

# From the Pastor's Desk

## Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

I encourage you to familiarize yourself with the most important points of Pope Leo XIV's 2026 Lenten Message.

1. Listening as the beginning of conversion. The Pope emphasizes the importance of:

Listening to the **Word of God.**

Listening to the **cry of the poor.**

Listening to those who **suffer.**

2. Fasting is more than just giving up food. The Pope points to the deeper meaning of fasting:

Fasting helps us recognize what we truly **"hunger for."**

It purifies and organizes our desires.

It nourishes our hunger and thirst for justice.

3. Abstinence from hurtful words. The Pope calls on Christians to **"disarm the tongue."** He encourages us to:

Avoid harsh words – **"curses."**

Refrain from hasty **judgments.**

**Do not slander or slander others.**

**Do not speak ill of those who are absent** and unable to defend themselves.

4. **Conversion has a communal dimension.** Lent is not just a personal matter. **Parishes and families are to become welcoming places for all people!**

**Reflection Mass – Sunday, March 15, 2026**  
St. Albert the Great Parish cordially invites parishioners and guests to attend a **Reflection Mass** on **Sunday, March 15, 2026, at 8:30 am**. We are honored to welcome **Most Reverend Robert Fedek** as our special celebrant for this liturgy. All are invited to join us for this grace-filled opportunity for prayer and reflection as we gather together in faith and fellowship.

**Lent** – It is a season of reflection and preparation before the celebrations of Easter – resurrection of Jesus Christ. By observing the 40 days of Lent, Christians replicate Jesus Christ's sacrifice and withdrawal into the desert for 40 days. During this period many people engage in fasting and practice moderation in order to focus on repentance and consecrating oneself to God.



**Mini Explanation**

Self-control flows from the cardinal virtue of temperance, and it's really all about boundaries. Through self-control, a gift of the Holy Spirit, we avoid surrendering too much of ourselves to our passions.

**Self-Control, Explained!**

Love. Joy. Anger. Desire. Fear.

These are just a few of what are called the "passions" of humankind, and in order to understand self-control, we must first understand the passions. Our passions are neither good nor bad – it's all in how we interact with them.

Enter the virtue of self-control.

Self-control flows from the cardinal virtue of temperance, and it's really all about boundaries. Passions only become problematic when we allow them to control us. Through self-control, a gift of the Holy Spirit, we avoid surrendering too much of ourselves to our passions.

**"When regulated by reason, and subjected to the control of the will, the passions may be considered good and used as means of acquiring and exercising virtue,"** we read in [The Catholic Encyclopedia](#). **"The sensitive is given to man by God, and therefore its acts have to be employed in His service."** ©LPi

Alimenta nuestra hambre y sed de justicia.

3. Abstenerse de palabras hirientes. El Papa llama a los cristianos a **"desarmar la lengua"**. Nos anima a:

Abstenerse de juicios **precipitados**.

**No calumniar ni difamar a los demás**.

**No hablar mal de quienes están ausentes** e incapaces de defenderse.

4. **La conversión tiene una dimensión comunitaria**. La Cuaresma no es solo un asunto personal. **Las parroquias y las familias deben convertirse en lugares acogedores para todos**.

## Oración y adoración

1 de marzo de 2026 - II Domingo de Cuaresma Mateo 17:1-9

La liturgia de hoy está llena de símbolos de gloria y majestad. Si estamos atentos, podremos descubrir el gran amor de Dios hacia su Hijo Jesús y también hacia nosotros, manifestado en su Transfiguración. La gloria futura se presenta en la nube como signo de la presencia de Dios, así como en los vestidos blancos y el rostro de Jesús resplandeciente como el sol. **"A la vista de ellos, su aspecto cambió completamente: su cara brillaba como el sol y su ropa se volvió blanca como la luz"** (Mateo 17:2). La muerte que Jesús había anunciado previamente a sus discípulos, la que iba a padecer, será transformada en gloria en la Pascua. Sin embargo, para llegar a esa Pascua hay que pasar por el camino del Calvario, hacia la cruz. Pedro propuso hacer tres tiendas; estaba tan bien allí, con sus compañeros y con Jesús. De repente, se escucha la voz del Padre que dice: **"Este es mi Hijo, el Amado; éste es mi Elegido, ¡escúchenlo!"** (Mateo 17:5).



Para ser verdaderos seguidores de Jesús, debemos desinstalarnos de nuestras comodidades y de nuestros caprichos.

La Cuaresma, que apenas comienza, debe llevarnos a comprometernos con el bien común y con la justicia que tanto necesita la sociedad actual. La dura realidad que estamos viviendo debe ser también un camino para encontrar la luz y la voz de Dios que nos llama a despertar y actuar frente a las necesidades de los demás. También cabe la pregunta: ¿a quién estamos escuchando? ¿A quién, o a qué, le estamos haciendo caso? Recordemos que seguir al Maestro exige esfuerzo y entrega. Bajemos, pues, de lo alto del monte para caminar con Jesús en esta Cuaresma. ©LPi
