stworzeniu Światła Świata może pomóc nam uporządkować niektóre z naszych obaw i zmartwień. Pamiętaj, że Bóg jest łagodny. Trudno jest, gdy bliska osoba nie otwiera drzwi Chrystusowi, ale nie można na siłę otworzyć drzwi do serca drugiej osoby. Zaufaj Bogu, że nadal będzie wołał do ukochanej osoby. To nie jest okazja, która zdarza się raz w życiu. Bóg pragnie, aby drzwi zostały otwarte. Przypomnij sobie, jak pasterz odnalazł zagubioną owcę i radował się, gdy ją odnalaziono! (Łukasz 15:3-5). Zaakceptuj Boży czas. Jak powiedział Psalmista: „**Wszystkie moje tęsknoty stoją przed Tobą, Panie; moje wzdychanie nie jest przed tobą ukryte**”. (Ps 38:9). Psychologowie opisują dwa style reagowania na stres – radzenie sobie skoncentrowane na problemie i radzenie sobie skoncentrowane na emocjach. Czasami najlepiej jest skoncentrować się na problemie, ponieważ potrzebne jest bezpośrednie działanie. Jednakże martwienie się o duchową podróż ukochanej osoby najprawdopodobniej wiąże się z radzeniem sobie skoncentrowanym na emocjach i przeglądem własnych uczuć wobec danej sytuacji. Podziel się swoimi emocjami z Chrystusem i odnow się w Eucharystii. Kiedy usłyszysz Jego głos, otwórz swoje serce i pozwól, aby Jego pokój odrzucił wszelkie lęki. Dr. Cathleen McGreal.

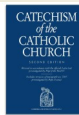
