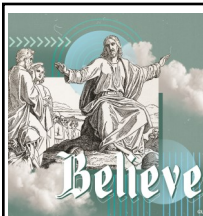

We may live in a part of the country where the heat that's accumulated by this time of year is overwhelming. If so, the first reading will resonate with us. Just one day into his journey across the desert, the great prophet Elijah is so hot and tired and hungry and thirsty that he actually prays for death. Whether due to extreme temperatures or something else, sometimes we may feel at the end of our ropes. May Elijah remind us that God comes to us in our hour of need, most significantly by sending us Jesus, the Bread of Life, whom we receive today in the Eucharist and who is with us always, accompanying us and sustaining us in our suffering. We are reminded again today of the sustenance God provides us. In the first reading, Elijah is on the verge of dying of hunger and thirst. God sends him an angel, who brings him a hearth cake and a jug of water, which sustains him on his journey across the desert to the mountain of God. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the huge crowd whom he had fed with five loaves and two fish that he is the bread of life, bread that will enable all those who eat it to live forever. God has given us the sustenance we need to make our journeys through this life and to the next.

## From the Pastor's Desk

**Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!**

A few days ago we started month of August, which in the **tradition of the Catholic Church** is dedicated to the Virgin Mary, the Mother of God. It is a time to celebrate various holidays, e.g. the **Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (August 15)**, the **Feast of Our Lady of Częstochowa (August 26)**. Also in August, numerous pilgrimages to Sanctuaries of Blessed Virgin Mary around the world take place. **As every year, for 37 years, a Polish walking pilgrimage has been taking place from Chicago to Merrillville, Indiana (August 10 and 11)**. **The motto of this year's pilgrimage is: "You are with me when I come to You, Mary Mother of God"**! Several thousand people take part in it, many young people, families with children and the elderly. Group of our parishioners (**about 200 people**) along with the **Pastor Mariusz**, is part of this pilgrimage. Together with all pilgrims, we assure you, dear parishioners and guests, that we commend our parish and school intentions, as well as the intentions of each of you individually, to **Jesus through the intercession of the Black Madonna of Jasna Góra!** We also ask you to pray for us that we will reach Merrillville, Indiana safely and soundly.

### GOSPEL MEDITATION

This week we hear Jesus say, **“He that believes in me, has eternal life”** (John 6:47). These straightforward words, uttered by human lips, sound — how to put this? — insane. Who could possibly say such a thing? Jesus says things that are so high, so demanding, so beyond our capacity to fathom, we hardly know what to do with them and (if you’re like me), they usually go in one ear and out the other. So, let us ask: how can believing in him lead to eternal life?

To believe in something means not just to acknowledge its existence, but also to orient yourself entirely to it. If a football player believes in his team, it means he puts his life totally at the service of that goal. If a student believes in her dream to become a doctor, she gives everything she has to her studies and preparation for her MCAT test. Belief means to move boldly toward something we love, and trust is possible to attain.

What is the highest possible good at which we can aim? It is God himself, the gift of eternal life without end. Jesus has made this **“good”** possible in and through his human nature. To believe in him means to have him as our ultimate goal. This week let’s believe the truth of these words and make practical decisions to orient ourselves toward what we see available in him: eternal life. — *Father John Muir* ©LPi

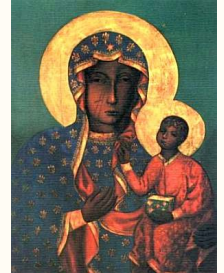
## Z liwka Ks. Probożcza

### Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście !

Kilka dni temu rozpoczęliśmy nowy miesiąc sierpień, który w *tradycji Kościoła Katolickiego* dedykowany jest osobie *Maryi-Matce Bożej*. Jest to czas celebracji różnych świąt maryjnych np. *Uroczystość Wniebowzięcia NMP (15 sierpnia)*, *Święto Matki Bożej Częstochowskiej (26 sierpnia)*. Także w miesiącu sierpniu mają miejsce liczne



pielgrzymki do sanktuariów maryjnych na świecie. *Jak co roku, od 37 lat odbywa się pieszka polonijna pielgrzymka maryjna z Chicago do Merrillville w Indianie (10 i 11 sierpnia)*. *Hasłem tegorocznej pielgrzymki są słowa: „Jesteś ze mną gdy idę do Ciebie, Maryjo”!* Uczestniczy w niej kilka tysięcy osób, wiele młodych ludzi, młodych rodzin z dziećmi oraz starszych. Także i z naszej parafii na pątniczym szlaku pielgrzymuje liczna grupa naszych parafian (*około 200 osób*) wraz z *księdzem proboszczem Mariuszem*.



Wraz z grupą pielgrzymów zapewniamy was *Kochani Parafianie i Goście*, że wszystkie nasze parafialne i szkolne intencje, jak również intencje każdego z was z osobna polecamy *Jesusowi za wstawiennictwem Czarnej Madonny z Jasnej Góry!* Prosimy was także o modlitwę w naszej intencji, abyśmy bezpiecznie oraz zdrowo dotarli do Merrillville w Indianie.

**Droga świata i droga ucznia** - Żydzi szemrali przeciwko Jezusowi, bo nie rozumieli, kiedy mówił, że jest chlebem, który zstąpił z nieba. Zнали Jego ojca i matkę, czy więc mógł być z nieba? Kto jest w stanie w to uwierzyć? To jest problem całkiem współczesny: jak myśleć o Jezusie? Wierzyć czy szemrać? Nie chodzi o to, żeby nie mieć żadnych wątpliwości i pytań. Apostołowie też je mieli. Ważne jest, gdzie szuka się odpowiedzi, za czym lub za kim się idzie. Można pójść drogą *tego świata* albo stać się *uczniami Boga* i dać się *pociągnąć Ojcu*. Droga świata mówi, że Jezus nie może być Bogiem — był tylko człowiekiem, choć niezwykłym. Jeśli tak jest, nie trzeba w Niego wierzyć, ani się dla Niego poświęcać. Jeśli tak jest, to On nie może też nic więcej dać. Jeśli tak jest, to można poradzić sobie bez Boga, modlitwy, sakramentów, świątyni. Pozostaje szemranie — znak niepokoju i wątpliwości, które próbuje się zagłuszyć agresją, ironią, kłamstwem... I do szemrania szuka się jeszcze sprzymierzeńców — nowych wyznawców głośnego sprzeciwu wobec Jezusa. Droga, którą idzie uczeń Boga polega na zaufaniu, że Jezus mówi prawdę. Wiara nie polega na tym, że ma się matematyczną pewność i fizyczny dowód. Wiara nie potrzebuje żadnych dowodów, lecz otwartego serca, które odczyta głos Ojca, pociągający człowieka do Chrystusa; otwartych uszu, aby uczeń usłyszał od Ojca; otwartego umysłu, aby mógł się od Ojca nauczyć. Droga świata i droga ucznia. Obydwie drogi są możliwe. Trzeba dokonać świadomego wyboru, wiedząc, jakie są tego wyboru konsekwencje.

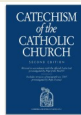
