

Gospel: Luke 9:11b-17. The feeding of the multitudes In the first reading and the responsorial psalm, we are reminded of Melchizedek, the first priest mentioned in the Bible. He brought Abraham bread and wine, the same food and drink that Jesus transformed into his body and blood. The Gospel story of the feeding of the multitudes through the multiplication of five loaves and two fish reminds us that God's generosity is overflowing, able to satisfy us all. Prayer & Worship



The Corpus Christi procession is still observed in many places. Like any procession, the primary liturgical image is the entrance of God's people into paradise, the epiphany of God's kingdom of justice and peace. A simple outdoor circling of the church can carry the significance. Public displays of faith are meant to be welcoming to neighbors, not threatening. Think this aspect through in your own community: How can the celebration show hospitality to all who witness it? The traditional canopy or ombrellino over the monstrance conveys the image of the tent that housed God's presence during the people's journey to the promised land. Any parade needs music; in Latin America and Europe the processions include marching bands. The sounds of handbells, brass, and percussion “carry” outdoors. Yes, it is hard to sing and walk at the same time. Ostinatos and certain litanies can work well.

Following the procession, some parishes schedule exposition of the Holy Eucharist for the remainder of the day. The festive day can then conclude with a celebration of solemn evening prayer. WLP's worship resources contain an order of service for evening prayer.

Tuesday is the Solemnity of the Nativity of John the Baptist. Certainly images of John the Baptist can be enshrined with flowers and candles. This ancient festival of the Nativity of John the Baptist was marked through the ages with much revelry. Most closely associated with the beginning of summer, St. John's Day was celebrated as a time to bless God for the land and the produce it would yield.

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary occur at the end of this week. Certainly images of the Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart can be enshrined with flowers and candles. These days of devotion always fall within the week after the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, just as the long stretch of Ordinary Time is commencing.

Procesja Bożego Ciała jest nadal obchodzona w wielu miejscowościach. Podobnie jak w przypadku każdej procesji, podstawowym obrazem liturgicznym jest wejście ludu Bożego do raju, epifania Bożego królestwa sprawiedliwości i pokoju. Proste okrążenie kościoła na zewnątrz może mieć znaczenie. Publiczne okazywanie wiary ma być świadectwem naszej wiary. Przemyśl jaka jest Twoja intencja uczestniczenia w Uroczystości Bożego Ciała? Tradycyjny baldachim nad monstrancją przekazuje obraz namiotu, w którym przebywała obecność Boga podczas podróży ludu do ziemi obiecanej. Każda parada, procesja potrzebuje muzyki; w Ameryce Łacińskiej i Europie procesje obejmują orkiestry maszerujące. Dźwięki dzwonków ręcznych, instrumentów dętych i perkusji „niosą” się na zewnątrz. Tak, trudno jest śpiewać i chodzić w tym samym czasie. Ostinatos i niektóre litanie mogą się sprawdzić.


Po procesji niektóre parafie planują wystawienie Najświętszego Sakramentu na resztę dnia. Dzień świąteczny może zakończyć się uroczystą modlitwą wieczorną. Materiały do nabożeństw WLP zawierają porządek nabożeństwa na modlitwę wieczorną. Wtorek to uroczystość Narodzenia św. Jana Chrzciciela. Z pewnością wizerunki św. Jana Chrzciciela mogą być uwiecznione kwiatami i świecami. To starożytne święto Narodzenia św. Jana Chrzciciela było obchodzone przez wieki z wielką hucznością. Najświęcej kojarzony z początkiem lata, Dzień Świętego Jana był obchodzony jako czas błogosławienia Boga za ziemię i plony, które wyda.

Uroczystość Najświętszego Serca Pana Jezusa i Wspomnienie Niepokalanego Serca Najświętszej Maryi Panny przypadają pod koniec tego tygodnia. Z pewnością wizerunki Najświętszego Serca i Niepokalanego Serca można uwiecznić kwiatami i świecami. Te dni nabożeństwa zawsze przypadają w tygodniu po uroczystości Najświętszego Ciała i Krwi Chrystusa, tuż przed rozpoczęciem długiego okresu Okresu Zwykłego.



If God has blessed your family with plenty of food to eat, make sure you also give food to people who are hungry.

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A Catholic friend of mine occasionally says, "The Eucharist is not a noun. It's a verb." In so saying, he is making the point that the Eucharist isn't simply Jesus' bodily presence given to us in holy Communion. It also manifests the dynamic pattern by which Christ actively loves and saves us. He teaches us to cooperate with that pattern. The Eucharist actually embodies four verbs: Jesus takes, blesses, breaks, and gives. Let's consider each one.

He takes: Do we acknowledge that we are totally in God's hands? Do we receive everything in our lives as a gift, and act responsibly with it?

He blesses: Do we actively reflect that Jesus makes us holy in our baptism? Do we embrace our bodies and souls as temples of God, worthy of love, peace, and joy?

He breaks: Do we run from failure and disappointment, from getting old or being ignored? Are we too worried about getting hurt or sick? Do we embrace our sufferings with confidence?

He gives: Are we willing to make our lives a gift for others? Are we confident that we will always have enough love to give to others, that God will always provide enough for us? Do we rejoice in giving away what we have to others, expecting nothing in return? This is the dynamic life the Eucharist empowers us to live.
